Agenda No.3

To review the Attendance and Academic Results of students during the previous year.

Resolution No. 3

In accordance with that the Examination Committee conducts Surprise Tests, Unit Tests and Model Examinations and also issues Progress Report Cards to the Students for obtaining the endorsement of their Parents. He also emphasized that the Parents should motivate their wards to avoid the use of Mobile Phones and keep away from getting addicted to tobacco and other substances. In this way, the Chairman of the Meeting informed the parents about the diverse mechanisms of the College for the holistic development of students. The Chairman also made it very clear that 109 Post Cards will be sent to the parents of total absentees so as to inform them about the consequences of not attending their classes regularly.
