BRIEF REPORT	As part of the Institutions' Vision and Mission Policies, the Principal, during the first meeting of the Staff Council, forms various Institute Level Committees every year covering Curricular, Co-curricular and Extra-Curricular activities for the overall development of the students. Accordingly, the Principal



constituted 'Subject Literary Association' for the Academic Session 2017-2018 in the first meeting of the Staff Council. Associate Prof. Dr. Madhukar Nandanwar was appointed as the Member Secretary of the Committee while Asst. Prof. Someshwar Wasekar and Asst. Prof. Jyoti Bante were appointed as its Honorary Members. The Committee issued Circular on 26th August 2017 to all the Department Heads for conducting various students'-centric activities like Guest Lectures, Workshops, Students' Seminar, Workshops, Quiz Competitions, Elocution Competitions, and Debates etc. for the multi-dimensional growth of students. As such, the Committee instructed all the Departments to maintain their respective "Departmental Library" and "Issue-Return Register". Moreover, the Heads of all Departments were instructed to fix one "Display Board" at the entry gate of their Departments to showcase the creative activities and achievements of their students. As such, the Committee gave liberty to each Department to execute some innovative activities to ensure the holistic development of students.
