To review the Attendance and Academic Results of students during the previous year.

Resolution No. 3

The Chairman of the Meeting raised concern over the poor attendance of students in the classroom as it has adversely affected the results of students. The Chairman of the Meeting motivated the Parents to send their wards to College regularly to attend their periods. He also emphasized that parents should make visit to the College at least once in a month and interact with the teachers to keep a track on the Academic progress of their wards and their attendance in the classrooms.

In the course of the Meeting, one of the Parents Mr. Bhoyar



expressed his views and put forwarded his opinion that the College should take very serious action of cancelling the admissions of those students who remain absent throughout. Further, after obtaining the consent of Parents, the Chairman of the Meeting approved the Resolution of sending Post Cards to the parents whose children abstain from attending regular classes.

The Chairman of the Meeting also highlighted that the College always takes positive initiatives to achieve the Academic progress of students. In accordance with that the Examination Committee conducts Surprise Tests, Unit Tests and Model Examinations and also issue Progress Report Cards to the Students for obtaining the endorsement of their Parents. He also emphasized that the Parents should motivate their wards to avoid the use of Mobile Phones and keep away from getting addicted to tobacco and other substances. In this way, the Chairman of the Meeting informed the parents about the diverse mechanisms of the College for the holistic development of students.

Agenda No.4

Implementation of the 'Adoption Scheme' of sponsoring poor students.

Resolution No. 4

The Chairman of the Meeting apprised the Parents regarding the readiness of staff to help financially poor students. Many students received financial help from the Principal and the teachers of the College.
