Agenda No. 3

To review the Attendance and Academic Results of students during the previous year.

Resolution No. 3

The Chairman of the Meeting raised concern over the poor attendance of students in the classroom as it has adversely affected the results of students. He also emphasized that parents should make visit to the College at least once in a month and interact with the teachers to keep a track on the Academic progress of their wards and their attendance in the classrooms.

In this way, the Chairman of the Meeting informed the parents about the diverse mechanisms of the College for the holistic development

Agenda No.4

Resolution No. 4

Many students received financial help from the Principal and the teachers of the College. Agenda No.5

Resolution No.5

He also highlighted that the Institution has installed CCTV Cameras in the College Campus to have a vigil on all the activities in the Campus. During the meeting, one of the parents asked about the



Scholarship issue. The Principal explained that all the scholarship process had been completed by the Administrative Staff of the College. But the Government had not deposited the amount in the students' account. Thus, the parents became satisfied.

Associate Prof. Dr. Sunil Shinde in his talk expressed that the role of parents is very important for the development of the College. The Chairman of the Meeting, in his Presidential Address, talked about the problems faced by the College and also expected the cooperation of the Parents to overcome these issues.

The Chairman of the Meeting asked the parents to encourage their wards to avail the benefits of all the facilities available in the College Campus.

All the agendas discussed in this Meeting were unanimously approved by all the Members of the Parent-Teacher Association. Sixty Four Parents were present in the Meeting.
