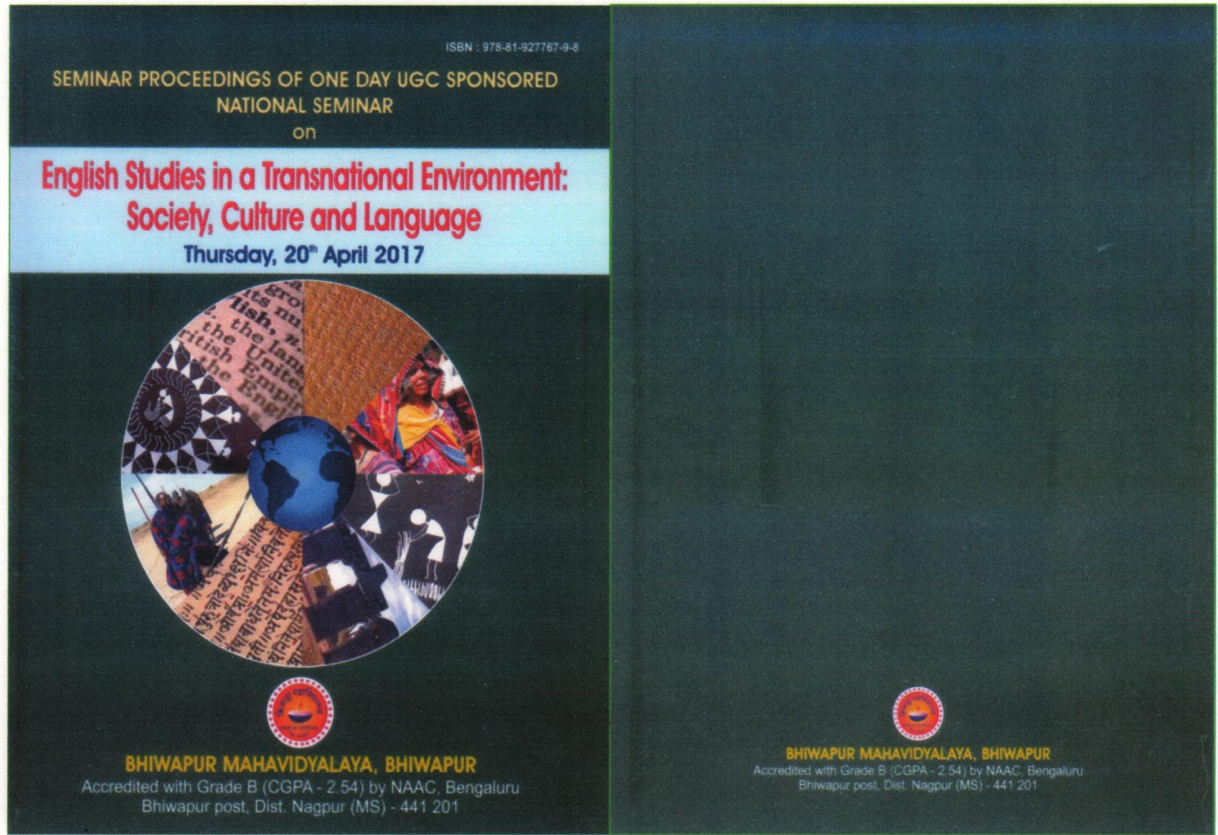

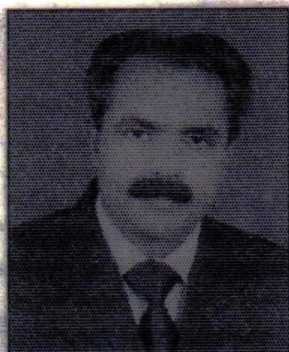
The policy makers of the country must remember that the welfare of the workers is a real concern as a large number of people in the country still continue to live below the poverty line.

CONCEPT NOTE

The Human Machine Interface of Computer hardware is any physical device used in or with your machine, whereas software is a collection of programming code installed on your computer's hard drive. 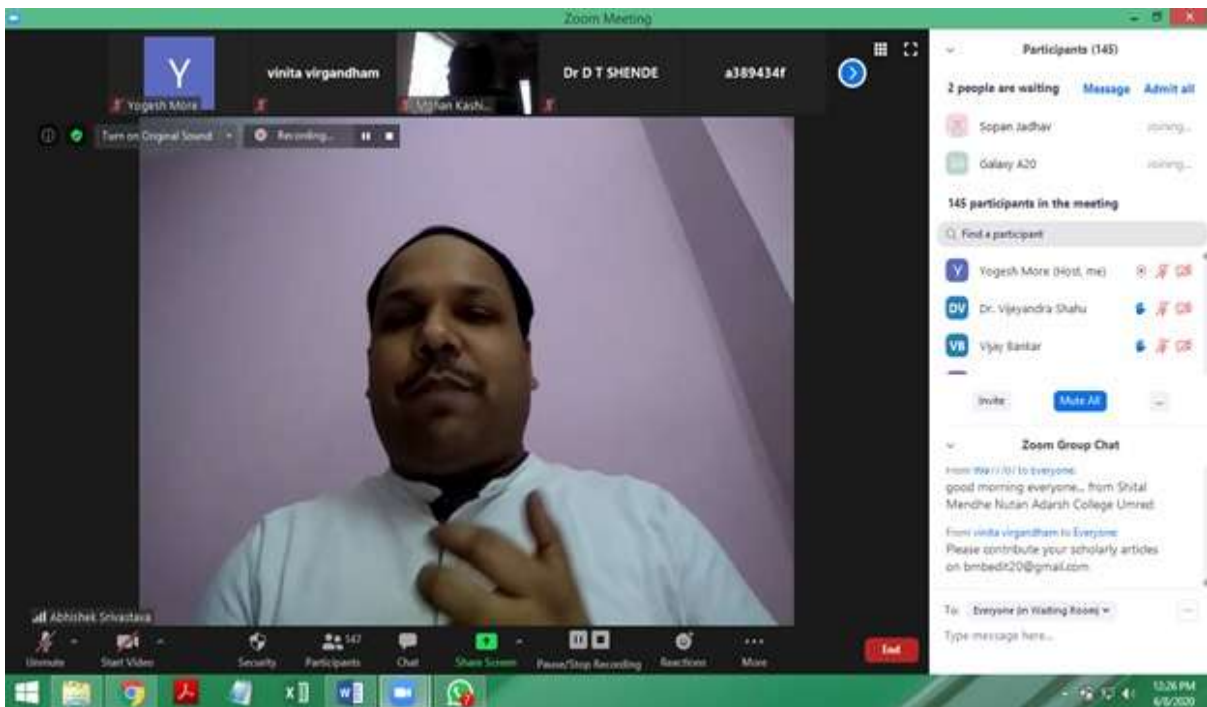
