BRIEF REPORT

As part of the Institutions' Vision and Mission Policies, the Principal, during the first meeting of the Staff Council, forms various Institute Level Committees every year covering Curricular, Co-curricular and Extra-Curricular activities for the holistic development of our students. Accordingly, the Principal constituted 'Subject Literary Association' for the Academic Session 2019-2020 in the first meeting of the Staff Council. Associate Prof. Dr. Madhukar Nandanwar was designated as the Member Secretary of the Committee while Asst. Prof. Someshwar Wasekar and Asst. Prof. Jyoti Bante were appointed as its Honorary Members. The Committee issued Circular on 6th October 2020 to all the Department Heads for conducting various students'-centric activities like Guest Lectures, Workshops, Students' Seminar, Workshops, Quiz Competitions, Elocution Competitions, and Debates etc. for the holistic development of our students. As such, the Committee instructed Heads of all the Departments to maintain their respective "Departmental Library" and "Issue-Return Register". Moreover, the Heads of all Departments were instructed to fix one "Display Board" at the entry gate of their Departments to showcase the creative activities and achievements of their students. As such, the Committee gave liberty to each Department to execute some innovative activities to ensure the holistic development of our students.



As per the Guidelines issued by the Committee concerned, the Subject Literary Associations of every subject in the Institution was intimated to submit the Master Plan of the activities to be undertaken through the "Subject Literary Association" during the Academic Session 2019-2020 on or before 20th October, 2020. The reports of the activities conducted under the "Subject Literary Association" of the respective Departments are as follows:

History Literary Association: - Asst. Prof. Dr. Motiraj Chavhan constituted the Executive Committee of 'History Subject Literary Association' under the guidance of Asst. Prof. Dr. M.R. Chavhan. The students of History Subject Literary Association were assigned with the task of preparing Project Works of compiling information regarding the Historical Forts in India. The Association conducted students' Seminar on various topics. As such, students were made aware of various Competitive Examinations. Students were impressed upon about the format and preparation of ensuing University Examinations.

The formal inauguration of 'History Subject Literary Association' was held on 16th October, 2019 at the hands of Associate Prof. Dr. Afroz Sheikh, Head, Department of History, Shri. Binzani City College, Nagpur. The Inaugural Ceremony was Chaired by Associate Prof. Dr. S.K. Shinde. Asst. Prof. Dr. Mangesh Kadu was prominently present on



the occasion. Associate Prof. Dr. Afroz Sheikh, in her Keynote Address, pointed out the significance of History subject in cracking various Competitive Examinations. Associate Prof. Dr. S.K. Shinde, while delivering his Presidential Address, appealed to the students to carry out various academic activities through the Literary Association of History. Asst. Prof. Dr. M.R. Chavhan, Head, Department of History, opined that History subject should be studied minutely and seriously to avail optimum benefit of the subject. All the students who opted for History subject marked their attendance in the Programme.

Subject Literary Association of Marathi: The 'Subject Literary Association' of Marathi was constituted under the guidance of Associate Prof. Dr. M.V. Nandanwar on 17th January, 2020. The Association encouraged the students to compose their own write-ups for publication in the College Magazine "Nirdhar". Department of Marathi maintained its Departmental Library and "Issue-Return Register". Students were encouraged to write articles, poems and other literary creations for publication in the College Magazine 'Nirdhar' in two languages, Marathi and English. Students were given information about objective type of questions in the University Examinations. This was done to familiarize the



students with the system of University Examinations. An Essay Writing Competition was conducted on 6th March 2020 in Marathi and English languages on the topic “Role of Youth in Nation Building”. The competition witnessed the attendance of 15 participants. Further, on 12th January, 2020 the “Literary Association of Marathi” organized written examination under the banner of “Gramgeeta Pravin”, which was conducted by “Gramgeeta Vikas Pariksha Vibhag, Gurukunj Ashram, Mozari, Dist: Amravati”. In all, 109 students of our Institution took part in this Examination.
