Quality Research Papers were invited from Research Scholars and Research Students who came from different Colleges and Universities across the country for publication in the Seminar Proceeding Book. A Committee, which consisted of thirteen staff members, was constituted with Dr. Mangesh Kadu as its Editor, for the purpose of publishing the Seminar proceeding Book. In all the Committee received 109 Research Papers for publication. The Committee short listed 90 Research Papers for publication. The Seminar Proceeding Book with ISBN No 978-81-927767-7-4 was published on 20/02/2017 at the hands of the dignitaries present on the occasion.




