### • **Guests and Dignitaries present in the program:**

A Two- Day Webinar on “Pandemics: Reshaping Geopolitics, Economics Realms and Socio Culture Dynamics” was conducted virtually on 7th and 8th June 2020 by IQAC of Bhiwapur College with Departments of Economics, Sociology, and Political Science. Renowned economist Dr. Srinivas Khandewale, a profound scholar of sociology, University of Mumbai. Dr. Balaji Kendre, and Dr. Abhishek Srivastava, a renowned thinker and scholar of Political Science were present as the Chief guest and resource persons. The program was presided over by the principal of the college, Dr. Jobi George.

### • **Guidance from dignitaries:**

In the first session, Dr. Balaji Kendre of Mumbai University, an eminent scholar of sociology, expressed his views on the topic “Pandemics: Reshaping Geopolitics, Economics Realms and Socio Culture Dynamics”, and highlighted on cultural and social development in India due to the Corona crisis. Since its inception B.C.Y.R.C. has blossomed into seventeen educational institutions all over Vidarbha imparting Higher Education in all the branches of learning. Bhiwapur Taluka is a typical rural place with 137 villages and it is close to the tribal dominated forest area. The town is 72 K.M. away from Nagpur. Bhiwapur Mahavidyalaya, which is affiliated to Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University, Nagpur was established in 1990 through Arts Faculty with the noble vision of imparting education to the rural youths for enabling them to learn locally and flourish globally in spite of the evils of poverty and inaccessibility. Subsequently Faculty of Commerce and Management and Faculty of Science were added in 2002 and 2012 respectively. Post Graduate courses in Economics, Political Science and Sociology are functional from 2004. 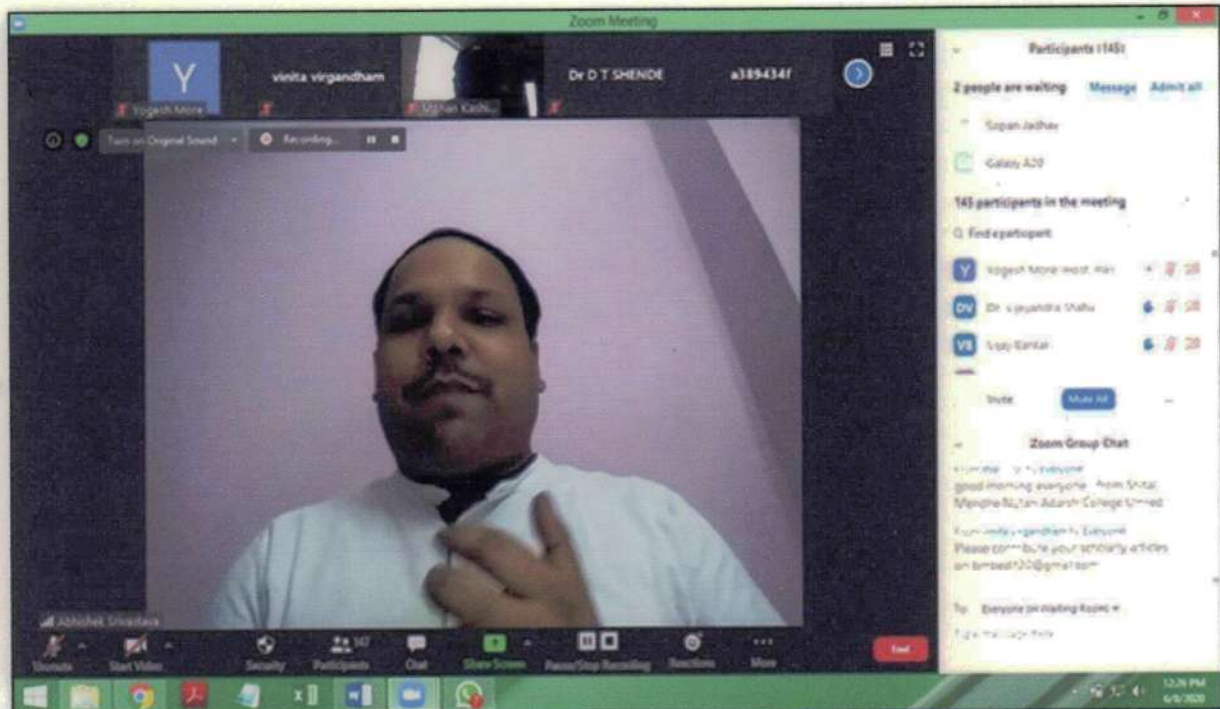

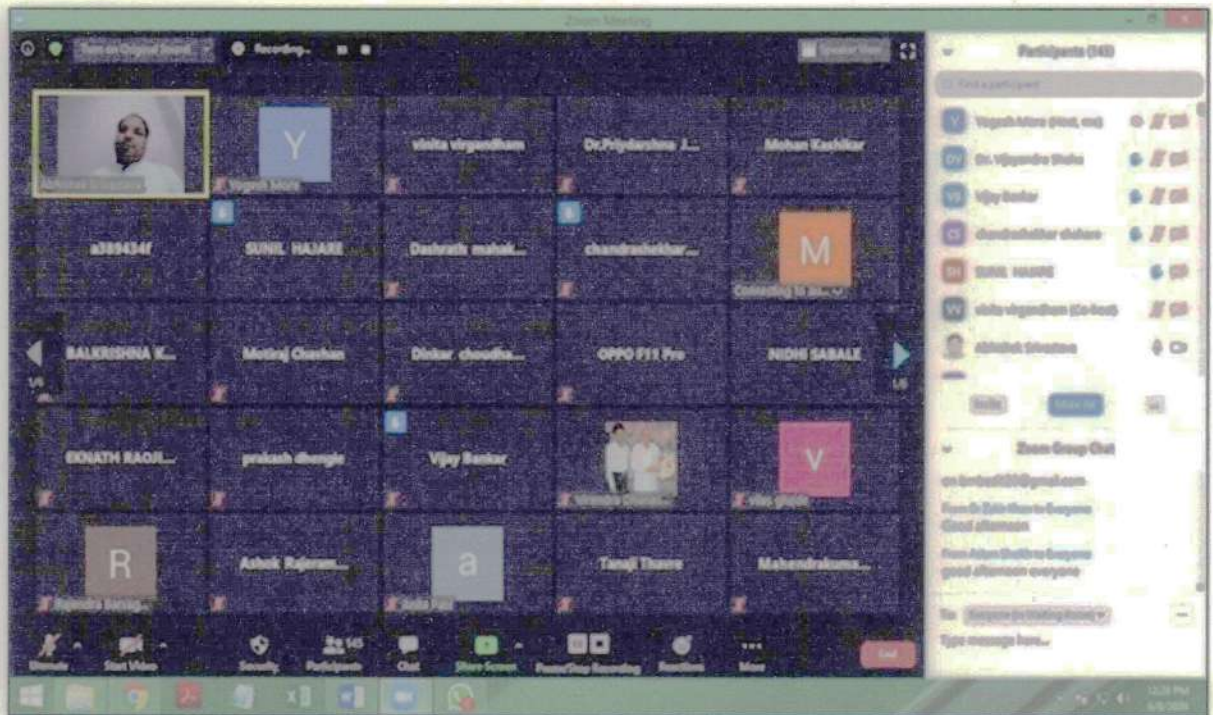
