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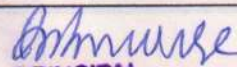

Boards/Smart Boards Etc.)'of Bhiwapur Mahavidyalaya, Bhiwapur had adopted various measures to raise the level of Digital consciousness of students. Since March 2020, the entire world came to a standstill and was under lockdown. The Pandemic forced pedagogy to trust and utilize ICT enabled Teaching-Learning process.

Online teaching was the only mode to continue the dissemination of knowledge. The faculty resorted to using different ICT tools through online classes using Google Meet, Zoom App, and Webex Meet. WhatsApp was the quickest mode to connect with the learners as the examinations were approaching.

The College Computer Lab and Language Laboratory hold a total of 49 Computers. The One Student One Skill Programme (OSOSP) Committee proposed 22 Skill-based Courses, out of which Tally and Web Designing are ICT based. The proposed Skill-oriented Courses were stalled due to Pandemic restrictions. The University and College level examinations were conducted online.

A Guest Lecture was organized on 17th February, 2021. Mr. Murlidhar Jambhulkar (Chartered Accountant) guided the students on the role of Computer in business and also gave basic information on Google Drive, Hardware, Software, Data Base, Antivirus of Operating System, Networking, Domain Name, Google Search Engine, Types of Famous Search Engines, M.S. Excel, M.S. Access etc. He also explained the journey of computer. In all 68 students were benefited from this programme.

The Library and Information Centre of Bhiwapur Mahavidyalaya, Bhiwapur, under the aegis of Internal Quality Assurance Cell, organized an Online Quiz Competition Series from 15-10-2020 to 30/01/2021 on the theme "News Paper Reading Habits among the Students". There were 25 General Knowledge questions given in the Google form through Online mode. In all 196 students were benefited from this programme.

National Webinar on "Stress Management of Students during COVID- 19 Pandemic" was organized by Faculty of Science under the aegis of Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Bhiwapur Mahavidyalaya, Bhiwapur on 27th May, 2020 at 7.00 P.M on ZOOM App. In all 958 participants including 542 students, 388 teachers and 28 parents got registered for this Webinar.

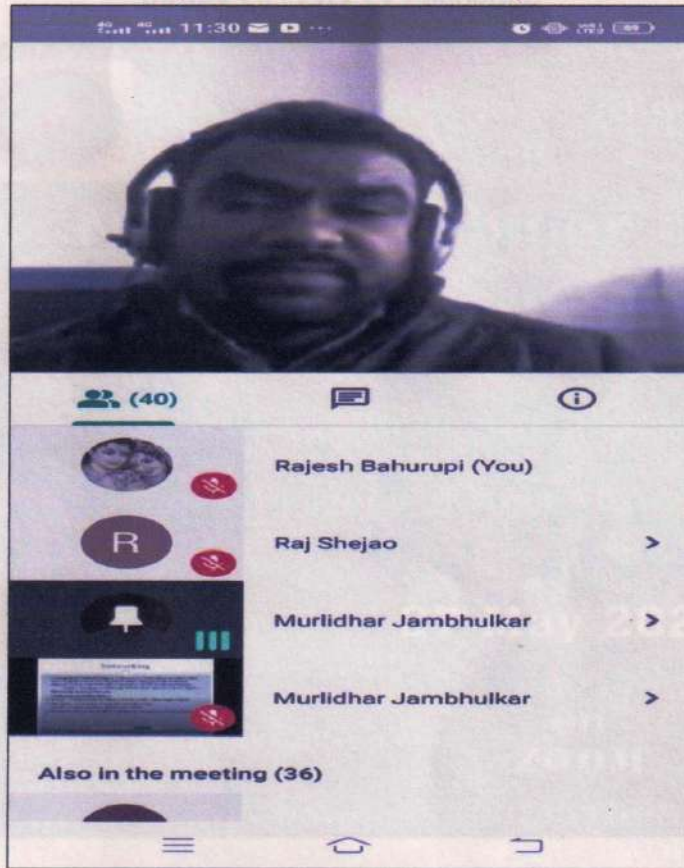
