Online teaching was the only mode to continue the dissemination of knowledge. The faculty resorted to using different ICT tools through online classes using Google Meet, Zoom App, and Webex Meet. WhatsApp was the quickest mode to connect with the learners as the examinations were approaching.

The College Computer Lab and Language Laboratory hold atotal of 49 Computers. The One Student One Skill Programme (OSOSP) Committee proposed 22 Skill-based Courses, out of which Tally and Web Designing are ICT based. The proposed Skill-oriented Courses were stalled due to Pandemic restrictions. The University and College level examinations were conducted online.




