Agenda No. 2:

To discuss the stress faced by the student in the situation caused by Covid-19.

Resolution no. 2:

Parents and Teachers participated in the discussion on the above topic. The Institution was closed due to lockdown restrictions and students found themselves stressed as they were away from teaching. The Parents and Teachers expressed the opinion that this situation has had an adverse effect on the studious and intelligent students. In order to reduce the stress on the students, it was unanimously resolved that the Parents should inform the Teachers about their children under stress and avail counselling from the faculty of the college.

Agenda No. 3:

Students using Mobile Phones for online classes. Paying attention to the misuse of Mobile Phones.

Resolution no. 3:

While participating in the discussion in accordance with the above topics, many Parents and Teachers also pointed out in the meeting that the students used the Mobile Phones provided for playing games, chatting with friends for hours, watching obscene clips and videos instead of using it for teaching – learning. Therefore, the resolution



was unanimously passed by deciding that every parent should be vigilant and pay attention to their child use of mobile phone.

Agenda No. 4:

Students have been home for two years due to Covid-19. Discussing that many students have gone into addiction during this time.

Resolution no. 4:

Colleges were closed for almost one and a half to two years due to Covid-19. Therefore, during this time, many Students have moved away from education and turned to alcohol, Ghutka, Tobacco, Kharra, Mobile phone indecency etc.

Agenda No. 5:

Students did not come to college even after receiving two doses of vaccine. Discussion on their absence.

Resolution no. 5:

As per instructions given by the Maharashtra Government to the Universities and Colleges to Conduct Physical Classes from October 20, 2021, the college was opened for students who had taken two doses following the guidelines of Covid-19. While discussing that the students did not come to the College regularly even after giving repeated instructions and information to the Students and Parents, some Parents said that their ward has not completed 18 years of age, some parents said that their child has completed only one dose and some said that their wards have completed two doses and they are coming to the college. While Participating in this discussion, the Teachers brought to the attention of the Parents that many children do not come to the College even after receiving two doses, so it was decided in this meeting that the Teachers should contact the students who have completed two doses and try to get other eligible students vaccinated.

Agenda No. 6:

Discussion on students who not taking admission and also not filling Scholarship form within the stipulated date

Resolution no. 6:

While participating in the discussion regarding the above topic, Hon. Principal pointed out to the meeting that the students are not even taking admission and filling the scholarship form within the stipulated time. And as per the discussion in this meeting, while expressing the opinion that all the parents should be aware about this, so that the Students and Parents are not bothered. A resolution was passed that a unit under the Chief Clerk will be created in the College



and the forms of the students will be filled within the stipulated time.

Agenda No. 7:

To sensitize the Parents that the examination forms will be filled within time.

Resolution no. 7:

While discussing on above topic Hon. Principal and Teachers pointed out to Parents that their wards do not fill up examination form within the stipulated time and also pointed out that many students do not come regularly to the college so they do not even know the date of filling the examination form. Therefore, this meeting unanimously decided that the parents should send their child to the college regularly and personally visit intermittently to check whether their child's exam form has been filled or not.

Agenda No. 8:

Any other matter with the permission of the Chair.

Resolution no. 8:

With the permission of the chair the resolution was unanimously passed after a detailed discussion in the meeting on the subject brought up on time.

1) Due to Covid-19 many students suffered academic losses. Therefore, additional online classes will be conducted for students who are affected.

2) It was decided to complete the vaccination of the college students through face-to-face contact with the eligible Student through Teachers for those who have not received any dose and those who have received one dose.
