merged and titled as Internal Complaint Committee (ICC) in accordance with the Guidelines of Government of Maharashtra and the Directions of Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University, Nagpur. The Committee consists of nine members: one member secretary, two Faculty members, two Non-teaching Representatives, One External member and three Students' Representatives. The process of including girl students in the Committee is implemented through election process. A Meeting of ICC was arranged on 10-03-2022 to discuss and plan various activities for Girl Students and women.

Till the compilation of this Annual Report, no complaint was received from the girl students/working women in Bhiwapur Mahavidyalaya.

Activity Report

Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University's N.S.S Department and Bhiwapur Mahavidyalaya's National Service Scheme Unit and Internal Complaint Committee jointly organized One Day Workshop on 'Youth Power for a Prosperous India' as part of Azadi ka Amrut Mahotsav celebrating India's 75 years of Independence.

In the Second Session of the One Day Workshop, the N.S.S Volunteers and the participating dignitaries were guided by renowned Scholar, Literary Personality and Poetess Prof. Vijaya Marotkar. It was Prof. Vijaya Marotkar's 300th Programme. She said, "To be restless at the moment of success is to be stagnant in life. A student should find the 'me' in me, should be able to recognize the opportunity". She further told the participants to decide and set their

goals and they should have a clear direction to achieve their goals. Besides, how the students can reach great heights without realizing their own abilities. She spoke while giving guidance on the topic of 'Pori Zara Japoon', (Trans. Girls, Be Cautious) the crisis caused by mobile phones, the reasons for the increasing violence against girls and how we should act cautiously by warning girls, made them aware by giving examples of various girls. The Programme was presided over by Associate Prof. Dr. Sunil Shinde.

Prof. Vijaya Marotkar, in her speech said that both men and women have equal rights in the workplaces. However, women face more discrimination as compared to men. Women should be protected in the workplaces. Rather, they should be protected from all sorts of discrimination and violence while discharging their duties and responsibilities.

She also spoke about increased and strong demands for addressing issues related to violence against women, as the number of such cases is alarmingly rising in India.

Prof. Vijaya Marotkar talked about lack of self confidence in women, due to which, they have been socialized and are customized to suffer in silence.

She also talked about the need for having appropriate dressing pattern for the girl students. This would create a congenial environment in the working place.
