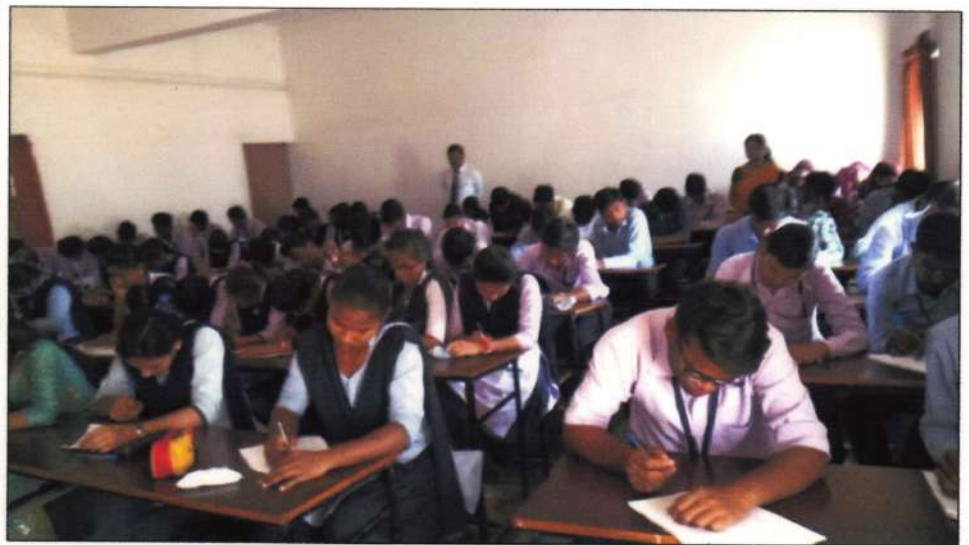

BRIEF REPORT

The Library and Information Centre is situated in the Administrative Building of the College. The Central Library is well-equipped with different types of Reference Books, Text Books, Journals, Periodicals, Magazines, E-books, Old Question Papers, and Internet facility, Regional and National Newspapers, Minor Research Projects, Major Research Projects.

The College has constituted a Library Committee, which comprises of members from teaching, non-teaching staff, and students' representatives. The Committee holds its meetings as per the Academic Calendar of the Institution. Every year, the Central Library prepares its Annual Budget and gets it approved from the College Development Committee (C.D.C.). According to the Department-wise budgetary provisions, on submission of the Demand List of Books as per the University's revised syllabus from the Heads of various Departments, the Librarian places purchase order to the vender after getting approval from the Principal. Towards the end of each Semester, students are required to obtain 'No Dues Certificates' from the Library, to collect their Hall Tickets from the College for appearing in the University Examinations. For promoting the reading habits of students and teachers, 'Library Orientation Programme' is organized every year. The Central Library maintains the visit record of all its stakeholders by obtaining their signatures on the Register. Post Graduate students are allowed to visit the Stack Room and choose books as per



their requirement.

Students are issued books as per the norms set by the 'Library Committee'. Once a book is issued; the student can keep it for seven days. Upon submission of the book in the Library, the student can avail the book for another term of seven days. If the student fails to submit the book in the library within the due date, the student has to remit late fee as per the rules of the Central Library.

Subscription of Journals

The Heads of various Departments, in consultation with other faculties of the respective Departments, recommend the titles of Journals for subscription in the Central Library. Upon receipt of recommendations, the Librarian procured the Proforma Invoice via email. After consultation and financial sanction from the Principal, the Proforma invoice was forwarded to the Account Section for subsequent action. Upon receipt of the Journals, its content pages were sent to the respective Faculties for information. They were encouraged to visit the Library regularly and avail the maximum benefits of the Journals subscribed. During the Academic Session 2018-2019, the 'Central Library' subscribed 12 Journals of International Repute. In addition to this, the 'Central Library' subscribed 7 News Papers, one Rozgar Samachar and one Employment News.

N-LIST MEMBERSHIP

N-list membership facility is renewed regularly for the users



in the Library by following all the procedures. Membership details are uploaded in the N-list website and all staff members are provided with their respective passwords for further use.

BOOK BANK SCHEME

The Central Library has a mechanism to issue books to students under its Book Bank Scheme for one Semester or for the whole Academic Year. Accordingly, the Central Library issued books to the needy students as per its set norms. Whoever is interested to obtain books under the Book Bank Scheme, is required to remit the cost of the Book in the Central Library. Upon submission of the Book, the amount deposited thereon, is given back after deducting only 10% of the total cost of the Book. Many students availed this facility of the Central Library.

REPROGRAHY FACILITY

Reprography Facility is made available in the Central Library. The Library charges only Rs.1 per copy, which is less as compared to professional venders in the market.

UGC NET WORK RESOURCE CENTRE

Seven Internet-enabled Computers are made available for the students in the UGC Net Work Resource Centre. This facility is introduced for enhancing the computer literacy among students.

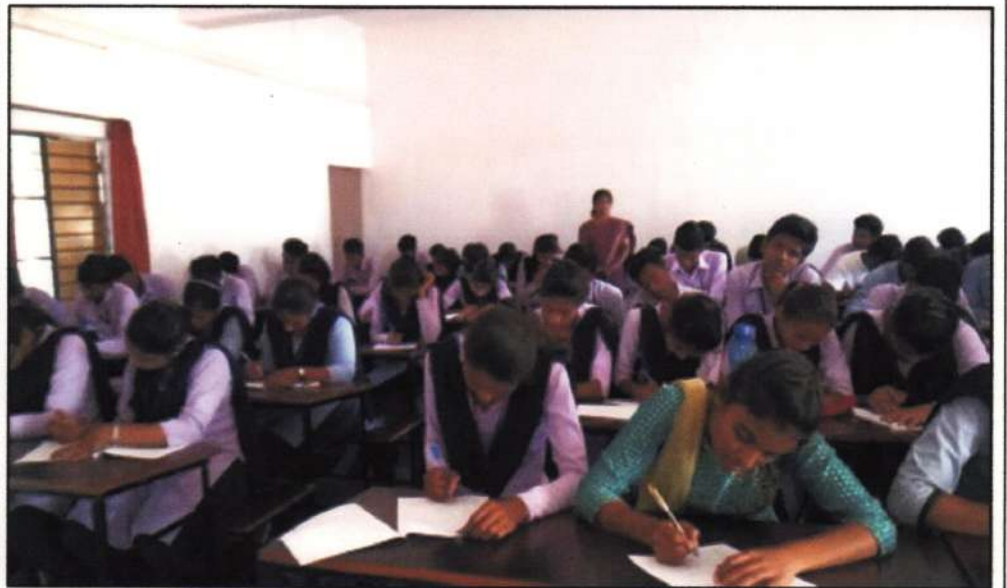

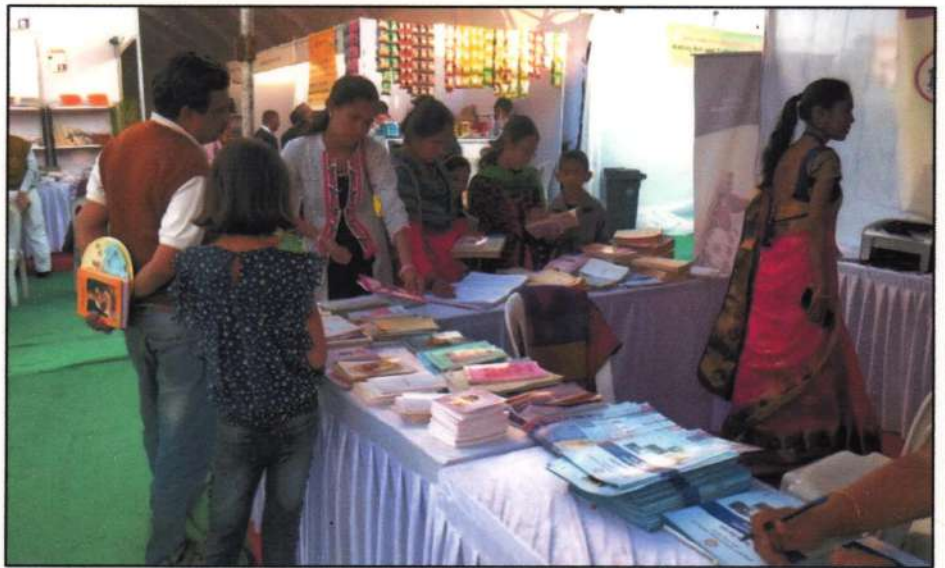

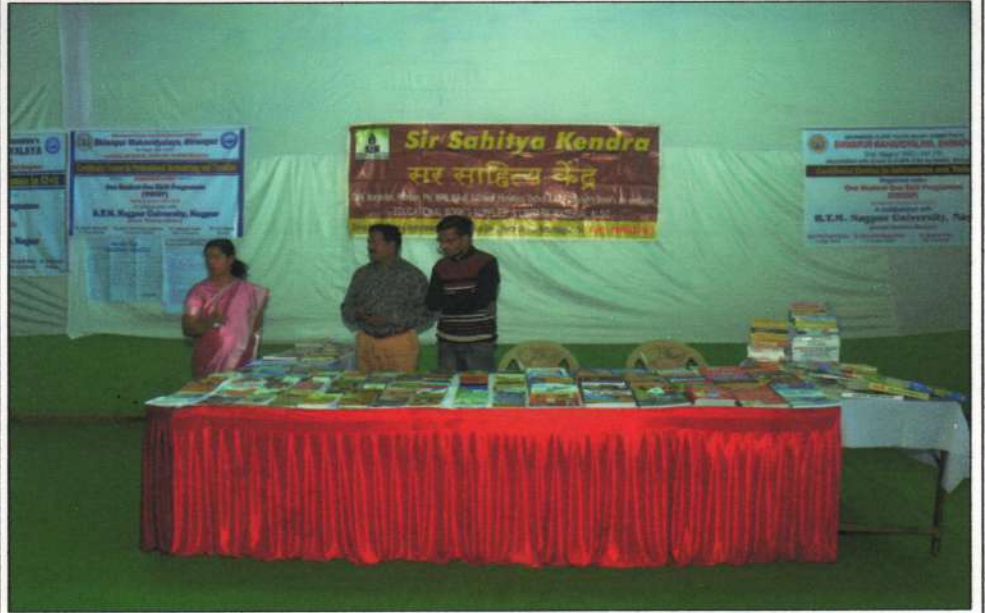

BRIEF REPORT

The Library and Information Centre is situated in the Administrative Building of the College. The Central Library is well-equipped with different types of Reference Books, Text Books, Journals, Periodicals, Magazines, E-books, Old Question Papers, Internet facility, Regional and National Newspapers, Minor Research Projects and Major Research Projects.

The College has constituted a Library Committee, which comprises of members from teaching, non-teaching staff, and students' representatives. The Committee holds its meetings as per the Academic Calendar of the Institution. Every year, the Central Library prepares its Annual Budget and gets it approved from the College Development Committee (C.D.C.). According to the Department-wise budgetary provisions, on submission of the Demand List of Books as per the University's revised syllabus from the Heads of various Departments, the Librarian places purchase order to the vender after getting approval from the Principal. Towards the end of each Semester, students are required to obtain 'No Dues Certificates' from the Library, to collect their Hall Tickets from the College for appearing in the University Examinations. For promoting reading habits of students and teachers, 'Library Orientation Programme' is organized every year. The Central Library maintains the visit record of all its stakeholders by obtaining their signatures on the Register. Post Graduate students are allowed to visit the Stack Room and choose books of their choice.



Students are issued books as per the norms set by the 'Library Committee'. Once a book is issued; the student can keep it for seven days. Upon submission of the book in the Library, the student can avail the book for another term of seven days. If the student fails to submit the book in the library within the due date, the student has to remit late fee as per the rules of the Central Library.

Subscription of Journals

The Heads of various Departments, in consultation with other faculties of the respective Departments, recommend the titles of Journals for subscription in the Central Library. Upon receipt of recommendations, the Librarian procured the Proforma Invoice via email. After consultation and financial sanction from the Principal, the Proforma invoice was forwarded to the Account Section for subsequent action. Upon receipt of the Journals, its content pages were sent to the respective Faculties for information. They were encouraged to visit the Library regularly and avail the maximum benefits of the Journals subscribed. During the Academic Session 2019-2020, the 'Central Library' subscribed 13 Journals of International Repute. In addition to this, the 'Central Library' subscribed 7 News Papers, one Rozgar Samachar and one Employment News.

N-LIST MEMBERSHIP

N-list Membership facility is renewed regularly for the users in the Library by following all the procedures. Membership



details are uploaded in the N-list Website and password is given to every staff member for further use.

BOOK BANK SCHEME

The Central Library has a mechanism to issue books to students under its flagship Book Bank Scheme for one Semester or for the whole Academic Year. Accordingly, the Central Library issued books to the needy students as per its set norms. Whoever is interested to obtain books under the Book Bank Scheme, is required to remit the cost of the Book in the Central Library. Upon submission of the Book, the amount deposited thereon, is given back after deducting only 10% of the total cost of the Book. Many students availed this facility of the Central Library.

REPROGRAHY FACILITY

Reprography Facility is made available in the Central Library. The Library charges only Rs.1 per copy, which is less as compared to professional venders in the market.

UGC NET WORK RESOURCE CENTRE

Seven Internet-enabled Computers are made available for the students in the UGC Net Work Resource Centre. This facility is introduced for enhancing Computer Literacy among students.

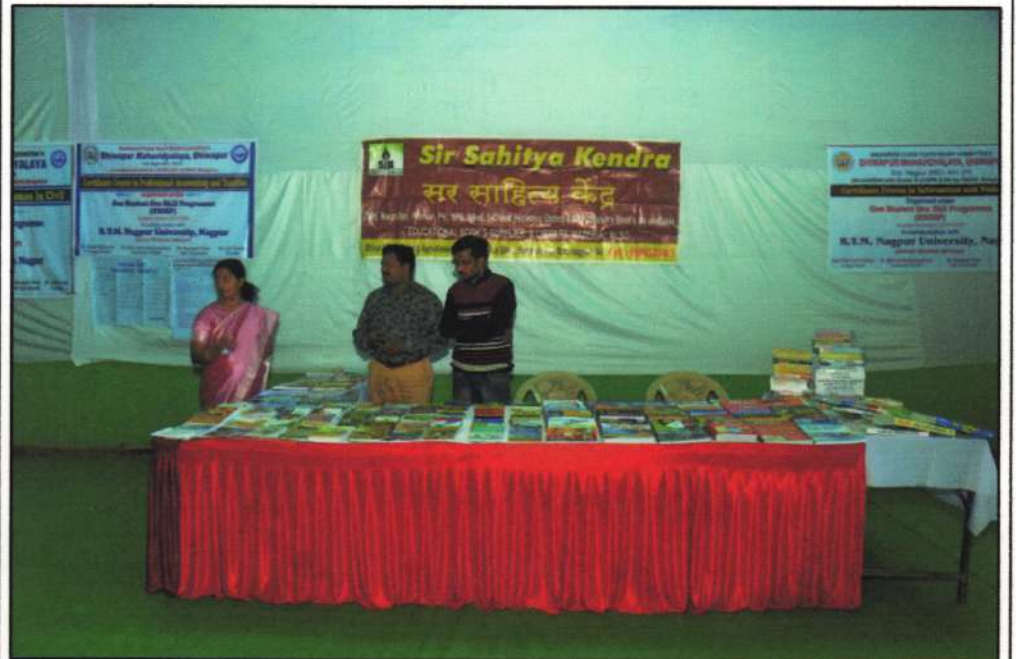

BRIEF REPORT


Library and Information Centre of Bhiwapur Mahavidyalaya, Bhiwapur organized Three Days' Online Workshop on "Developing your own Moodle Site", from 10/02/2022 to 12/02/2022. The programme was co-ordinated by Asst. Prof. Dr. Rajasree.O.P, the Librarian and Organizing Secretary. Dr. (Mrs.) Rekha Sharma, Associate Professor, Human Resource Development Centre, Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University, Nagpur was the Resource Person of the Programme. Dr. Jobi George, Principal of Bhiwapur Mahavidyalaya, Bhiwapur, presided over the function.

Dr. (Mrs.) Rekha Sharma, on the First Day of the Online Training Programme on 10th February, 2022, emphasized on the importance of Moodle Site creation and Learning Management System for teachers in the current scenario via power point presentation followed by hands on session. She taught creation of Moodle site in the Gnomio Platform, uploading resumes and photographs and details in the Moodle site.

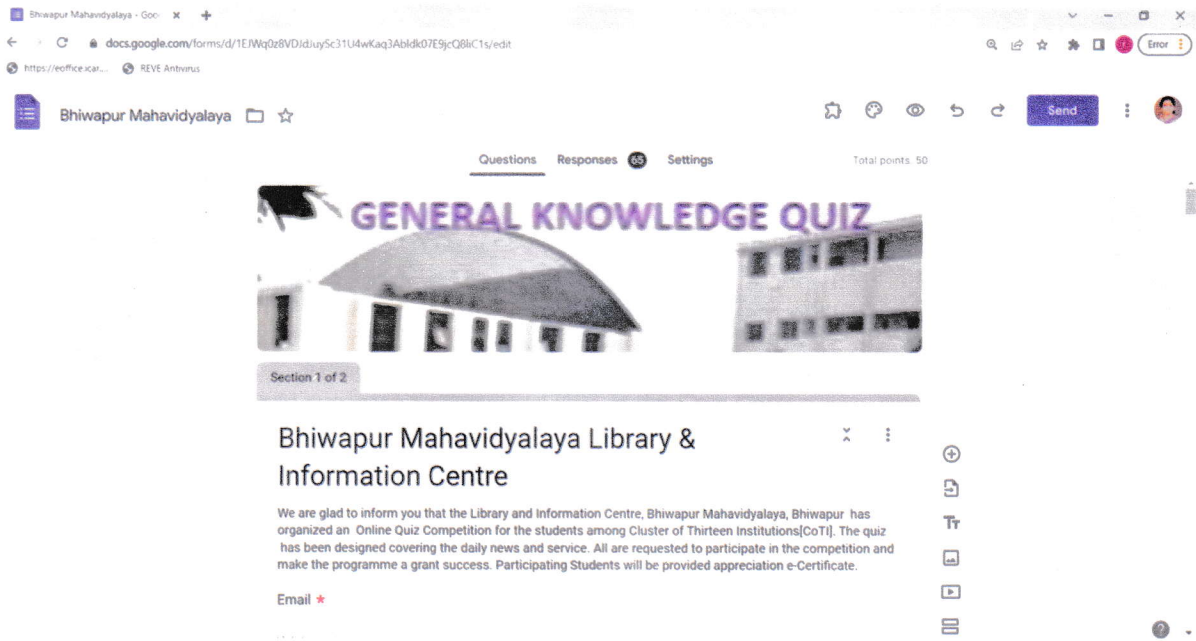
Objectives

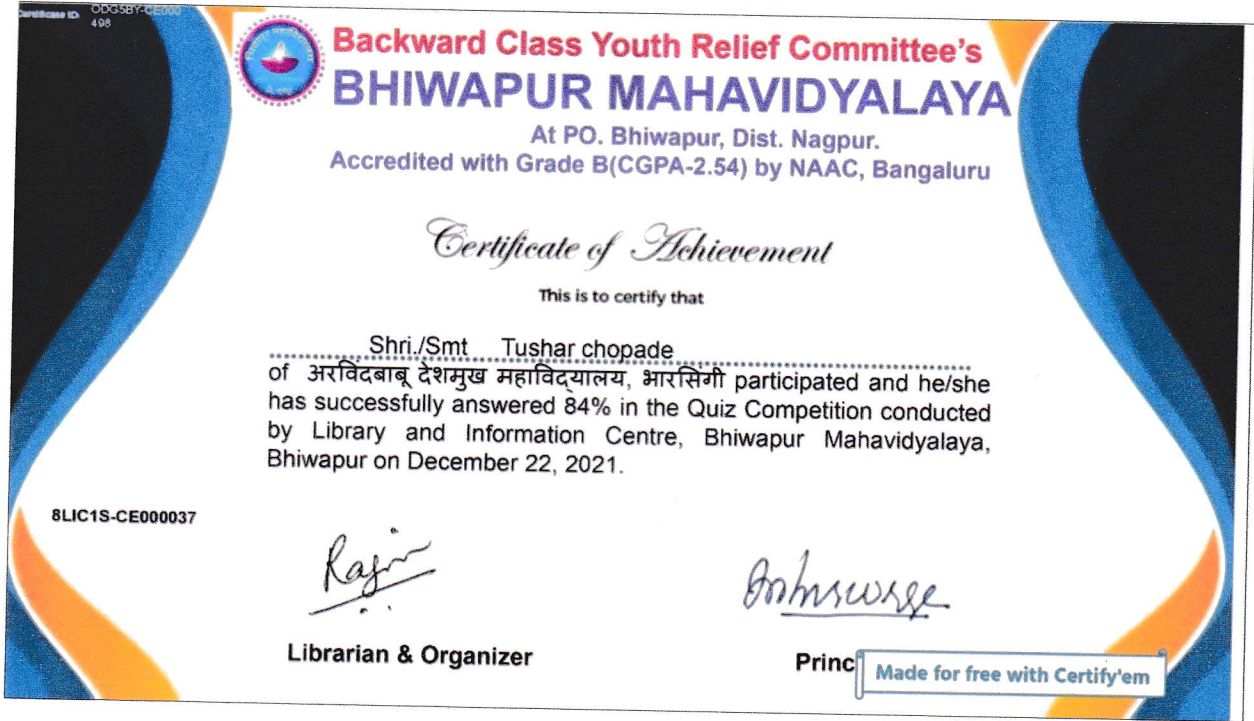


Fig.: Specimen copy of e-certificate issued to participant

We have constituted a Library Committee, which comprises of members from teachers, non-teaching staff, and students' representatives, and the Committee holds its meetings as per the Academic Calendar of the Institution. Every year, the Central Library prepares its Annual Budget and gets it approved from the College Development Committee. According to the Department-wise budgetary provisions, upon submission of the Demand List of Books as per the University's revised syllabus from the Heads of various Departments, the Librarian places purchase order to the vender after getting approval from the Principal. Towards the end of each Semester, students are required to obtain 'No Dues Certificates' from the Library for appearing in the University's Examinations. For promoting the reading habits of students and teachers, Library Orientation Programme is organized every year. The Central Library maintains the visit record of all its stakeholders by obtaining their signatures on the Register. All other issues, if any, are resolved by the Library Committee. Post Graduate students are allowed to visit the Stack Room and choose books as per their needs.

Students are issued books as per the norms. Once a book is issued; the student can keep it for seven days. Upon submission of the book in the Library, the student can avail the book for another term of seven days. If the student fails to submit the book in the library within the due date, the student has to remit late fee as per the rules of the Central Library.

Subscription of Journals

The Heads of various Departments, in consultation with other faculties of the respective Departments, recommend the titles of Journals for subscription in the Central Library. Upon receipt of recommendations, the Librarian procured the Proforma Invoice via email. After consultation and financial sanction from the Principal, the Proforma invoice was forwarded to the Account Section for subsequent action. Upon receipt of the Journals, its content pages were sent to the Faculties for information. They were encouraged to visit the Library regularly and make the maximum benefits of the Journals subscribed. During the Academic Session 2021-2022, we subscribed 13 Journals of International Repute. In addition to this, the Central Library subscribed 3 News Papers, one Rozgar Samachar and one Employment News.



N-LIST MEMBERSHIP

N-list membership facility is renewed regularly for the users in the Library by following all the procedures. Membership details are uploaded in the N-list website and further the password of each Faculty is given for further use.

BOOK BANK SCHEME

The Central Library has a mechanism to issue books to students under its Book Bank Scheme for one Semester or for the whole year. Accordingly, the Central Library issued books to the needy students as per its set norms. Whoever is interested to obtain books under the Book bank Scheme, is required to remit the cost of the Book in the Central Library. Upon submission of the Book, the amount deposited thereon, is given back after deducting only 10% of the total cost of the Book. Many students availed this facility of the Library.

REPROGRAHY FACILITY

Reprography Facility is made available in the Central Library. The Library charges only Rs.1 per copy, which is less as compared to professional venders.

UGC NET WORK RESOURCE CENTRE

Seven Internet-enabled Computers are made available for the students in the UGC Net Work Resource Centre. This facility is introduced for enhancing the knowledge of students in Computer education.

Online Quiz Competition

The Library and Information Centre of Bhiwapur Mahavidyalaya, Bhiwapur, under the aegis of IQAC, organized an Online Quiz Competition in collaboration with the Cluster of Thirteen Institutions (COTI) for the benefit of students. There was good response for the programme from the students and faculties. The online mode had been chosen considering the difficulties of participants in attending the event in offline mode due to COVID-19 Pandemic Protocols. Latest General Knowledge questions were chosen for the Quiz Competition. Sixty four candidates participated in this Quiz Competition,



which was organised on 22/12/2021.

Online Workshop on “Develop your own Moodle Site”

- To help the students to save time and resources.



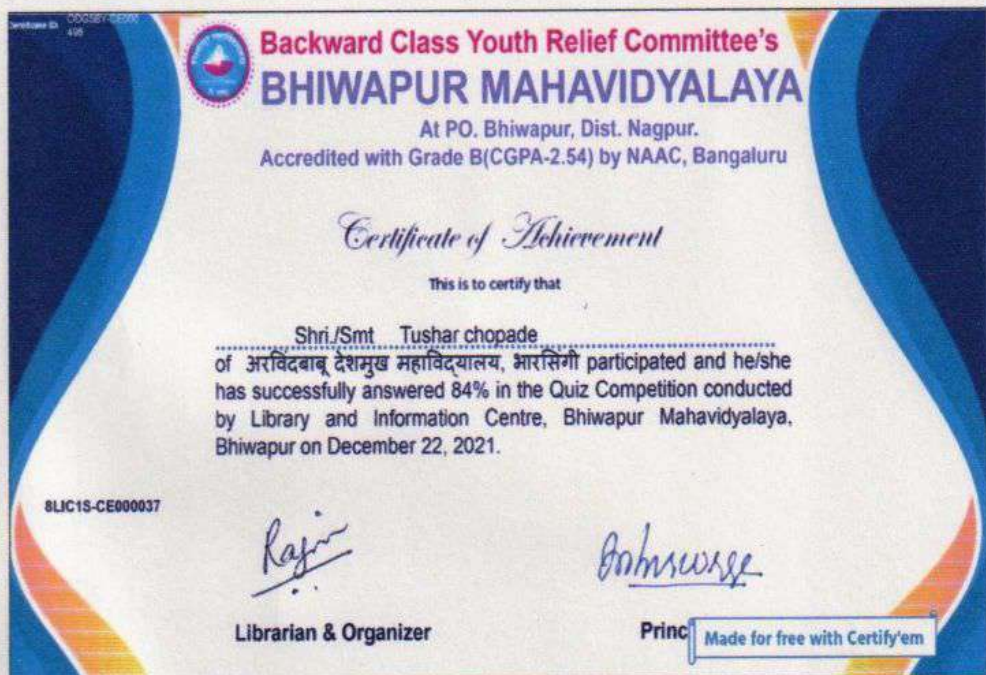

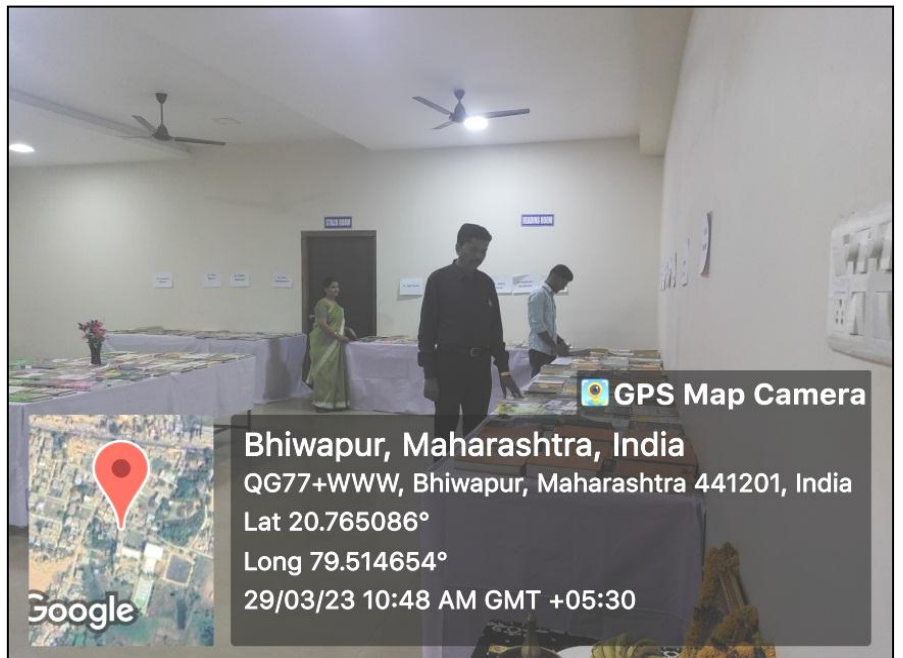

Gopakumar has completed his Ph.D. from Mangalore University after his BSc in Botany and MLISc (Library and Information Science). Dr. V. Gopakumar has expertise in Software related to academics, library and digital content creation. He has developed digital content of various types and has been imparting training in the digital content development area during Refresher Courses in various Universities. He has 27 Research Articles and three books to his credit. He has translated two Kannada novels of Dr. V. Shivarama Karanth to Malayalam. He has organized several Workshops, Refresher Courses, and three International Conferences namely CALIBER 2011, Library Technology Conclave, and iKOAL 2018. Presently Dr. V. BRIEF REPORT	<p>The Library and Information Centre of our College, in collaboration with a Cluster of Thirteen Institutions (CoTI), organized a One-day Workshop on 27th April, 2023 entitled “Creating an Exhaustive Reading List for Research” through Online Mode. The Programme was coordinated by Asst. Prof. Dr. Rajasree O.P., the Librarian and Organizing Secretary, while Dr. V. Gopakumar, the University Librarian and Head of the Knowledge Centre at Digital University of Science, Technology, and Innovation, Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala, served as the Resource Person.</p> <p>Dr. Jobi George, the Principal of Bhiwapur Mahavidyalaya, Bhiwapur, presided over the function. Dr. V. Gopakumar, the Keynote Speaker, emphasized on the changes in libraries and their resources. In the 1990s, users relied primarily on books and journals for references, but in today’s world, digital resources have taken over. The Internet and associated technologies have revolutionized the way people search for information. Overcoming barriers of distance, time, and language; information can now be distributed globally.</p> <p>Previously, Information Scientists dreamt of having control over</p>

	<p>the flow of information, but with the advent of Internet, the amount of information being produced and disseminated, has become tremendous and difficult to control. This phenomenon is known as the Information Explosion, leading to everyone facing information overload.</p> <p>Researchers are particularly affected by this overload as they heavily rely on previous Research reports. Identifying relevant Research reports amidst the vast amount of information available, has become a daunting task. However, technology is assisting us in identifying documents that are relevant to our Research topics through the use of digital tools. This Session was aimed to teach the participants how to create an exhaustive list of journal articles on a specific Research topic.</p> <p>Dr. V. Gopakumar introduced the Mendeley Digital Library, highlighting that its membership is free. He explained how to download digital resources and save them in the Library for future use. He also discussed creating plagiarism-free articles using direct speech and emphasized the use of browsers search in the Mendeley Library. Additionally, he provided insights into the Outlook library Website. In all, 45 participants marked their attendance in the Workshop. Asst. Prof. Dr. Rajasree. O.P, Librarian and Organizing Secretary, proposed the formal Vote of Thanks.</p>

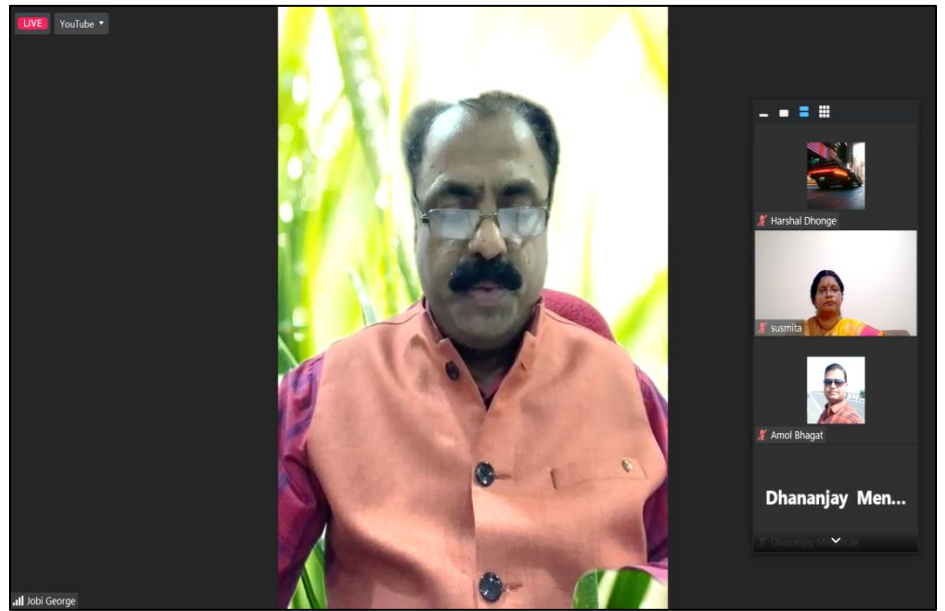

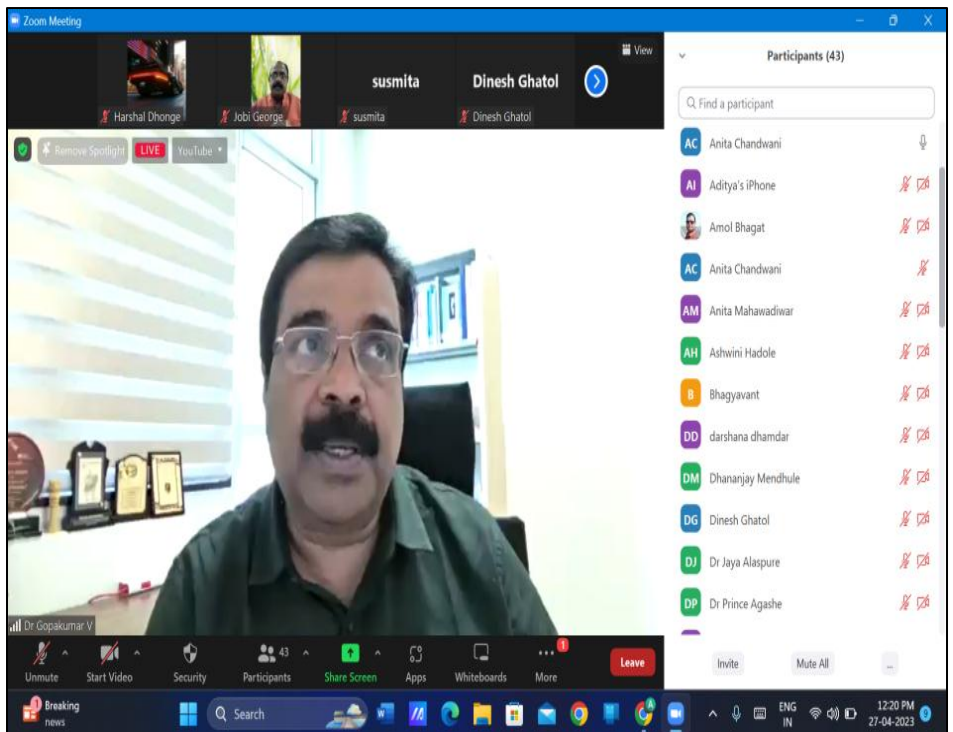

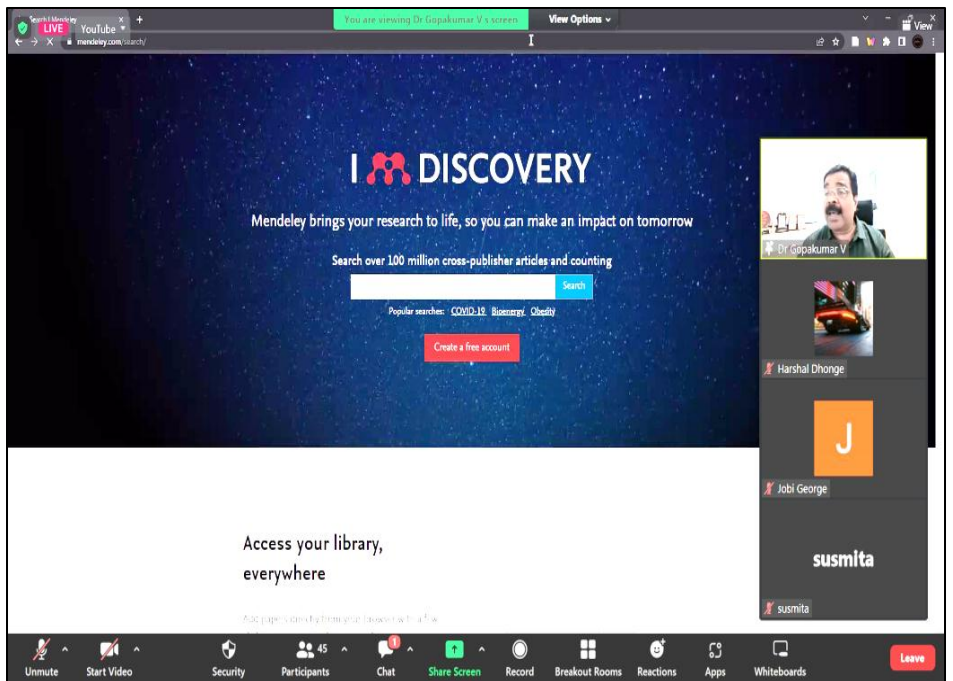

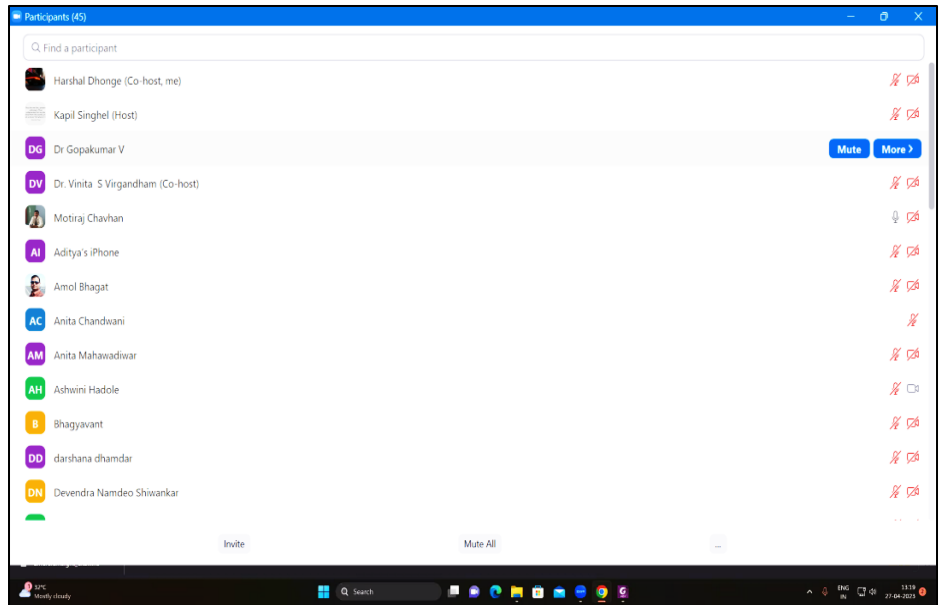
