### **BRIEF REPORT**

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The IQAC of our Institution is instrumental in implementing various innovative teaching-learning practices in our through Institution Information and Communication Technology (ICT), Audio-Visual-Aids, CDs, Internet and free Computer Training Programmes for the students. To facilitate the same, "Committee For Promoting the use of Technology in Teaching and also for Establishing Complete Students' Computer Literacy Programme (Audio Visual Aids-LCD, OHP, Interactive Boards/Smart Boards Etc.)", was constituted for the Academic Session 2018-19. The Committee encouraged teachers to undertake ICT enabled Teaching-Learning process for effective curriculum delivery. The Committee had initiated Free Computer Literacy Programme for the students. Under this flagship Training Programme, teachers supported the students in learning the basics of Computer Application and Internet operations.

The Committee maintained data of teachers who incorporated ICT in their teaching-learning process:

- In August-2018, Asst. Prof. Dr. Nitisha Patankar, Asst. Prof. Dr. S. Dhote, Asst. Prof. A. Kalbandhe and Asst. Prof. Dr. V. Vinita Virgandham used ICT tools for conducting their classes.
- In September-2018, Asst. Prof. Dr. M.R. Chavhan, Asst. Prof. Dr. R. K. Quraishi, Asst. Prof. Dr. R. Bahurupi, Asst. Prof. S. Wasekar, Asst. Prof. Dr. N. Patankar, Asst. Prof. Dr. S. Dhote and Asst. Prof. Dr. V. Virgandham used ICT tools for conducting their classes.

conducting their classes.

Initially, the Committee procured the data of students with basic Computer knowledge. The Committee excluded those students who had already obtained the basic knowledge of Computer from the Training Programme. Further, the Committee sought the assistance of Computer literate students to impart training to all the remaining students who were lagging behind in basic Computer knowledge. For providing the basic Computer knowledge to students, the Committee divided students into small groups of 20/30/40 and engaged one teacher for conducting the Training Programme. The Committee prepared the list of students on the basis of Optional Subjects of First Year, Second Year and Final Year and accordingly divided the students into groups of 20/30/40. The College has State-of-the-Art infrastructure to cater free Computer Training to students. Each teacher was given the responsibility of teaching the basics of Computer Application to a certain number of students during the off periods. This practice had enabled the College to increase the Computer literacy rate of students. The Committee monitored the classes engaged by all the teachers with the help of Audio-Visual Aids. As such, the Committee allowed outstanding students with basic Computer Knowledge to demonstrate their skills with the help of Interactive Boards.



Graphical representation of students with basic Computer Knowledge in Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com)





Graphical representation of students with basic Computer Knowledge in









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

BRIEF REPORT	The IQAC is instrumental in implementing various innovative teaching practices in our Institution through Information and Communication Technology (ICT), Audio-Visual-Aids, CDs, Internet and free Computer Training Programmes for students. To facilitate the same, "Committee For Promoting the use of Technology in Teaching and also for Establishing Complete Students' Computer Literacy Programme (Audio Visual Aids-LCD, OHP, Interactive Boards/Smart Boards Etc.)", was constituted for the Academic Session 2016-17. The
Happur *Phan	Committee encouraged teachers to undertake ICT enabled Teaching- Learning process for effective curriculum delivery. The Committee had initiated Free Computer Literacy Programme for the students. Under this Training Programme, teachers supported the students in learning

	the basics of Computer Application and internet operation.
	Initially, the Committee procured data of students with basic Computer knowledge. The Committee excluded those students who had already obtained the basic knowledge of Computer from the Training Programme. Further, the Committee sought the assistance of Computer literate students to impart training to all the remaining students who were lagging behind in basic Computer knowledge. For providing the basic Computer knowledge to students, the Committee divided students into small groups of 20/30/40 and engaged one teacher for conducting the Training Programme. The Committee prepared the list of students on the basis of Optional Subjects of First Year, Second Year and Final Year, from the first period onwards and accordingly divided the students into groups of 20/30/40. The College has State-of-the-Art infrastructure to cater free Computer Training to students. Each teacher was given the responsibility of teaching the basics of Computer Application to a certain number of students during the off periods. This practice had enabled the College to increase the Computer literacy rate of students. Students were imparted the knowledge of MS-Word, MS- Excel and MS-Power Point. Certificates were issued to the meritorious students on completion of the basic course. Further, the regular teaching was mostly carried out by teachers with the help of ICT. The Committee monitored the classes engaged by all the teachers with the help of Audio-Visual Aids. As such, the Committee allowed outstanding students with basic Computer Knowledge to demonstrate their skills with the help of Interactive Boards.




Fig.: Specimen copy of e-certificate issued to participant

The Committee is entrusted in promoting the use of technology in teaching and also for establishing Complete Students' Computer Literacy Programme (Audio Visual Aids – LCD, OHP, Interactive Board/Smart Boards etc.). The Committee has adopted various measures to increase digital consciousness among students. The Online mode had been chosen considering the difficulties of students and teachers in attending the class in Offline mode due to lockdown restrictions. The faculty resorted to using different ICT tools through online classes



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

The Institution has 97 Computers with 14 Digital Classroom including 11 Smart Board devices, 02 Smart boards, 01 interactive board. The College Computer Lab and Language Laboratory holds a total of 49 Computers. One Student One Skill Programme (OSOSP) Committee proposed 22 Skill-based Courses, out of which Tally and Web Designing are ICT based. The proposed Skill-oriented Courses were stalled due to Pandemic restrictions.





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

# Computer Literate/ Illiterate Percentage Graph





# 1. World Computer Literacy Day

The 'Committee for Promoting the use of Technology in Teaching and Achieving Complete Students' Computer Literacy Programme' celebrated WorldComputer Literacy Day on 2<sup>nd</sup> December, 2022 which was aimed to create awareness and encourage the students about the efficient use of Computers in day-to-day life, and also for motivating them to learn new skills.

# 2. Basic Computer Training Course of 45 Days.

Initially, the Committee procured data of students with basic Computer knowledge. The Committee excluded those students who had already obtained the basic knowledge of Computer from the Training Programme. Further, the Committee sought the assistance of Computer literate students to impart training to all the remaining students who were lagging behind in basic Computer knowledge. For providing the basic Computer knowledge to students, the Committee took initiative to arrange free 'Computer Training Programme', which was inaugurated on 21<sup>st</sup>November, 2022. In all, 153 students registered for this course. The Committee divided students into small groups and engaged one teacher for conducting the Training Programme. The College has State-of-the-Art infrastructure to cater free Computer Training to students. This practice had enabled the College to increase the Computer literacy rate of students. In all 117 students successfully completed the Training Programmeand were awarded Certificates of completion.



# 4. Digital Library








	provided valuable insights into the H-Index and I-10 Index

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
