About Us:

When there were no elite educational institutions catering professional and conventional schoolings to the rural youths especially to the children of disadvantaged sections of the society in Vidarbha, it was Heavenly Bhausaheb Govindrao Mulak who pioneered the beginning of a new era in Higher Education in Maharashtra by establishing a charitable Trust namely Backward Class Youth Relief Committee (B.C.Y.R.C.) in 1974. 



The presentation began with a role of highlighting the factors required to do a business. After the role play a series of PPT slides were played to understand how a business module runs.




Dr. M. M. Betkar expressing his views on how to design Patents.
