Associate Prof. Dr. Vijay Banker, Head, Department of Commerce, Govindrao Warjurkar Arts and Commerce College, Nagbhid, District Chandrapur was the Guest Speaker. In his stupendous talk, he gave detailed information on the New Educational Policy 2020 and the various roles that the non-teaching personnel are expected to play in achieving the desired objectives of NEP 2020. He further stated that an Institution can prosper only if all the employees work together with devotion and commitment. The Institutions with discord among its employees could not flourish in the new scenario. Prof. Dr. Mangesh Kadu, in his Introductory Speech, interacted with the non-teaching staff about the New Education Policy 2020. 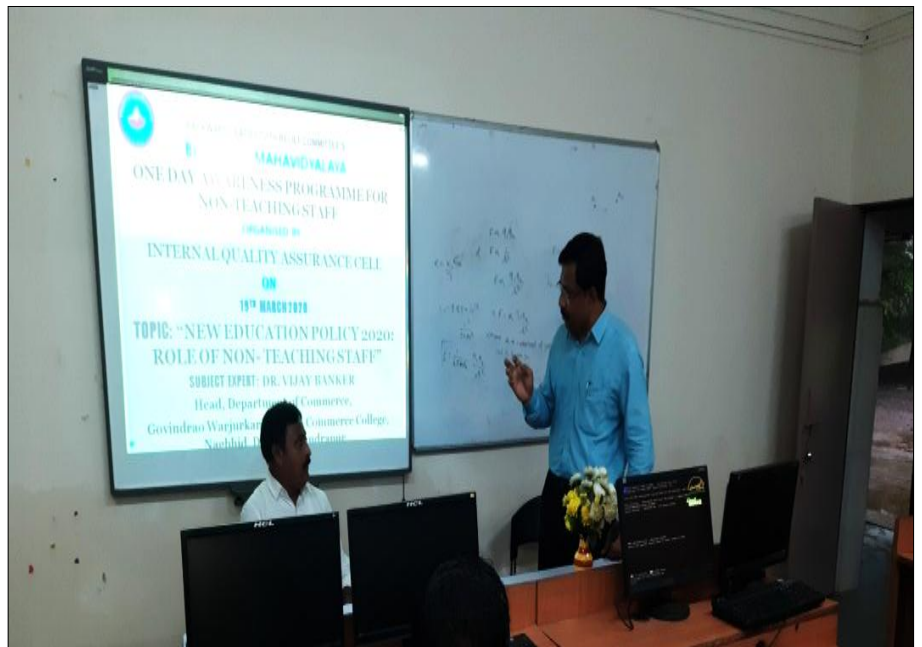

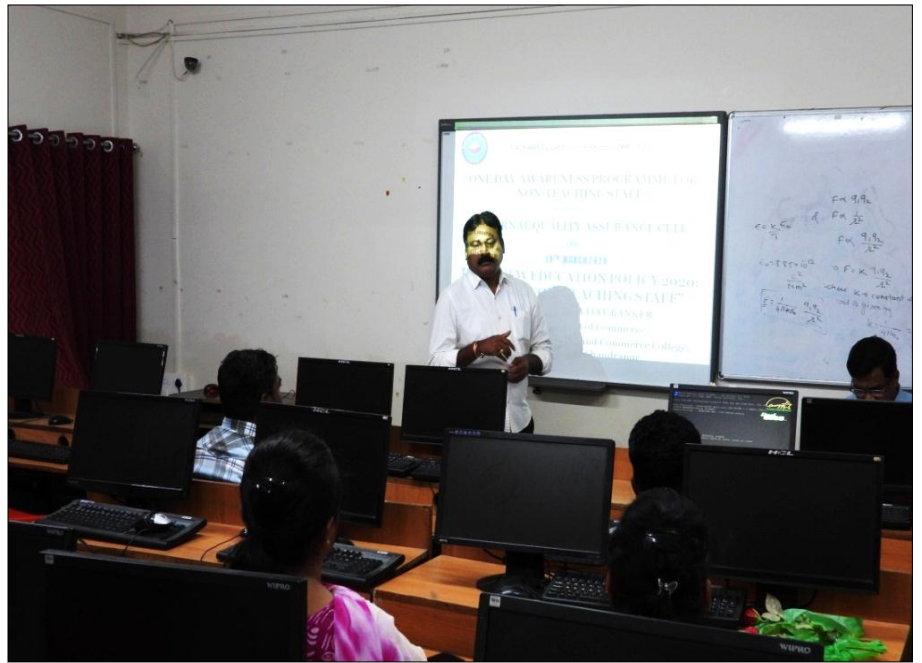
