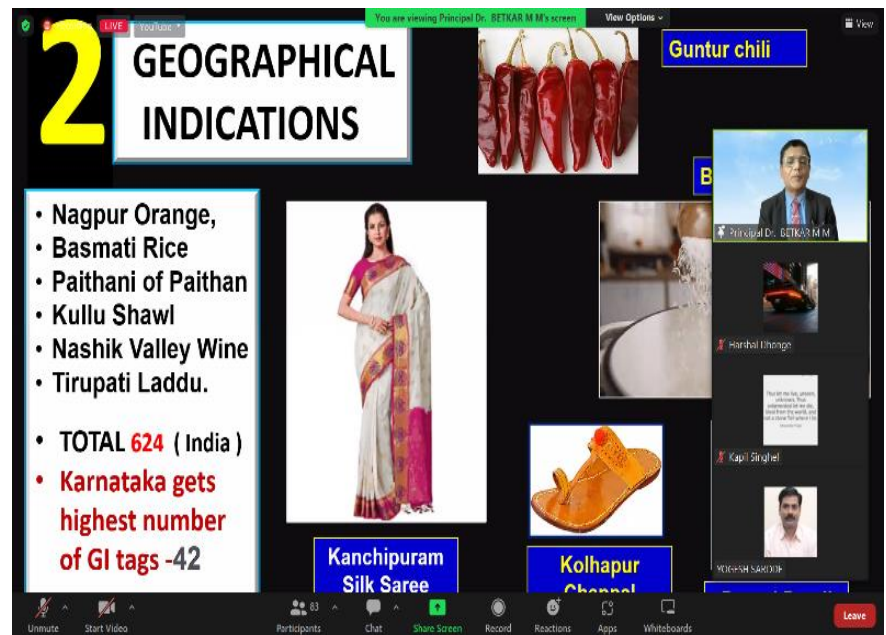

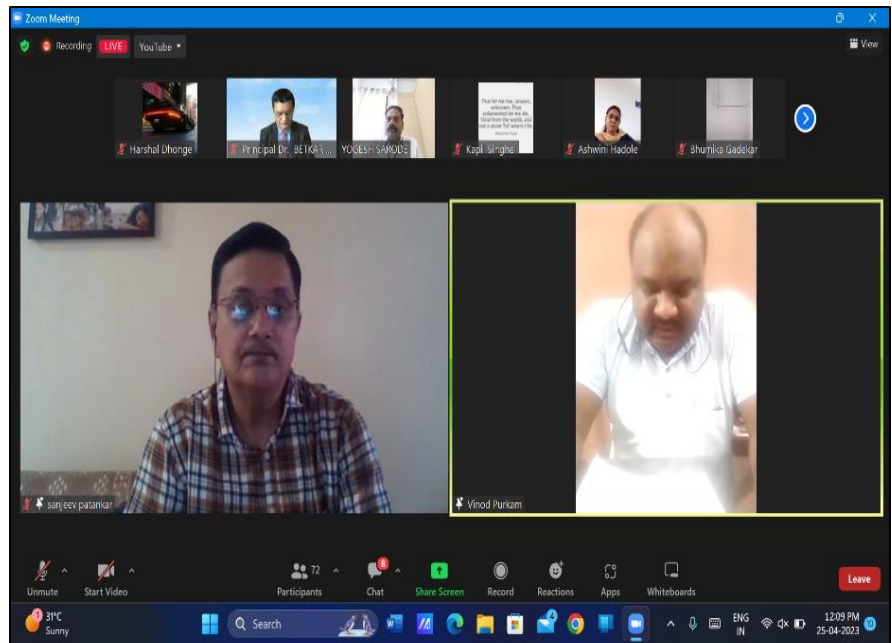


**Dr. M. M. Betkar expressing his views on how to design Patents.**

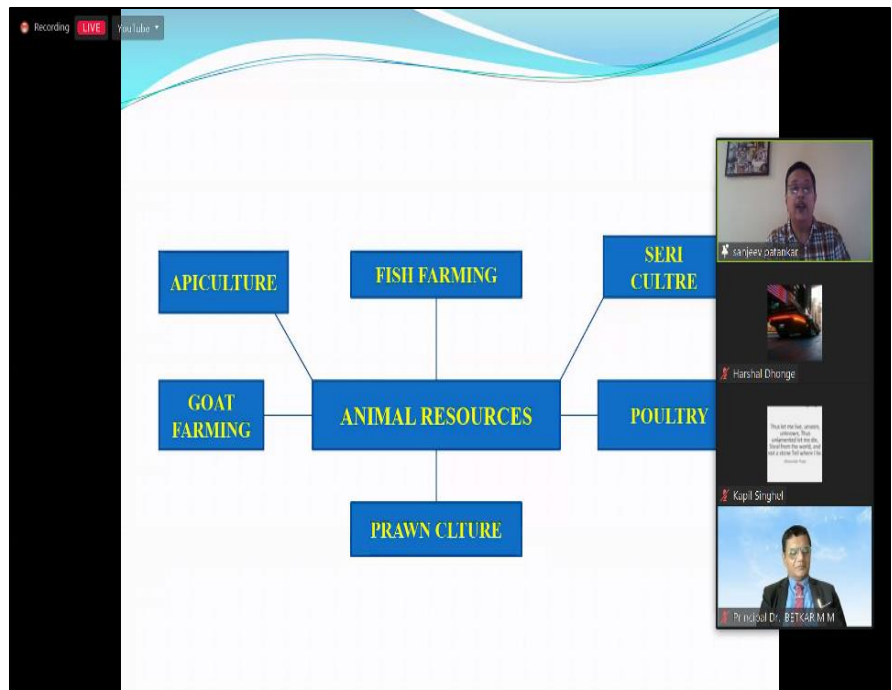
