<b>BRIEF REPORT</b>	<p>On the auspicious occasion of National Science Day, the Faculty of Science of our College, under the aegis of IQAC, celebrated 'Science Week' from 22<sup>nd</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> February, 2023. The week-long celebrations featured a variety of engaging activities, including competitions such as Essay Writing, Elocution, Quiz, Power Point Presentations, Science Exhibition and Poster Presentation for the students of Junior and Senior Colleges. The highlight of the Event was the 'Intercollegiate Science Exhibition' and 'Poster Competition', where students actively participated with great enthusiasm.</p> <p>The Science Day celebrations commenced with the Inaugural Ceremony on 22<sup>nd</sup> February, 2023. The Event began with the lighting of the Traditional Lamp and paying homage to the eminent scientist Sir C.V. Raman. Over 100 students, members of teaching staff and non-teaching staff of our College attended the ceremony. Associate Prof. Dr. Sunil Shinde presided over the Session and delivered a brief introduction about the significance of celebrating National Science Day. Asst. Prof. Dr. Vinita Virgandham, the IQAC coordinator, graced the occasion as the Chief Guest of the</p>

Inaugural Function. Asst. Prof. Dr. Yogesh More, Head, Department of Physics and the Co-Ordinator of National Science Day celebrations, announced the schedule of events for the Science Week, which were set to take place from 22<sup>nd</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> February, 2023. The College extended its full support and encouragement for the successful organization of the National Science Day celebrations.

On 22<sup>nd</sup> February, 2023 an Essay Writing Competition was held for the students of Junior and Senior Colleges, witnessing the active participation of nearly 50 students. The following day, on 23<sup>rd</sup> February, 2023 an Elocution Competition on the topic “Global Science For Global Well Being” took place, with nearly 53 students participating in the Event. On 24<sup>th</sup> February, 2023, a Power Point Presentation Competition was conducted, focusing on the theme “Global Science for Global Well-being”, attracting nearly 30 presentations from undergraduate and Junior College students.

The celebrations continued with a Science Quiz on 25<sup>th</sup> February, 2023 where students from both Senior and Junior Colleges participated with great zeal and enthusiasm. On 27<sup>th</sup> February, 2023 the Departments of Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology, and Mathematics exhibited their latest scientific equipment available in the laboratories, aiming to generate scientific temper and enhance students’ interest in Science. The students were also shown a small Documentary on Sir C.V. Raman and the success stories of Scientists.

The grand finale of the Science Week was marked on 28<sup>th</sup> February, 2023 with a Science Exhibition and Poster

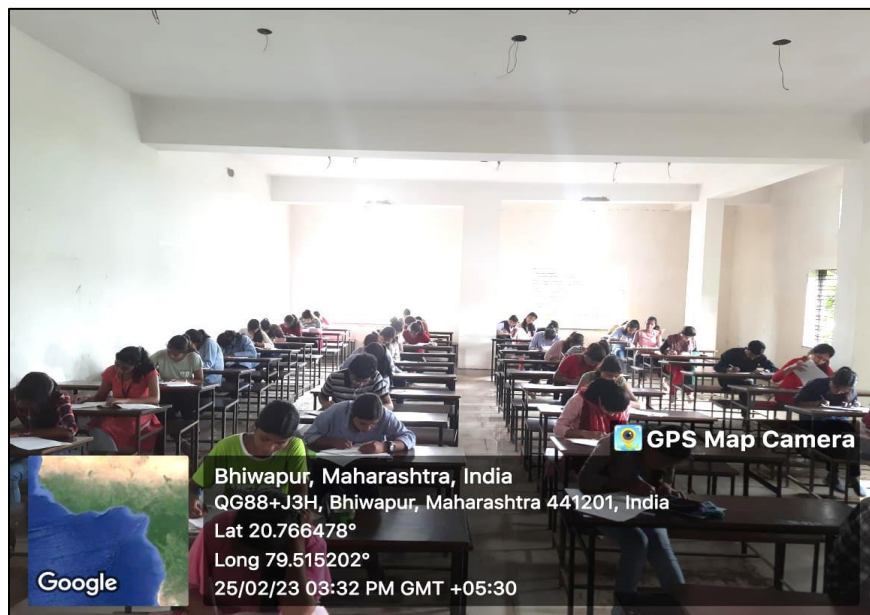
