2. Highlights of my village

- ★ Shankarpur is a village in Chandrapur district of Maharashtra, India.
- ★ It falls under Chimus Taluka.
- ★ Shankarpur population in 2021/2022 is between 6,154 and 7,034 and total households residing are 1571.
- ★ Literate people are 4368 out of 2328 are male and 2040 are female.
- ★ People living in Shankarpur depend on multiple skills, total workers are 2883 out of which men are 1741 and women are 1142.
- ★ Total 305 cultivators are depended on agriculture farming out of 202 are cultivated by men and 103 are women.
- ★ 1263 people works in agricultural land as a labour in Shankarpur, men are 691 and 572 are women.
- ★ Some people works in chilli harvesting.

### ★ Agriculture :-

12 hours agricultural power supply in summers and 12 hours agricultural power supply in winter is available in Shankarpur. Total Irrigated area in Shankarpur is 507.5 hectares from canals 4 hectares, from Boreholes / Tube wells 8.6 hectares and from Lakes or tanks 48.4 hectares are the sources of Irrigation.

Crops in village :-

1. Kharif crops :- Cotton, Paddy
2. Rabi crops :- Wheat, Gram.

### ★ Drinking - Water and Sanitation :-

Untreated Tap water supply all round the year and in summer available. covered well, Hand pump and Tube wells / Boreholes are other Drinking water sources.

### ★ Commerce :-

Commercial Bank available in Shankarpur.  
Cooperative Bank available in Shankarpur.

This village has a power supply 20 hour in summer and 22 hour power supply in winter, Anganwadi centre, ASHA, Public Library, Daily News Paper and Police Station are the other amenities in Shankarpur.

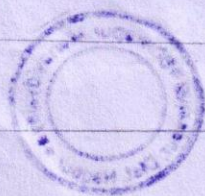
