BRIEF REPORT	<p>Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) is one of the flagship Skill Development Programmes of Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) implemented by National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC), Government of India. Bhiwapur Mahavidyalaya, under the auspices of its IQAC Chapter, collaborated with National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC), Government of India and conducted six months Certificate Course in ‘Self-employed Tailor’ for the dropouts and unemployed youth of Bhiwapur and its adjacent villages from 28th March, 2022 to 28th September, 2022. The main objective of this Skill Certification Programme is to enable the dropouts and unemployed youth to take up industry relevant Skill Training Courses that will help them in securing decent livelihood.</p> <p>Eligibility:</p> <p>Candidate of Indian Nationality Who:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Should be aged between 15-45 years. 2. Should possess an Aadhaar Card and an Aadhaar linked Bank Account. 3. Should possess 6th Class Certificate or any other Educational Degree or Certificate

4. Should be unemployed or the participants must be dropout students.

Accordingly, we made wide publicity through Leaflets and Notices in Bhiwapur and its adjacent villages to encourage the unemployed and drop out local youths to take the maximum benefits of this special initiative of Government of India. In all, twenty six unemployed and dropout girls from Bhiwapur and its adjacent villages enrolled their names in the Certificate Course in “Self-employed Tailor”.

The Inaugural Ceremony of this Skill Programme was Chaired by Dr. Jobi George, the Principal of the College. Asst. Prof. Dr. Vinita S. Virgandham, the Nodal Officer of the Programme, and Asst. Prof. Dr. Anita Mahawadiwar, the Coordinator of ‘One Student One Skill Programme’ were prominently present on this occasion. All the participants were equipped with the skills necessary for financial independence. Attendances of the participants were meticulously recorded using Aadhaar enabled Biometric System.

Mrs. Sangita Shende, the Master Trainer of the Certificate Course in ‘Self-employed Tailor’ coordinated this Programme. She worked hard to make this Skill Oriented Course a grand success.

All the trainees were duly honoured with T-shirts sponsored by National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC), in recognition of their successful mastering of the Course

	Curriculum. Upon completion of the ‘Certificate Course in ‘Self-employed Tailor’ Certificates had been issued to all the participants.

PROBLEMS FACED, IF ANY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Lack of Awareness: Many potential unemployed youth have not been aware of the Event or the benefits it offered, leading to a poor turnout.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attendance and Dropout: Ensuring consistent attendance and preventing dropouts during the six-month Course was a challenge. • Finding experienced instructors who could effectively teach the Skill Programme and keep the Course engaging was a hurdle. • Attracting enough students to enroll their names in the Course required effective marketing and outreach efforts. • Maintaining the quality and consistency of instruction and assessment throughout the Course was challenging. • Ensuring that the Certification process is fair and credible and that the students meet the required standards for Certification was challenging. <p>Keeping the students engaged and motivated throughout the Course, especially in a remote place like Bhiwapur, was difficult. The Committee triumphantly addressed these challenges which required effective planning, communication, collaboration, and adaptability.</p>


