BRIEF REPORT	As part of the Institutions' Vision and Mission Policies, the Principal, during the first meeting of the Staff Council, forms various Institute Level Committees every year covering Curricular, Co-curricular and Extra-Curricular activities for the holistic development of our students. Subject Literary Association of Bachelor of Vocation for the




