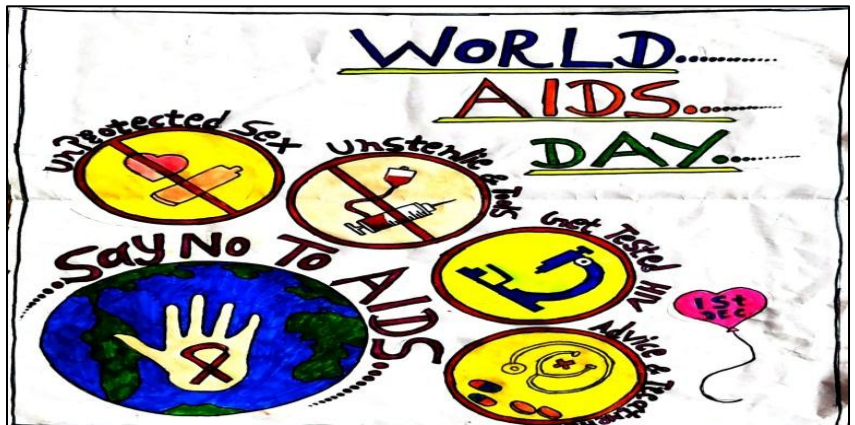
भिवापूरमध्ये एड्स जनजागरण पंधरवडा
