ABSTRACT

The purpose of this **Water Analysis Assessment for Degree Students** is to find out, how the water sample can test. The report starts with introduction and ends with conclusion with experiment report. The report defines the detailed information about water testing with various examples. The report also explains about the quantity of the samples and types of the samples. The Sampling Methods consists of Manual sampling, which explain the details of water testing.

The physical and chemical properties of drinking water vary. It is therefore difficult to obtain a truly representative sample. We need water for different purposes; we need water for drinking, agriculture, irrigation, swimming, fishing, etc. Water for various purposes requirements for the composition and purity, and each body of water must be tested regularly to confirm the suitability.

The types of analysis could change from simple field testing for a single analytic to laboratory. The analytical process demands sampling and sample storage since changes in composition of water do not stop once the sampling has been taken. Screeningis done to ensure that water reaches the laboratory, the same composition as it has occurred during sampling.

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INTRODUCTION

Sampling:

The physical and chemical characteristics of drinking water vary from top to bottom of depth of land, as well as with time as from morning to evening. It therefore becomes difficult to obtain a truly representative sample.

Source of sample:

Sample collected from, River water, Water, Lake Wate,r Tube well and testing conducted 13th April, 2023

Sample containers:

Containers typically are made of plastic or glass, but one material may be preferred over the others. For example, silica, sodium, and boran may be leached from soft glass but not plastic, and trace levels of some pesticides and metals may absorb onto the walls of glass containers. Thus, hard glass container is preferred. For samples, containing organic compounds, do not use plastic containers expect those made of fluorinated polymers such as polytetrafluoroethylene (PTFE).

Sample Volumes:

Collect a 1 litre sample for most physical and chemical analyses. Do not use sample from the same container for multiple testing requirements (e.g., organic, inorganic, bacteriological, and microscopic examinations) because methods of collecting and handling are different for each type of test. Always collect enough sample volume in the appropriate container in order to compile with the sample handling, storage and preservation requirements.

Preservation Techniques:

To minimize the potential for volatilization or bio degradation between sampling and analysis, keep samples as cool as possible without freezing. Preferably pack samples in crushed or cubed ice or commercial ice substituent before shipment. Avoid using dry to break. Dry ice also may effect a pH change in samples. Keep composite samples cool with ice or a refrigeration system set at 4°C during compositing. Analyse samples as quickly as possible on arrival at the laboratory. If immediate analysis is not possible, preferably store at 4°C.

Methods:

1. Turbidity:

Three pin plug of the instrument was introduced into the appropriate main socket. The instrument was switched on and it was allowed to warm up for 10 to 15 minutes. The appropriate range is selected and standardize control was kept maximum. The test tube with distilled water was inserted into the cell holder and it is covered with light shield. Now set zero control was adjusted to indicate zero in the meter. The test tube containing distilled water is removed and was replaced with the test tube containing standard solution. The test tube containing the sample solution was inserted into the cell holder and the corresponding reading was noted in NTU units.

Preparation of stock standards

The particles of formation are uniform in size and shape. The stock standards prepared from the formations are accurate within 1% and stable for 6-8 weeks. The stock standard of 4000NTU is prepared as per the following procedure.

- 1) Take 5g of reagent grade Hydrazine Sulphate and dissolve in 400 of distilled water. This is solution A.
- 2) Next dissolve 50g of pure HexamethyleneTetramine in 400 ml of distilled water. This is solution B.
- 3) Mix solution A and B and make it upto one litre by adding distilled waterand allow this mixture to settle for 48 hours at normal room temperature.

This is a stock standard of 4000 NTU and can be used for 6-8 months to prepare working standards as per following table. Shake this solution well before making dilution.

Determination of pH

Preparation of reagent

Standard Buffer Solutions:

They can be prepared easily by dissolving the pH powder or tablets completely in 100ml of distilled water.

pH unit of measure which describes the degree of acidity or alkalinity of a solution. It is measured on a scale of 0to 14. The term pH is derived from P the mathematical symbol of the negative logarithm, and H the chemical symbol of the Hydrogen. The formal definition of pH is the negative logarithm of the hydrogen ion activity.

$$pH = -log10[H+]$$

pH provides the needed quantitative information by expressing the degree of the activity of an acid or base in terms of hydrogen ion activity.

Fresh distilled water has a pH of 7. Acidic waters have a pH of 0to 7, whereas alkaline waters have a pH of 7 to 14. Ammonia and Lime solution have pH of about 12 where as many cool drinks, lime juice, battery, etc. have pH of less than 4. As pH is measured on a logarithmic scale, a water having a pH of 6to 10 times more acidic than the natural water, a water having a pH of 4 is 1000 times more acidic than water with pH 7 and a pH of 2 is 100000 times more acidic than apH of 7.

pH of a solution can be found easily by using pH strips (paper) or a pH meter gives very accurate values whereas pH strips gives approximate values. pH is determined by the measurement of electromotive force of a cell comprising an indicator electrode responsive to hydrogen ions (such as glass electrode) immersed in the test solution and a

reference electrode is usually achieved by means of a liquid junction, which forms a part of the reference electrode. The 'emf' of this cell is immersed with pH meter. This is high impedance electrometer calibrated in terms of pH

Procedure:

Connect the pH electrode to the input socket at the front. Clean the electrodewith distilled water and dry it. Dip the electrode in the 4.00 pH buffer solution which is provided. Measure the temperature of the buffer solution. Keep the TEMP. Knob at temperature of the solution. Push the pH switch. Adjust the display to 4.00 pH with the CAL knob. Now the instrument is calibrated. Wash theelectrode, dry it and put it in the solution whose pH is to be measured.

Result:

pH of the given samples=7.27

3.Determination of Hardness of water

Reagent preparation:

1. EDTA solution 0.01N:

Dissolve 3.723g of disodium salt of EDTA in distilled water to prepare 1literof solution. Store in polyethylene or Pyrex bottle.

2. Buffer solution:

Dissolve 16.9g of ammonium chloride in 143ml of concentrated ammonium hydroxide. Add 1.25g of magnesium salt of EDTA to obtain sharp change in color of indicator and dilute to 1 liter with distilled water.

3. Eri chrome Black T:

Dissolve 0.25g of EBT in 500ml alcohol or 0.5g of EBT with 100g sodiumchloride (A.R) to prepare dry powder.

Hardness is generally caused by the calcium and magnesium ions present in water.

Polyvalent ions of some other metals like strontium, iron, aluminum, zinc and manganese etc. Are also capable of precipitating the soap and thus contributing to the hardness. However, the concentration of these ions is very low in natural waters, therefore, hardness is generally measured as concentration of only calcium and magnesium which are far higher in qualities over other hardness producing ions. Calcium, and magnesium form a complex of wine red color with Erichrome black t at pH of 10.0+0.1 the EDTA has g0t a stronger affinitytowards ca++ and mg++ and, therefore by addition of EDTA, the former complex ion broken down and a new complex of blue color is formed.

Procedure:

Titration:

EDTA vs Sample Water

To pipette out 20ml of sample water into a clean conical flask. To this 5ml of buffer solution and 2drops of Eri chrome Black T indicator was added. The solution was titrated against EDTA taken in the burette. The end point was changeof color from wine red to steel blue. The titration was repeated up to concordant values.

Dissolve 3.4 g of dried silver nitrate in distilled water to make 1liter of the solution and keep in a dark bottle.

2) Potassium chromate 5%:

Dissolve 5 g of potassium chromate in 100 ml distilled water.

3) Sodium chloride 0.0141N:

Dissolve 4.121 g of anhydrous Sodium chloride in 250 mldistilled water

Silver nitrate reacts with chloride to form very slightly soluble white precipitate of AgCl₂. At the and point when all the chloride get precipitated, freesilver ions react with chromate to form silver chromate of reddish brown color.

Procedure:

Titration:

Sample Water Vs Silver Nitrate

20 ml of sample water pipette out into a clean conical flask. One drop of potassium dichromate was added as a indicator. The solution turns yellow in color. The solution was titrated against silver nitrate taken in the burette. The end point was the change of yellow color into reddish brown color. Titration was repeated up to its concordant values.

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

BRIEF REPORT	An educational tour offers students an opportunity to explore and learn outside the confines of a traditional classroom. It provides them with new experiences, the chance to try different things, and gain valuable life lessons. One such educational tour was organized, under the aegis of IQAC, by the Eco-Club in collaboration with Department of Botany on January, 28th, 2023 to Aura Conservation Park, a Botanical garden known for its medicinal plants. Led by Asst. Prof. Darshana Dhamdar and Asst. Prof. Amit Thakare, the tour commenced at 8:06 A.M from Bhiwapur Mahavidyalaya. The journey from Bhiwapur to Aura Conservation Park took approximately two hours, and upon arrival at around 10:50 A.M, the participants were greeted with delicious breakfast and unique herbal tea. During breakfast, Mr. Ambarish Ghatate and Naturopath Mr. Mukund Sherekar shared their insights on the vision behind creating Aura Park. Serving as a haven for biodiversity enthusiasts, this park, situated only 70 km from Nagpur on Amravati Road, boasts of an impressive collection of over 500 species of medicinal plants. Mr. Ambarish Ghatate and Mr. Mukund Sherekar oversee the management of Aura Park, which stands as the largest collection of medicinal plants in Central India, exhibiting rich



biodiversity. Their efforts aim to conserve and nurture rare medicinal plants that are crucial to ancient Indian medicine, which relies heavily on the healing properties of these plants. After the introduction, the students were divided into two groups to explore the park. The participants were acquainted with a medicinal plant called 'Dashmool'. Dashmool refers to a combination of ten roots from specific plants. In Ayurveda, these ten roots are widely used to address various conditions related to nerves, muscles, bones, and joints. Dashmool exhibits potent anti-inflammatory and analgesic properties, making it a key ingredient in numerous Ayurvedic medicines. Additionally, it is utilized individually to treat inflammatory diseases the musculoskeletal system, including osteoarthritis, gouty arthritis, and rheumatoid arthritis, among others.

The Participants also explored other areas of the park flourished with medicinal plants like Navagraha Vatika, Gokarna, Touch Me Not (Mimosa Pudica), Aparajita plant, Khanduchakka (Ehretiala Evisroxle), Mandukaparni, Rohitakat Ecomella, Gotu Kola, Cassia Fistula, Kalanchee Pinnata, Nirgundi plant, Paribhadra, Kalmegh, Gudmar, Rudraksha, and many more.

unique concept introduced by Mr. Mukund Sherekar. He delivered an enlightening lecture on this topic, providing us with fascinating insights. Nakshatra, also known as lunar mansions, refers to the 27 or 28 divisions of the sky through which the Moon passes during its monthly cycle in Hindu astronomy and astrology. Each Nakshatra is associated with a Zodiac sign and its corresponding celestial bodies and their movements in the sky. Hindu astrologers believe that each constellation of the zodiac is linked to a specific tree, possessing medicinal, social, aesthetic, or economic value. The park has been designed to represent these Nakshatras on the ground, with a circular layout and arcs corresponding to the angles subtended by the zodiacs on Earth. Trees associated with specific zodiac signs have been planted in their corresponding areas within the park.

Following the lecture, Mr. Sherekar shared details about their 'Bio Gas' project and their future plans to develop a machine technology that generates electricity using the power of bulls. At 4:15 P.M the participants enjoyed another serene moment with nature while sipping tea. Students took group photographs with the guides and members before departing from the Aura Park at 5:20 P.M. The bus reached Bhiwapur at 7:45 P.M, concluding the enriching and memorable Educational Tour.







The threads (known as Manja) used for the kites can inadvertently entrap and harm these creatures, even endangering their lives. In a responsible initiative followed by Makar Sankranti, our NCC Cadets undertook a Manja (Kite Thread) Collection Drive on 16 th January, 2023. A Cadet named JUO Sandesh Dhone led this effort to address this issue. They cleaned up the College premises and the surrounding streets. Notably, they diligently gathered not only damaged kites but also discarded hazardous Manja from the streets. The participation of 20 NCC Cadets amplified the impact of this endeavour. Colonel Amod Chandana, the Commanding Officer of the 20 Maharashtra Battalion NCC Nagpur, applauded the commendable initiative of these Cadets. Dr. Jobi George, the Principal of the College, extended his heartfelt appreciations for the dedicated contribution of the Cadets towards

Safety Concerns: Collecting damaged kites and hazardous Manja from streets have exposed the Cadets to safety risks such as cuts from sharp kite strings or potential contact with



harmful chemicals or materials.

Logistics and Disposal: Proper disposal of collected damaged kites and hazardous Manja in an environment-friendly manner, have posed logistical challenges. Finding appropriate and environment-friendly deposal methods for materials, required careful consideration.



BRIEF REPORT

As part of the Institutions' Vision and Mission Policies, the Principal, during the first meeting of the Staff Council, forms various Institute Level Committees every year covering Curricular, Co-curricular and Extra-Curricular activities for the holistic development of our students. 


Computer Literate/ Illiterate Percentage Graph


Graph showing the percentage of Computer Literacy among students

Following activities were organized by the Committee during the Academic Session 2022-2023

1. World Computer Literacy Day

The 'Committee for Promoting the use of Technology in Teaching and Achieving Complete Students' Computer Literacy Programme' celebrated WorldComputer Literacy Day on 2nd December, 2022 which was aimed to create awareness and encourage the students about the efficient use of Computers in day-to-day life, and also for motivating them to learn new skills.

2. Basic Computer Training Course of 45 Days.

Initially, the Committee procured data of students with basic Computer knowledge. The Committee excluded those students who had already obtained the basic knowledge of Computer from the Training Programme. Further, the Committee sought the assistance of Computer literate students to impart training to all the remaining students who were lagging behind in basic Computer knowledge. For providing the basic Computer knowledge to students, the Committee took initiative to arrange free 'Computer Training Programme', which was inaugurated on 21stNovember, 2022. In all, 153 students registered for this course. The Committee divided students into small groups and engaged one teacher for conducting the Training Programme. The College has State-of-the-Art infrastructure to cater free Computer Training to students. This practice had enabled the College to increase the Computer literacy rate of students. In all 117 students successfully completed the Training Programmeand were awarded Certificates of completion.

3. Teachers use ICT for Teaching
