- C) The Parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within area of Entrepreneurship Based Training, Education and Research.
- Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interests.

- G) CLUSTER OF THIRTEEN INSTITUTIONS (CoTI), are affiliated to Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University, Nagpur and caters to all approved faculties of the University.
- H) NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET

FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSE 1- CO-OPERATION

- 1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institution and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.
