BRIEF REPORT	The Volunteers of the National Service Scheme Unit of our Institution, under the aegis of IQAC, presented a captivating Drama titled 'Azad Hind Chi Gatha' on 23 rd March, 2023 as a significant part of the 'Amrut Mahotsav' commemorations of India's Independence. As an integral facet of Government's initiative to celebrate 'Amrut

Mahotsav' more dynamically, an ambitious endeavour was unfolded. Over a thousand students, artists, and dramatists from all over Maharashtra, demonstrated their talents by performing 75 Dramas across 75 locations, spanning over 75 Colleges in 36 districts across the State, all synchronized to transpire on the same day and also at the same time.

The honour of representing Nagpur district in this endeavour was bestowed upon our College. The core objective was to pay homage to the noble sacrifices of India's Freedom Fighters, to acknowledge the pivotal roles of eminent figures in India's struggle for Independence, and reflect upon our Nation's remarkable progress post-independence. Spearheaded by Dr. Jobi George, the Principal of our College, the Event was aimed to encapsulate the living history of India's fight for Independence through the medium of theatre. The vibrant depiction of the journey of Azad Hind, the struggles of pre-independence era, and India's post-independence advancement, came to life through the commendable performances of our students.

The creative vision for the play 'Azad Hind Chi Gatha' was realized by Mr. Darshan Mahajan and Mr. Vidyanath Surve, Founders and Directors of 'Artistic Humans'. Commissioned by respected authorities such as Shri. Vibhishan Chaure, Director of Directorate of Cultural Affairs and Dr. Vikas Chandra Rastogi IAS, Principal Secretary of the Department of Higher and Technical

Education, Maharashtra State, the play was conceptualized and crafted with care. Operating under the banner of the 'Subject Literary Association of History', 20 dedicated N.S.S Volunteers actively participated in bringing this vision to life.

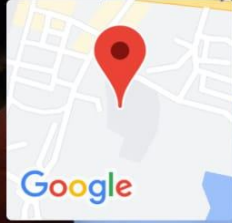

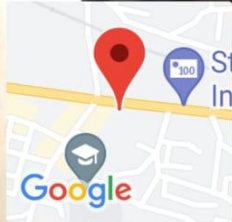



OPERATIONAL METHODOLOGY FOR THE CERTIFICATE COURSE IN PANCHAYAT RAJ

This course is only for the bonafide students of the college. No fees will be charged for the course. But if any student is not able to complete the course within the stipulated time for any reason, but is willing to complete the course, he or she can complete the course by paying Rs. 300/-. Admitted students can use all the resources of the college (such as computers, libraries, and internet facilities) for study.

This certificate course will have a total duration of sixty hours. Classes will be taught daily as per the prescribed syllabus. Each class will be for one hour, as per the schedule. Every admitted student will be required to complete at least fifty hours out of the total sixty hours. The class will be attended by the class teacher each day. After the completion of the course, there will be a written examination of eighty marks based on multiple-choice questions. Also, an oral test of twenty marks will be conducted. A minimum of fifty marks in both examinations will be mandatory to pass the certificate course.



BRIEF REPORT	<p>The Department of Political Science, under the auspices of our IQAC Chapter, organized a Guest Lecture on 24th February, 2023. The occasion was graced by Dr. Sunil Shinde, Associate Professor and Head, Department of Economics, who served as the Chairperson. The topic of the Guest Lecture was "Indian Government and Politics". Dr. Mangesh Kadu, Head, Department of Political Science, delivered an Introductory Speech, highlighting the purpose behind selecting this topic and its significance in fostering research acumen among our students who intend to pursue higher education in Political Science. He emphasized on the transitional phase of Indian politics and democracy, as they strive to become more robust and mature. Dr. Mangesh Kadu spoke about the importance of Political Science and exhorted the students to stay abreast of the evolving changes in National politics and the world around them.</p> <p>The esteemed speaker for the Event was Dr. Dinkar Choudhari, Head, Department of Political Science, Arts and Commerce College, Bhis, District Chandrapur (affiliated to Gondwana University, Gadchiroli). His lecture on "Indian Government and Politics" shed light on the intricate relationship between Government formation and actual politics. He emphasized that the type and manner of politics practiced directly influence the kind of governance prevalent in our country. While politically targeted ideologies may be short-lived, serving specific</p>



purposes, stability, peace, and development can be ensured when politics is based on a broader ideological foundation. Dr. Choudhari emphasized the need for political parties to have a strong ideological base rather than focusing on short-term and target-oriented approaches.

During his lecture, Dinkar Choudhari covered five essential aspects of Indian politics, including the fundamentals of Indian politics, the influence of Constitution on Indian politics, politics as a means of social service, the relationship between morality and politics, and the significance of political participation. He concluded by underscoring the importance of active political engagement, stating that increased positive participation from citizens in the political process and Governmental decision-making is crucial for the development of democracy and the progress of our Nation.

In all, 66 students registered their attendance for the Programme.

The event was brought to a close with the Formal Vote of Thanks by Asst. Prof. Someshwar Wasekar

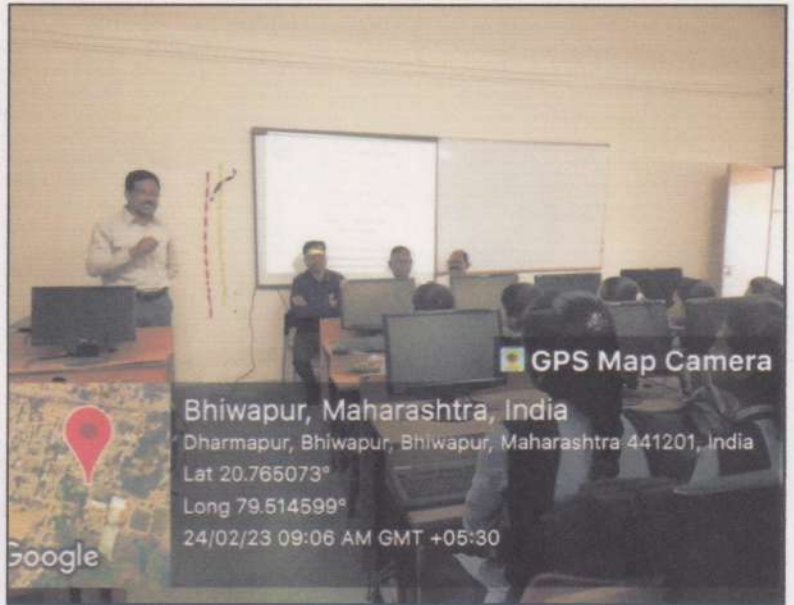

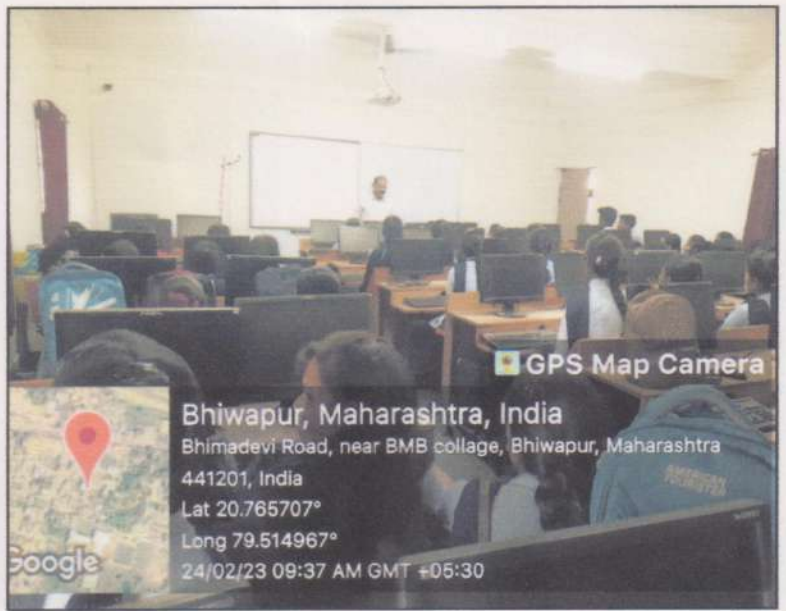

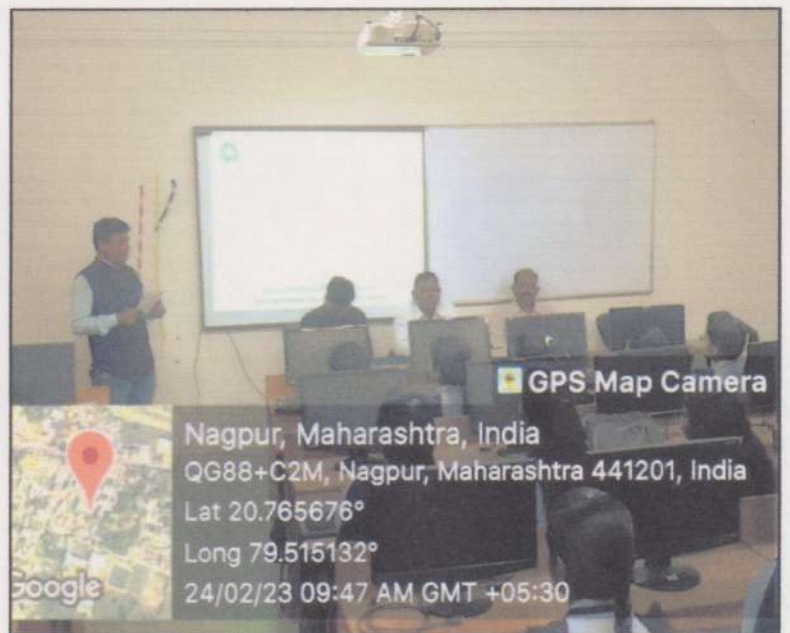

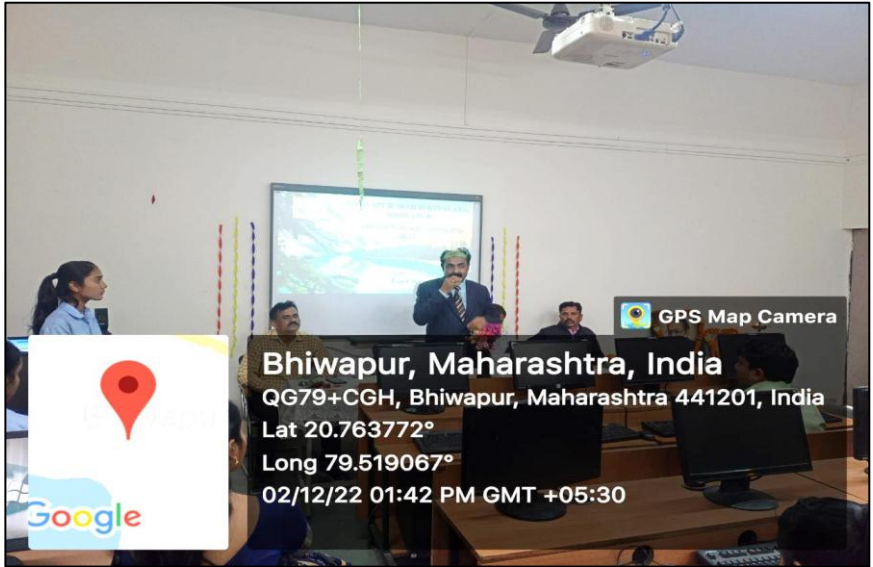

The threads (known as Manja) used for the kites can inadvertently entrap and harm these creatures, even endangering their lives.</p> <p>In a responsible initiative followed by Makar Sankranti, our NCC Cadets undertook a Manja (Kite Thread) Collection Drive on 16th January, 2023. A Cadet named JUO Sandesh Dhone led this effort to address this issue. They cleaned up the College premises and the surrounding streets. Notably, they diligently gathered not only damaged kites but also discarded hazardous Manja from the streets. The participation of 20 NCC Cadets amplified the impact of this endeavour.</p> <p>Colonel Amod Chandana, the Commanding Officer of the 20 Maharashtra Battalion NCC Nagpur, applauded the commendable initiative of these Cadets. Dr. Jobi George, the Principal of the College, extended his heartfelt appreciations for the dedicated contribution of the Cadets towards safeguarding the lives of animals.</p> <p>This effort shows how undertaking thoughtful ventures can make a big impact. The Cadets demonstrated that they really care about their community and the environment by carrying</p>

	<p>harmful chemicals or materials.</p> <p>Logistics and Disposal: Proper disposal of collected damaged kites and hazardous Manja in an environment-friendly manner, have posed logistical challenges. Finding appropriate and environment-friendly disposal methods for materials, required careful consideration.</p> <p>Despite these challenges, the fact that the NCC Cadets took on this initiative demonstrated their determination to make a positive impact on their community and the environment. Overcoming these challenges have contributed to the overall success of the Manja Collection Drive.</p>



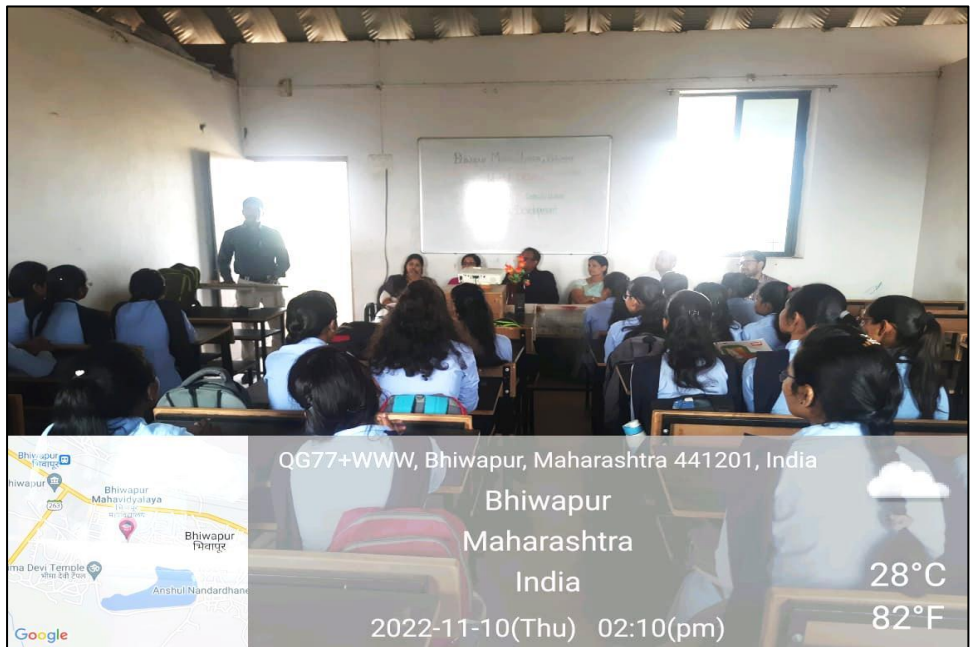

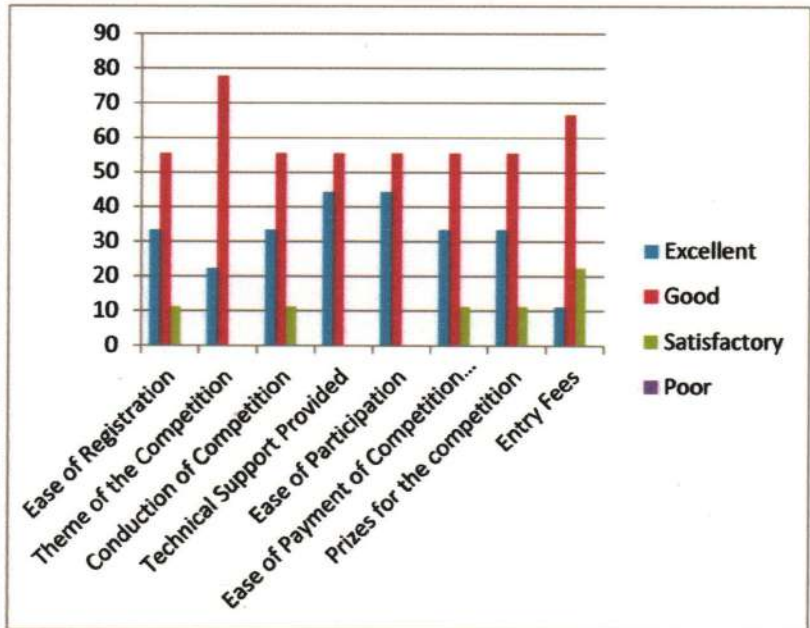
