



ANALYSIS REPORT OF THE FEEDBACK OBTAINED FROM STUDENTS/BENEFICIARIES/ACADEMIC PEERS ETC.	 Most students reported high levels of satisfaction with the remedial classes. Students felt that the classes greatly improved their understanding of key political science concepts. Areas such as political theories, forms of government, and the constitution were particularly highlighted. Lectures, interactive sessions, and

- group discussions were well-received.
- Interactive methods were praised for enhancing engagement and understanding.
- A few students suggested incorporating more multimedia resources and practical examples.
- Students appreciated the personalized support and attention from instructors.
- Instructors were noted to be approachable and available for extra help outside class hours.
- The class environment was described as supportive and conducive to learning.
- A few students faced challenges in balancing remedial classes with other commitments.
- Some students mentioned the need for more supplementary materials and access to online resources.

Conclusion

The feedback from students regarding the remedial classes for BA-I Political Science has been overwhelmingly positive. The classes have successfully enhanced students' understanding and engagement in the subject. By addressing the few challenges

and incorporating the suggested improvements, the remedial program can become even more effective in supporting students' academic success.

DETAILED REPORT OF THE ACTIVITY

The Institution has developed an efficient mechanism to monitor the attendance of students in the classrooms. To facilitate this, an Attendance Committee was formed at the Institutional Level to monitor students' attendance in the classrooms. To increase the percentage of students' attendance in the classrooms, the Member Secretary of this Committee worked as per the instructions and assignments given by IQAC. As soon as the Academic Session began, all the Teaching Faculties were informed to register the students' names in the Attendance Register as per the list provided by the Office of the Principal. The Member Secretary of the Attendance Committee worked diligently to increase the percentage of students attending the regular classes. He also informed all the Teaching Faculties to ensure the endorsement of the Principal on the Attendance Register at the end of every month.

The students who had less than 75% of attendance in the classrooms were encouraged to attend classes regularly. Students failing to register 75% of attendance were informed and the same was conveyed through Postcards to the Parents.

Mechanism of Working of the Attendance Committee during the Academic Session 2023-2024

- Attendance Committee issued Notice on 15th October, 2023 and asked all the Faculty Members to procure Attendance Register, Work Book, Marker Pen and Duster from the Administrative Office.
- Attendance Committee issued Notice on 12th December, 2023 to the Security Guards to restrict students from moving out of the College premises during the College hours.
- The Security Guards were instructed to maintain the records of students (entry and exit) in the Register who leave the College premises before the scheduled time.
- Attendance Committee issued Notice on 17th October,
 2023 and gave instructions to the Administrative Staff to




Computer Literate/ Illiterate Percentage Graph


Computer Literate/Illiterate Percentage Graph

Following activities were organized by the Committee during the Academic Session 2023-2024

1. Basic Computer Knowledge Programme

The Committee first obtained students' data with rudimentary Computer skills. The Committee was empowered to disqualify students who already possessed a rudimentary understanding of Computers. The Committee sought assistance from Computer Literate students to provide training to the Trainees.
