


Computer Literate/ Illiterate Percentage Graph


Computer Literate/Illiterate Percentage Graph

Following activities were organized by the Committee during the Academic Session 2023-2024

1. Basic Computer Knowledge Programme

The Committee first obtained students' data with rudimentary Computer skills. The Committee was empowered to disqualify students who already possessed a rudimentary understanding of Computers. 
