E-Waste Collection and Management

1. Objectives of the Practice

To manage hazardous E-waste in scientific manner and to avoid adverse effects on Human Health and Environment.

2. The Context

Informal E-waste processing leads to adverse Human Health effects and pollution. As the decomposition of E-waste needs scientific methodologies, the Institution initiated this Practice.

3. The Practice

Keeping Government's E- Waste Management Rules and the International Basel Convention, we initiated the Collection and disposal of E-waste by signing MoU with M/s. Suritex Pvt. Ltd., Nagpur, a Govt. authorized E-waste Recycler, which ensures proper disposal as per Maharashtra Pollution Control Board's norms.

4. Evidence of Success

A total of 1420 kg E-waste was collected. 150 Monitors were collected, generating Rs. 36300/- of which sum of Rs. 20350/- was given to the E-waste providers.

5. Problems Encountered and Resources Required

Lack of awareness about the effects of improper disposal of E-waste. People disposed E-waste by burning it or by giving it to scrap vendors who unethically disposed causing harm to the environment.

6. Notes (Optional)

Recovering the parts within the devices and providing manufacturers with recycled metal that can be used to make new products and protecting human and environment by avoiding landfills

DETAILED REPORT OF THE ACTIVITY	<p>Electronic Waste is the discarded electronics and electrical devices. It is one of the hazardous wastes. It has many hazardous effects on the environment and the health of the individuals. Improper E-waste processing in Developing Nations can lead to adverse human health effects and pollution in the environment. As the decomposition of electronic items takes a more prolonged and different methodology, it is advised to decompose it in scientific and eco-friendly manner. The recycling of E-waste serves a lot of useful purposes. For example, protecting human and environmental health by keeping those devices out of landfills. Recovering the parts within the devices that still have value and providing the manufacturers with recycled metal that can be used to make new products. In India, the Government, through the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEFCC), released updated E-Waste Management Rules. International treaties like Basel Convention were aimed at lessening and regulating the movement of hazardous waste among countries.</p> <p>Our College also took efforts to exterminate E-waste from the society and to recycle it in a scientific way. Bhiwapur Mahavidyalaya has taken an initiative in collaboration with M/s. Suritex Pvt. Ltd., Nagpur, a</p>

Government authorized E-waste Recycler for recycling E-waste in a Scientific and Eco-friendly manner. On 2nd May, 2022 our College signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with M/s. Suritex Pvt. Ltd. For ensuring the proper disposal and the recycling of E-waste as per the safety norms set by the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board. Our College paid Rs. 15000/- exclusive of GST for E-waste services. To implement the same, our Institution established E-waste Collection Centre under the Department of Physics. A Policy was designed to ensure the proper working of the Centre. As per the Policy, Request letters were issued to various Institutions, Government Offices and to individuals for providing the E-waste. Circulars were also displayed on the Notice Boards, appealing the students and the Staff members for providing E-waste. College collected all sorts of E-Waste materials like Electrical and Electronic Appliances, IT Hardware and its consumables, Telecom Equipment and switches, Bio Medical Equipment and its spares, other Medical Devices, Power Chords, Cables, Wires, Chargers, Paper, Glass, Metal Scraps or any other device that runs on electricity/battery and provided it to M/s. Suritex Pvt. Ltd. We paid the Rs. 50/- for a piece of discarded monitor and CRT Display and Rs 10/- per kilogram for other items, against the total quantity of E-waste collected from the providers. College also issued Appreciation Letters to the providers for supporting the College in

	<p>this Noble Cause. During the Academic Session 2023-2024, College formed a Four Member Committee for monitoring and facilitating the E-Waste Collection. A special E-Waste Collection Drive was organized during the visit of Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) Bus in our Campus on 3rd March, 2024. Two Monitors and 86 kg of E-Waste had been collected from 8 Donors during the Drive. During the Academic Session 2023-2024, a total of 1420 kilograms of E-waste and 150 Monitors were collected from various Institutions, Staff members and Students of our College, including 1285 Kg of E-waste from K.D.K. College of Engineering, Nagpur and subsequently provided it to M/s. Suritex Pvt. Ltd for recycling. As per the E-waste Management Rule-2016 (Rule 19), M/s. Suritex Pvt. Ltd provided E-waste Manifest (C-Form 6). The College generated a revenue of Rs. 36300/- (Vide Cheque No. 001274 and 001275 dated 26/02/2024) of which, sum of Rs. 20350/- was paid to the providers through Cheque, for providing E-waste, during the Academic Session 2023-2024.</p>

<p>PROBLEMS FACED, IF ANY</p>	<p>Awareness and Participation: Everyone is not aware of the harmful effects of E-waste or the importance of its proper disposal. Encouraging participation from students, staff and other individuals was challenging due to the lack of awareness.</p> <p>Collection Efficiency: Collection of E-waste required a structured collection system. The Committee faced some challenges like insufficient collection points, difficulties in reaching out to all potential contributors and ensuring consistent and regular collection.</p> <p>Inaccurate Sorting: E-waste often contains a wide variety of materials. Accurate sorting is essential to recover valuable components. Incorrect sorting can lead to loss of valuable resources and inefficient</p>

	<p>recycling.</p> <p>Health and Safety: Handling E-waste can expose individuals to hazardous substances. There was a need for proper safety measures, training and protective equipment for those involved in collecting and transporting the E-waste.</p> <p>To address these challenges, the Committee had a well-planned and comprehensive strategy for E-waste Management. This included raising awareness, implementing proper collection mechanisms, collaborating with authorized recycling partners, ensuring compliance with regulations and continuously evaluating and improving the mechanism based on the experiences and challenges already faced.</p>

Essay Writing Competition:

The Essay Writing Competition provided students with a platform to express their thoughts and insights on the significance of voting in a democracy. The participants eloquently articulated the importance of active citizenship and the role of youth in shaping the future of our nation. Topics ranged from the impact of voter apathy to strategies for increasing voter turnout, reflecting a deep engagement with the Democratic Process among the students' Community.

Orientation Session:

The week concluded with an Orientation Session aimed at providing students with a comprehensive understanding of electoral process. Expert speaker Taluka Magistrate and Deputy Returning Officer of Umrer Legislative Assembly Mr. Kallyankumar Dahat highlighted the importance of voter

process and encouraging them to participate in the democratic process. The Feedback was collected through verbal interactions with students and citizens, focusing on their opinion, experiences and suggestions regarding the events.

Methodology: The Feedback was gathered through structured verbal interactions with a sample of 50 students and citizens across the city. The Feedback was then transcribed and analyzed to identify key themes, sentiments and actionable insights.

Key Findings:

Overall Impression:

- Seventy eight percentages of students and citizens expressed positive impressions about Voter Awareness Week. They appreciated the informative Sessions, interactive activities and the enthusiasm of the organizers.
- Fifteen percentages of students and citizens had a neutral stance, including that while they found the event useful, it did not change their perspectives significantly.
- Seven percentages of students and citizens provided negative Feedback, citing reasons such as lack of engagement, scheduling conflicts and

repetitive content.

The Feedback from students and citizens indicates that Voter Awareness Week was largely successful in achieving its objectives. The events were well-received, with high praise for its educational content and interactive elements. However, there are areas for improvement, particularly in terms of diversifying topics, enhancing engagement strategies and optimizing event schedules.
