	educational resources to the disadvantaged groups of the
	society. These disadvantaged groups are SCs, STs,
	Women, OBC (non-creamy layer), Minorities and
	Physically challenged persons. It is clear from the
	demographic factors that a large section of population of
	our country is still disadvantaged and marginalized.
	The establishment of the Equal Opportunity Centre (EOC)
	at Bhiwapur Mahavidyalaya marks a significant step
	towards promoting inclusivity, diversity and equality
	within our academic community. Students from backward
	classes would be able to access Scholarships, Financial
	help, advantages from numerous Government-sponsored
	schemes and preparation for Competitive Examinations
	through this Centre. Activities centered on business,

employment and entrepreneurship, as well as activities like "Yuva Samvad Abhiyan," were also suggested.

Under the auspices of "Equal Opportunity Centre" of our College, we conducted class-wise Counseling Sessions on 29<sup>th</sup> November, 2023 for the students of our College. Giving them guidance on Scholarships, Financial aid, Competitive Examinations, Entrepreneurship Development, business opportunities and employment was the main goal. Asst. Prof. Dr. Ravikant Mishra oversaw Event coordination. During Keynote Speech Mr. Khushwant Dhamke emphasized about Scholarships, Financial aid and the required paperwork procedure. Asst. Prof. Dr. Ravikant Mishra provided insight into the range of professional options available through Competitive Examinations.
