

DETAILED REPORT OF THE ACTIVITY	<p>‘Committee for Promoting Research Innovation, Extension and Consultancy Services’, under the auspices of Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) organized online National Workshop on ‘Importance of Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) in Higher Educational Institutions’ on 29 April 2024 at Google Meet Platform. The Workshop aimed to enlighten Faculty Members, Researchers, and Students about the significance of IPR in academia, the process of securing Intellectual Property, and the benefits it brings to Educational Institutions and society at large.</p> <p>In the Inaugural Session, the Welcome Address was delivered by Asst. Prof. Dr. Vinita Virgandham, IQAC coordinator of our College. Dr. Virgandham emphasized the importance of IPR in fostering a culture of innovation and creativity. Asst. Prof. Dr. Ashwini Kadu, Programme Coordinator, in her Introductory Remark, provided an overview of the Workshop’s objectives and expected outcomes. The Keynote Speaker Dr. Nandkumar Dahibhate, a renowned expert in the field of Intellectual Property, discussed the global and National IPR landscape, with a focus on its relevance to Higher Education.</p> <p>The workshop was divided into two Technical Sessions, each focusing on different aspects of IPR.</p> <p>Session 1: Overview of Intellectual Property Rights: The Keynote Speaker Dr. Nandkumar Dahibhate covered various topics such as introduction to IPR, types of Intellectual Property, importance of IPR in academia.</p> <p>Session 2: IPR and Innovation in Higher Education:</p> <p>The Session covered the important topics “The role of IPR in promoting innovation, best practices for encouraging Research and Development, Institutional Policies on IPR”.</p>

	<p>Valedictory Session: The workshop concluded with a Valedictory Session where key takeaways and recommendations were summarized.</p> <p>Dr. Jobi George, Principal of our College, delivered the Presidential Address. Asst. Prof. Dr. Ashwini Kadu, conducted Proceedings of the Valedictory Session. Asst. Prof. Someshwar Wasekar, proposed the Formal Vote of Thanks.</p> <p>The National Workshop on ‘Importance of Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) in Higher Educational Institutions’ was a resounding success. Participants gained a deeper understanding of IPR and its application in academia. The Workshop provided a platform for knowledge sharing and highlighted the need for robust IPR policies to foster innovation and protect intellectual assets in Higher Educational Institutions.
