DETAILED REPORT OF THE ACTIVITY	<p>Institutional ‘Committee for Promoting Research, Innovation, Extension and Consultancy Services’, under the auspices of Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), organized One-Day National Workshop on ‘"Research Methodology: Theory in Social Research’ on 27th April, 2024. The esteemed Keynote Speakers of the Workshop were Dr. Pradeep K. Meshram and Dr. Dhananjay Sontakke for the First and the Second Sessions respectively.</p> <p>This Workshop was intended to deepen the understanding of Theoretical Frameworks and Research Methodologies essential for conducting rigorous Social Research.</p> <p>The Workshop began with an Inaugural Session, where Asst. Prof. Dr. Vinita Virgandham, the IQAC Co-Ordinator, welcomed the participants. Asst. Prof. Dr. Ashwini Kadu, Head, Department of Chemistry, delivered the Inaugural Address highlighting the importance of Theoretical underpinnings in Social Research and their role in guiding empirical studies.</p> <p>The Workshop focused extensively on the core area of ‘Theory in Social Research’, which encompassed several critical topics, discussed in two Sessions throughout the day.</p> <p>Session 1: Introduction to Social Research: Theory Keynote Speaker: Dr. Pradeep K. Meshram</p> <p>Prof. Dr. Pradeep K. Meshram discussed the role of Theory in Social Research and provided an insightful overview of the significance and application of various Theories in this field. He highlighted different types of Theories, including Grand Theories, Middle-range Theories, and Substantive Theories, each playing a crucial role in shaping Social Research.</p>

The Session emphasized the integral relationship between Theory and Research. It was explained how Theoretical Frameworks are essential for guiding the formulation of Research questions and hypotheses. By providing a structured lens through which Researchers can view and analyse social phenomena, Theories help in developing coherent and focused Research studies.

Grand Theories offer broad, overarching perspectives on social systems and structures, while Middle-range Theories focus on specific aspects of social life, providing more detailed and testable propositions. Substantive Theories, on the other hand, are closely tied to particular empirical phenomena and offer insights into specific contexts or issues.

Overall, the Session underscored that a well-chosen Theoretical Framework is indispensable for the success of any Social Research, as it helps in organizing ideas, guiding data collection and analysis, and ultimately, contributing to the advancement of knowledge in the field.

Session 2: Major Theoretical Frameworks in Social Research

Keynote Speaker: Dr. Dhananjay Sontakke

The Second Session explored key Theoretical Frameworks used in Social Research, such as Structuralism, Functionalism, Conflict Theory, Symbolic Interactionism and Feminism. 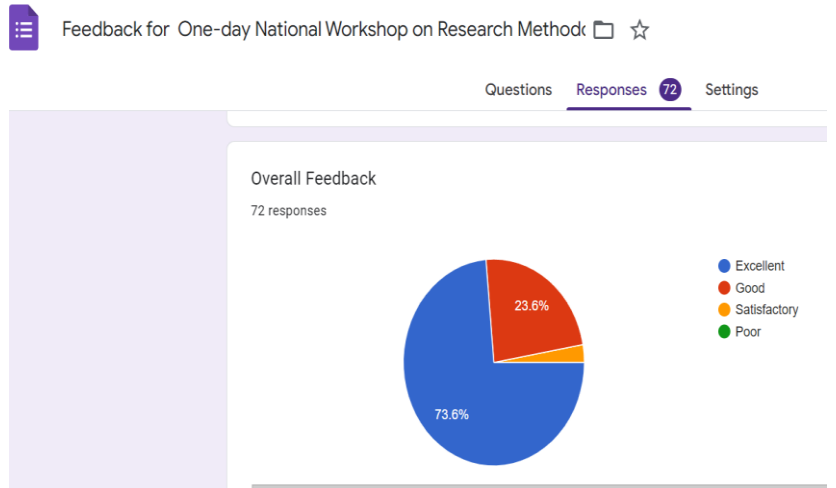

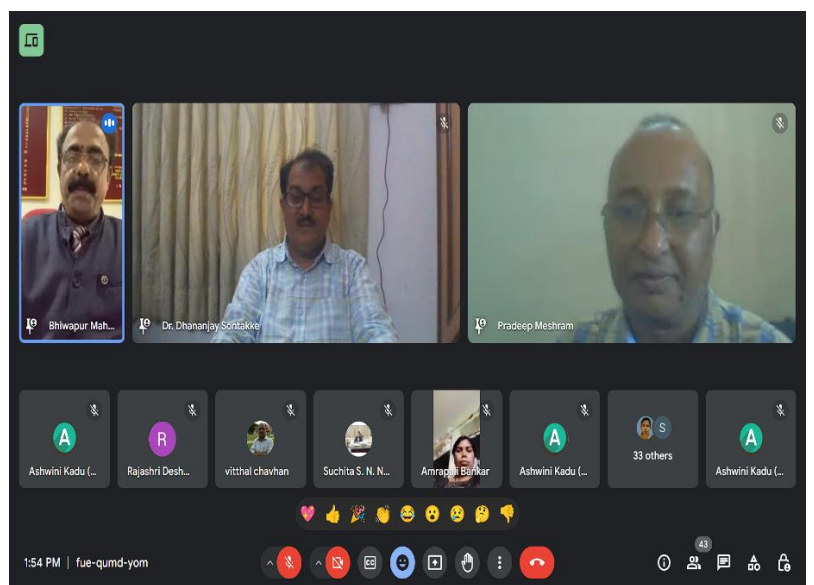

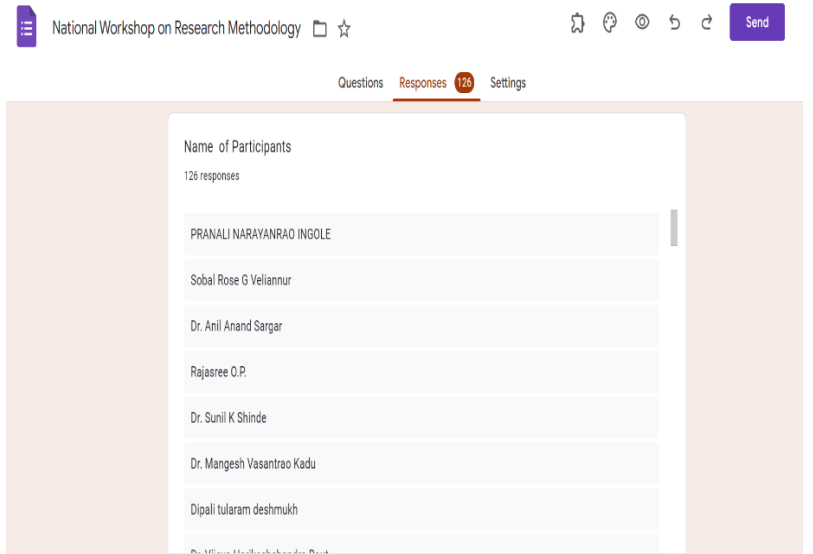
