Agenda No.3

To review the Attendance and Academic Results of students during the previous academic session.

Resolution No. 3

The Chairman of the Meeting raised concern over the poor attendance of students in the classrooms as it had adversely affected the results of students. The Chairman of the Meeting motivated the Parents to send their wards to College regularly to attend their scheduled lectures. He also emphasized that parents should visit the College at least once in a month and interact with the teachers to keep track on the Academic progress of their wards and their attendance in the classrooms.

During the course of the Meeting, one of the Parents Mr. Kishor Gawande expressed his views and put forth his opinion that the College should take very serious action of cancelling the admissions of those students who remain absent throughout. Further, after obtaining the consent of Parents, the Chairman of the Meeting approved the Resolution of sending Post Cards to the parents whose children abstain from attending regular classes.

The Chairman of the Meeting also highlighted that the College always takes positive initiatives to achieve the Academic progress of students. In accordance with the quality policy of the Institution, the Examination Committee conducts Surprise Tests, Unit Tests and Model Examinations and also issues Progress Report Cards to the students for obtaining the endorsement of their Parents. He also emphasized that the Parents should motivate their wards to avoid the use of Mobile Phones and keep away from getting addicted to tobacco and other substances. In this way, the Chairman of the Meeting informed the parents about the diverse mechanisms of the College for the holistic development of students.

Agenda No.4: Discussion on students' attendance in the College

ResolutionNo.4:

An extensive discussion was held on the topic of students' attendance. The Chairman highlighted that the attendance of some students was below the expected standard. He urged the Parents and Guardians to monitor their ward's attendance regularly. Additionally, he recommended the Parents/ Guardians to make unannounced visits to the College to verify their ward's attendance.

To address this issue, the Committee resolved to send Postcards to the Parents/Guardians of students who have either a 100% absence rate or an absence rate exceeding 75%.

Agenda No. 5: To discuss about the negligence of students in taking admissions in the College in various disciplines and submission of the GOI Scholarship forms.

Resolution 5:

The Principal of our College pointed out that some of the students are not serious about submitting their GOI Scholarship forms within the stipulated time period. He also brought to the notice of all that some of the students are not strictly adhering to the schedule fixed by the University for taking admissions in the College, due to which, they are deprived of their privilege of getting Higher Education. He also instructed all the Teaching Staff to co-operate and inform personally to all the students about the dead-line for the submission of GOI scholarship forms. The Principal also requested the house to be alert and aware of the seriousness of
