**DETAILED REPORT OF
THE ACTIVITY**

The Second Meeting of the Parent-Teacher Association of our Institution during the Academic Session 2023-2024 was organized on 23rd March, 2024 under the Chairmanship of the Associate Prof. Dr. Sunil Shinde, Head, Department of Economics of our College.

Agenda No.1

To read and confirm the Minutes of the previous Meeting

Resolution No. 01

The Minutes of the previous Meeting of the Parent-Teacher Association were read and it was approved unanimously by all the Members present in the Meeting.

Agenda No.2

To review the Attendance and Academic Results of students during the previous year.

Resolution No. 2

The Chairman of the Meeting raised concern over the poor attendance of students in the classrooms as it had adversely affected the results of students. The Chairman of the Meeting motivated the Parents to send their wards to College regularly to attend their scheduled lectures. He also emphasized that the Parents should make frequent visits to the College and should interact with the teachers to keep track on the Academic progress of their wards and also about their attendance in the classrooms.

During the course of the Meeting, one of the Parents Mr. Abhishek Dhone expressed his views and put forwarded his opinion that the College should take very serious action of cancelling the admissions of those students who remain absent throughout the Academic Year. Further, after obtaining the consent of Parents, the Chairman of the Meeting approved the Resolution of sending Post Cards to the Parents whose children abstain from attending regular classes.

The Chairman of the Meeting also highlighted that the College always takes positive initiatives to achieve the Academic Progress of students. In accordance with the quality Policy of the Institution, the Examination Committee conducts Surprise Tests, Unit Tests and Model Examinations and also issues Progress Report Cards to the students for obtaining the endorsement of their Parents. He also emphasized that the Parents should motivate their wards to avoid the use of Mobile Phones and keep away from getting addicted to tobacco and other intoxicative substances. The Chairman of the Meeting informed the Parents about the diverse mechanisms of the College for the holistic development of our students.

Agenda No.3

To initiate discussion regarding the De-addiction movement in the Institution.

Resolution No.3

To make the students free from Tobacco and Ghutka consumption, the De-addiction Committee of our Institution is working actively under the aegis of IQAC. The Chairman of the Committee also encouraged the Parents to motivate their wards to get away from the consumption of intoxicative substances. He also appealed the Parents to stay away from the consumption of tobacco and other intoxicative substances.

Agenda No. 4: To discuss the negligence of students regarding the dead-line of submission of admission forms in the College in various disciplines and submission of the GOI Scholarship forms.

Resolution 4: The Chair pointed out that some of the students are not serious about submitting their GOI Scholarship forms within the stipulated time period. He also brought to the notice of all that some of the students are not strictly adhering to the schedule fixed

by the University for taking admissions in the College, due to which, they are deprived of their privilege of getting Higher Education. He also instructed all the Teaching Staff to co-operate and inform personally to all the students about the dead-line for the submission of GOI scholarship forms. All the Members unanimously agreed to pay proper attention towards this issue.

Agenda 5: Discussion with Parents/Guardians regarding the upcoming NAAC Visit.

Resolution 5:

The Chairman informed the house that the Institution is gearing-up for the upcoming NAAC Committee visit. The College submitted its Self-Study Report (SSR) to the Office of NAAC on 19th October, 2023. During their visit, the NAAC Committee Members will meet with Parents and Guardians. The Chairman urged everyone to attend the said meeting and contribute to the Institution's progress.

Agenda No. 6:

Discussion on creating awareness among students about voting in the General Lok Sabha Election 2024.

Resolution 6: Asst. Prof. S.V. Wasekar urged the Parents and guardians to encourage their wards to vote in the upcoming Lok Sabha Election-2024. He also emphasized the importance of encouraging individuals above 18 years of age to register their names in the voting list of their Constituency.

Any other Matter with the permission of the Chair.

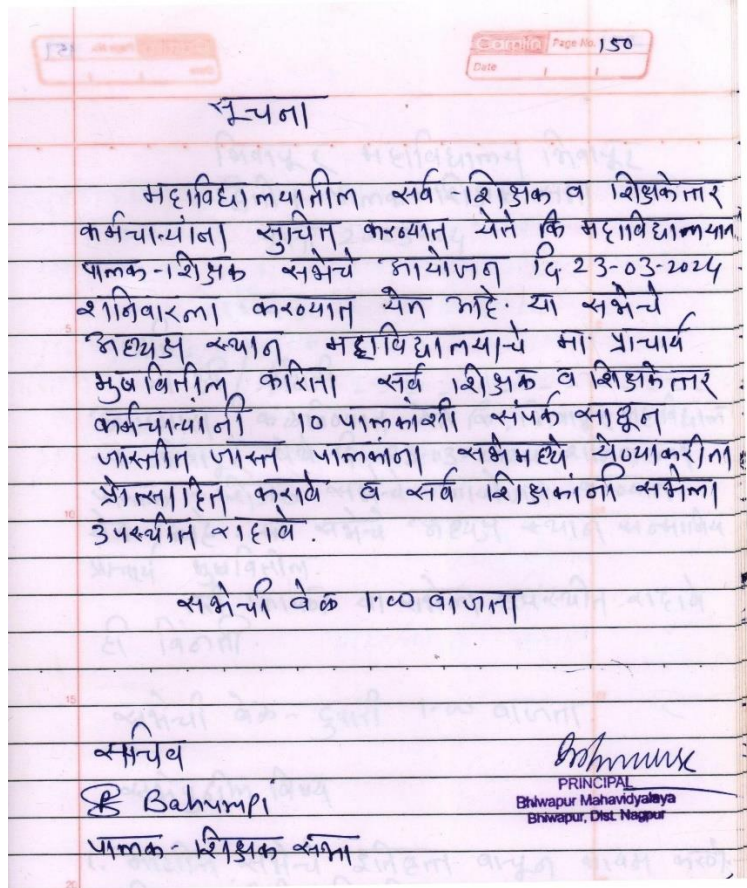
Resolution No.7
