		Head, Department of Economics of our College.				
		Agenda No.1				
		To read and confirm the Minutes of the previous				
	Meeting					
		Resolution No. 01				
		The Minutes of the previous Meeting of the Parent-				
		Teacher Association were read and it was approved				
		unanimously by all the Members present in the Meeting.				
		Agenda No.2				
		To review the Attendance and Academic Results of				
		students during the previous year.				
		Resolution No. 2				
		The Chairman of the Meeting raised concern over the				
		poor attendance of students in the classrooms as it had				
		adversely affected the results of students. The Chairman				
		of the Meeting motivated the Parents to send their wards				
		to College regularly to attend their scheduled lectures.				
		He also emphasized that the Parents should make				
		frequent visits to the College and should interact with				
		the teachers to keep track on the Academic progress of				
		their wards and also about their attendance in the				
		classrooms.				
		During the course of the Meeting, one of the Parents				
		Mr. Abhishek Dhone expressed his views and put				
		forwarded his opinion that the College should take very				
		serious action of cancelling the admissions of those				
		students who remain absent throughout the Academic				
		Year. Further, after obtaining the consent of Parents, the				
		Chairman of the Meeting approved the Resolution of				
		sending Post Cards to the Parents whose children				
		abstain from attending regular classes.				

The Chairman of the Meeting also highlighted that the College always takes positive initiatives to achieve the Academic Progress of students. In accordance with the quality Policy of the Institution, the Examination Committee conducts Surprise Tests, Unit Tests and Model Examinations and also issues Progress Report Cards to the students for obtaining the endorsement of their Parents. He also emphasized that the Parents should motivate their wards to avoid the use of Mobile Phones and keep away from getting addicted to tobacco and other intoxicative substances. The Chairman of the Meeting informed the Parents about the diverse mechanisms of the College for the holistic development of our students.

Resolution No.3

To make the students free from Tobacco and Ghutka consumption, the De-addiction Committee of our Institution is working actively under the aegis of IQAC. All the Members unanimously agreed to pay proper attention towards this issue.
