<b>DETAILED REPORT OF THE ACTIVITY</b>	<p>As per the Academic Policies of our Institution, the Cultural Committee, Subject Literary Associations of English, History and Economics arranged ‘Three Days’ Educational Tour’ from 11<sup>th</sup> March, 2024 to 13<sup>th</sup> March 2024. The details of the Educational Tour are as follows;</p> <p><b>The First Day: 11<sup>th</sup> March, 2024</b></p> <p><b>The Temple of Anusaya Mata in Pardsinga</b></p> <p>On the first day of the Educational Tour i.e. on 11<sup>th</sup> March, 2024 the students and the staff visited the Temple of Sant Anusaya Mata in Pardsinga.</p> <p><b>Narnala Sanctuary: -</b></p> <p>The students also visited the Narnala Sanctuary in Akot, Dist. Akola. It is a hill fortress in the Satpura Range of Vidarbha, Maharashtra.</p> <p><b>Shri Sant Gajanan Maharaj’s Temple at Shegaon: -</b></p> <p>The Staff and the students visited Shegaon for paying obeisance to Shri Sant Gajanan Maharaj. Students were informed that Shegaon gained the reputation as a Holy</p>

Place ever since Shri Sant Gajanan Maharaj lived there. Shri Sant Gajanan Maharaj Temple was built at his place of Samadhi. Sant Gajanan Maharaj Sansthan is the largest Temple Trust in Vidarbha region and is known as the "Pandharpur of Vidarbha". After getting Darshan and Mahaprasad, the students and the Staff took rest in the Ashram of Sant Gajanan Maharaj Trust.

### **The Second Day: 12<sup>th</sup> March, 2024**

#### **Jalicha Dev: -**

On 12<sup>th</sup> March, 2024 we visited Jalicha Dev. Here, students were informed that 'Jalicha Dev' is the most important holy place for the devotees of 'Mahanubhav Panth'. It is believed that Shri Chakradhar Swami resided here for some time. It is situated in Bhokardan Tahsil in Jalna on the North side.

#### **Ajantha Caves- UNESCO World Heritage Site: -**

Then, we all reached Ajantha, one of the oldest Caves in the country. After that, Associate Prof. Dr. Motiraj Chavhan informed the students that the Ajanta Caves are 30 odd rock-cut Caves that date back to the second century BC. These Buddhist Monuments are known for their murals, paintings and sculptures that have defined Indian art over time. Today, they are a UNESCO World Heritage Site and a protected Monument under the Archaeological Survey of India. There were 30 Caves and these were built in two phases and provided shelter to Buddhist monks who came there to meditate during the Monsoon. Even today, these Caves can cast a spell on you with their artistic beauty and would give

you a peek into our history. An inspiration to today's Indian art, the paintings that are centuries old tell a story of our ancestors and how they lived their lives. He also added that once-in-a-lifetime any history or art lover should visit Ajanta Caves. Here, students studied the murals, paintings and sculptures that have defined Indian art over time.

### **Devagiri, Daulatabad Fort:**

Then we visited the Devagiri Fort in Sambhaji Nagar. Associate Prof. Dr. Motiraj Chavhan, Head of the Department of History, Bhiwapur Mahavidyalaya informed the students that Devagiri, Daulatabad is a Majestic Fort in Maharashtra. This famous Fort, which is also known as Deogiri and Devagiri, is located in the Daulatabad village near Sambhaji Nagar. It was once the Capital for the Yadava Dynasty from the 9<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup> century and was also the Capital of the Delhi Sultanate briefly between 1327 and 1334 and the second Capital for the Ahmednagar Sultanate between 1499 and 1636. When Muhammad Bin Tughlaq took over the Throne of Delhi, he was drawn to this Fortress and decided to shift his Capital and court here, renaming the area as the City of Fortune or Daulatabad. Students of our College understood all the information about the Historical Place 'Devagiri'. To reach the summit of Devagiri, it was a thrilling experience for the Staff and the students of our College.

### **Khuldabad:**

We also visited the tomb of Aurangzeb (4<sup>th</sup> November,

1618-3<sup>rd</sup> March, 1707), the sixth Mughal Emperor, ruled most of the Indian Subcontinent for half a century until he died on 3<sup>rd</sup> March, 1707.

Associate Prof. Dr. Motiraj Chavhan informed the students that Aurangzeb is buried in an unmarked grave<sup>in</sup> the complex of the Dargah or Shrine of Sheikh Zainuddin. It is said that Aurangzeb paid for his burial place by stitching caps during his last years and that it cost only 14 rupees and 12 annas which surprised the students and Staff alike.

### **Grishneshwar Jotirlinga:**

Then we visited Grishneshwar Jyotirlinga Mandir or Grushneshwar. It is the Temple of Shiva in Verul village of Sambhaji Nagar in Maharashtra. It is one of the 12 Jyotirlingas.

### **Bhadra Maroti:-**

Further, we visited the Bhadra Moroti Temple in Khultabad. All the students and Staff took rest at Bhadra Maroti Sanstan's Ashram in Sambhaji Nagar.

### **The Third Day: 13<sup>th</sup> March, 2024**

### **The Ellora Caves -Verul:**

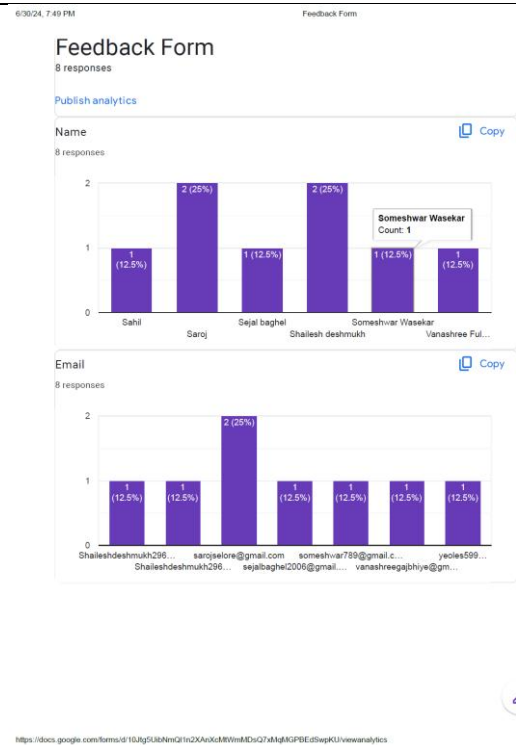
On 13<sup>th</sup> March, 2024 we visited the Ellora Caves. The students were informed that these Ellora Caves not only bear witness to three great religions (Buddhism, Brahminism and Jainism) but they also illustrate the spirit of tolerance, characteristic of ancient India, which permitted these three religions to establish their

	<p>sanctuaries and their communities in a single place.</p> <p><b>Sindhkhed Raja:</b></p> <p>Then we visited Sindhkhed Raja. Students of our College came to know that Jijamata (Rajmata Jijau) was born on 12<sup>th</sup> January, 1598 at Sindhkhedraja in Buldhana District. Rajmata Jijau was the Matoshree of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj, the founder of the Maratha Empire.</p> <p>After paying obeisance at Rajmata Jijau’s birth place, we reached the College safely on 13<sup>th</sup> March, 2024 in the evening. In all, thirty two students participated in this Educational Tour.</p> <p>To make this educational tour a successful one, Dr. Jobi George, the Principal of our College, Associate Prof. Dr. Sunil Shinde, Associate Prof. Dr. Motiraj Chavhan, Asst. Prof. Dr. Anita Mahawadiwar and Mr. Ratnakar Kannake extended great support. The coordination of this event was done by the Member Secretary of Cultural Committee Asst. Prof. Someshwar Wasekar.</p>

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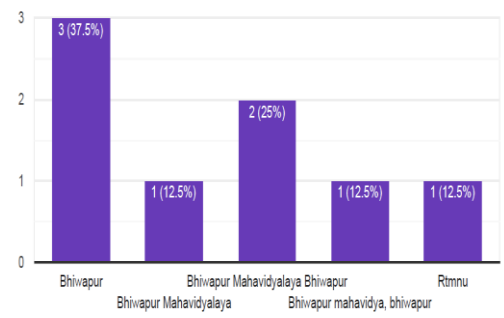

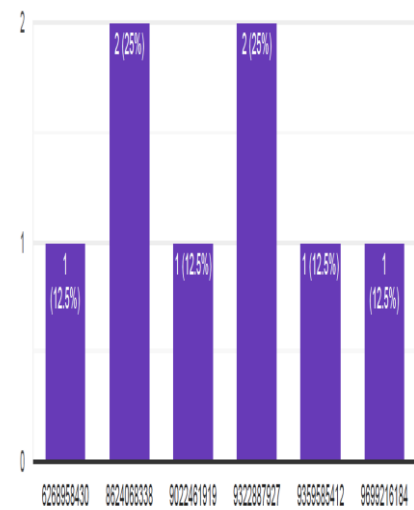
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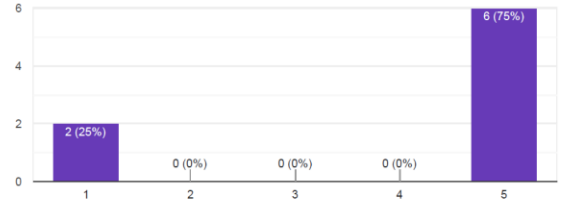




Rate the arrangement of the Educational Tour-2024.



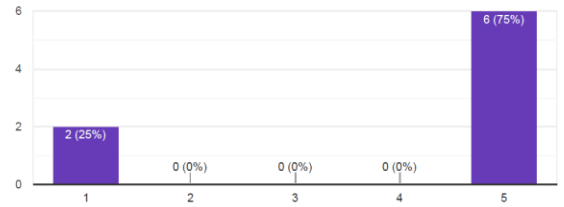

Rate the Relevance of the Educational Tour-2024.



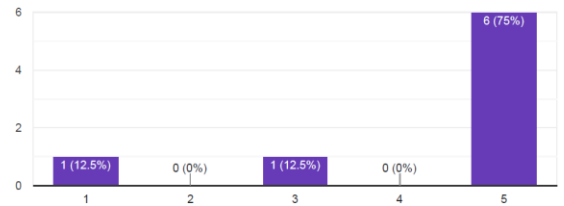

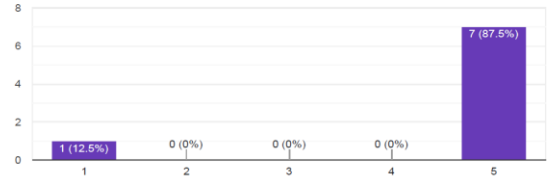

What is the overall rating of the tour experience?



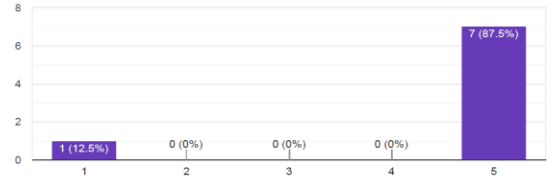

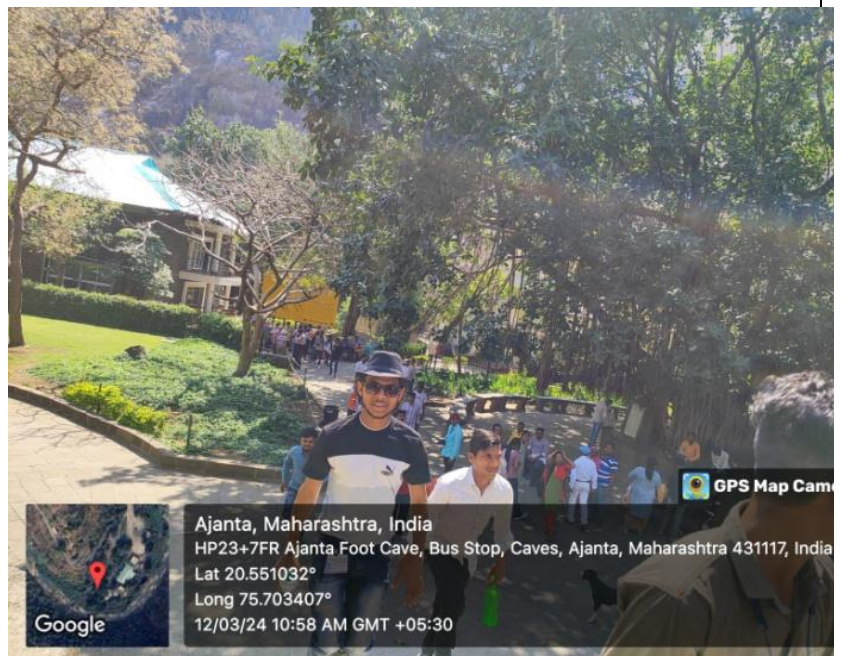

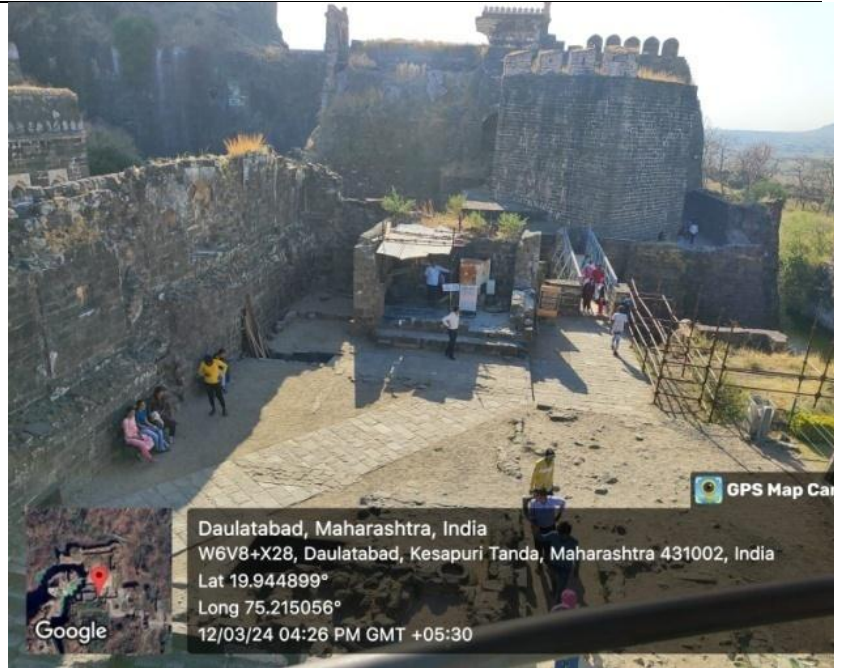
