The Resource Person, Mr. Nikhil Wadhai, a renowned wildlife photographer, shared insights into the latest techniques and camera settings for wildlife photography. 	Following the informative Session, participants had an opportunity to apply the newly learned techniques in the field on the next day, i.e. 7 th October, 2023. The participants actively engaged in applying the techniques learned during the Workshop, enhancing their practical skills in

wildlife photography.
