# DETAILED REPORT OF THE ACTIVITY

The Seminar and Symposia Committee, under the auspices of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), organized a Workshop on 'Professional Ethics for Teaching and Non-Teaching Staff' on 27<sup>th</sup> March, 2024 in the Conference Hall of our College. The primary objective of this Workshop was to enhance the understanding and application of ethical principles in the workplace, thereby fostering a more cohesive and productive environment.

The Event commenced with a warm welcome address by Asst. Prof. Dr. Vinita Virgandham, the IQAC coordinator, highlighting the importance of understanding 'Professional Ethics'.

The Keynote Speaker Mr. Promod Pabrekar, a renowned Resource-person and Senior Consultant from RUSA, Maharashtra, delivered an insightful talk on 'Professional Ethics for Teaching and Non-Teaching Staff.' In his discussion, he emphasized that Professional Ethics are crucial for fostering a culture of integrity and ethical behaviour within the Institution. By equipping the Staff with the knowledge and tools to navigate ethical challenges, the Institution is better positioned to achieve its goals and maintain a positive, professional environment. His talk addressed the needs and enhanced the understanding of Ethics among the Staff. The Workshop was aimed to create a more ethical, accountable and cohesive environment that supports the Institution's mission and vision. Dr. Promod Pabrekar emphasized that the importance of professional Ethics in defining the character of an Institution. It underscores that everyone, whether they are teaching, managing, or supporting, should be guided by integrity. The goal is not only to educate students academically but also to set an ethical example for them.

Associate Prof Dr. Sunil Shinde chaired the Event. In his Presidential Speech, Dr Sunil Shinde, appreciated the initiative taken by the Committee. The Proceedings of the Event was conducted by Associate Prof. Dr. Raheel Quraishi and the formal Vote of Thanks was delivered by Asst. Prof. Dr. Ashwini Kadu.

### PROGRAMME OBJECTIVES To discuss the importance of Ethics in Education and Administration. To equip Staff with practical tools for Ethical decisionmaking. To foster a culture of integrity and accountability within the Institution. To provide the participants with a comprehensive understanding of the concept of professional Ethics, including its scope, significance and applications in the Educational Environment. To create awareness among Teaching and Non-teaching Staff about the importance of maintaining Ethical standards in their professional conduct and decision-making processes. To discuss the importance of maintaining professional boundaries and confidentiality. PROBLEMS FACED, IF ANY **Dealing with Conflicts of Interest:** Balancing personal interests with professional responsibilities can be challenging, and the Staff needs guidance on how to manage these conflicts ethically. Navigating Ethical Dilemmas: Staff often find themselves in situations where the right course of action is not clear, leading to uncertainty and stress. **IMPACT/OUTCOME** have a deeper understanding **Participants** now **ACHIEVED** Professional Ethics and its importance in their lives. Increased awareness of the ethical principles that should guide their professional conduct. Improved ability to make decisions that align with ethical standards and Institutional values. The Workshop fostered a sense of community and mutual respect among teaching and non-teaching staff. Enhanced collaboration and communication among Staff Members, promoting a more cohesive work environment. A culture of ethical behavior and integrity will enhance the Institution's reputation and trustworthiness.

The Feedback from the participants was overwhelmingly positive. 
