Resolution No. 3

The Chairman of the Meeting raised concern over the poor attendance of students in the classroom as it had adversely affected the results of students. The Chairman of the Meeting motivated the Parents to send their wards to College regularly to attend their periods. He also emphasized that parents should make visit to the College at least once in a month and interact with the teachers to keep track on the Academic progress of their wards and their attendance in the classrooms.

During the course of the Meeting, one of the Parents Mr. Kishor Gawande expressed his views and put forwarded his opinion that the College should take very serious action of cancelling the admissions of those students who remain absent throughout. Further, after obtaining the consent of Parents, the Chairman of the Meeting approved the Resolution of sending Post Cards to the parents whose children abstain from attending regular classes.

The Chairman of the Meeting also highlighted that the College always takes positive initiatives to achieve the Academic progress of students. In accordance with that the Examination Committee conducts Surprise Tests, Unit Tests and Model Examinations and also issues Progress Report Cards to the students for obtaining the endorsement of their Parents. He also emphasized that the Parents should motivate their wards to avoid the use of Mobile Phones and keep away from getting addicted to tobacco and other substances. In this way, the Chairman of the Meeting informed the parents about the diverse mechanisms of the College for the holistic

development of our students.

To initiate discussion regarding the De-addiction movement in the Institution.


Resolution No.4

To make the students free from Tobacco and Ghutka consumption, the De-addiction Committee of our Institution is working actively under the Supervision of IQAC. The Chairman of the Committee also encouraged the Parents to motivate their wards to get away from the consumption of intoxicative substances. He also appealed to the parents to stay away from the consumption of tobacco and other intoxicative substances.

He also instructed all the teaching staff to co-operate and inform personally to all the students about the dead-line for the submission of the GOI scholarship forms. The Principal requested the house to be alert and aware of the seriousness of the issue. All the members unanimously agreed to pay proper attention towards this issue.
