BRIEF REPORT	<p>India is a land of diverse cultures and religions, but unfortunately it carries a system of social divisions. This system has led to inequalities that deny access to certain groups to resources and opportunities. These groups include SCs, STs, Women, OBC (non-creamy layer), Minorities and people with disabilities. These inequalities persist, leaving a significant portion of our population marginalized.</p> <p>The Assistant Commissioner of Social Welfare, Nagpur, under the Department of Social Justice and Special Assistance (Government of Maharashtra), conveyed the need to establish an Equal Opportunity Centre at Institute level. This Centre would serve as a platform to offer scholarships, financial aid, benefits of various Government schemes, and guidance for Competitive Examinations to students from Backward Classes. Additionally, programmes focused on entrepreneurship, business, employment and initiatives like ‘Yuva Samvad Abhiyan’ were recommended.</p> <p>Following this official communication, our Institution established an Equal Opportunity Centre on 14th July, 2022. Asst. Prof. Dr. Ravikant Mishra was appointed as the Coordinating Officer.</p>

Under the aegis of our 'Equal Opportunity Centre' we organized a Counselling Session in the Bhausahab Mulak Memorial Indoor Sports Complex of our Institution on 22nd November, 2022. The Session targeted College students from underprivileged sections of the Society, including Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Special Backward Classes, women, and individuals with disabilities. The focus was on providing guidance to them regarding Scholarships, Financial aid, Competitive Examinations, Entrepreneurship Development, Business Opportunities, and Employment.


Asst. Prof. Dr. Motiraj Chavhan presided over the Event while Asst. Prof. Dr. Ravikant Mishra co-ordinated the Event. Mr. Khushwant Damke delivered a Keynote Address, offering insights into Scholarships, Financial aid and the necessary documentation process. Asst. Prof. Dr. Motiraj Chavhan, in his Presidential Address, shed light on various career paths achievable through Competitive Examinations. The Proceeding of the Programme was conducted by Mr. Pravin Mangar of B.A.-II Year and Mr. Ansh Madankar of B.Sc.-I Year proposed the formal Vote of Thanks. The Event witnessed the participation of 200 students. The Institution has its own a Minority Cell, SC and ST Cell, and OBC Cell. Aligned with these, many programmes were organized by various Committees. The events are as follows:

- a) Free Guidance Workshop on MPSC and UPSC Examinations was organized jointly by Bhiwapur Mahavidyalaya and the Unique Academy, Pune under the guidance of Mr. Deva Jadhwar on 19th October, 2022.
- b) Campus Recruitment Drive was conducted on 18th November, 2022.
- c) Campus Recruitment Drive was conducted on 24th February, 2023
- d) Guidance Lecture on Digital Marketing was conducted on 4th March, 2023.
- e) Three Days' 'Employability Enhancement and Youth Livelihood Programme' was conducted for Girl students from 13th March 2023 to 15th March 2023.
- f) Campus Recruitment Drive was conducted on 20th March, 2023.
- g) Four Days' Training Programme on Digital Equaliser (Life and Digital Skill) was conducted from 21st March 2023 to 25th March 2023.

Thus, the establishment of 'Equal Opportunity Centre' in our Institution signifies a vital step towards breaking barriers and providing deserving students with a fair chance to pursue education and succeed in life.

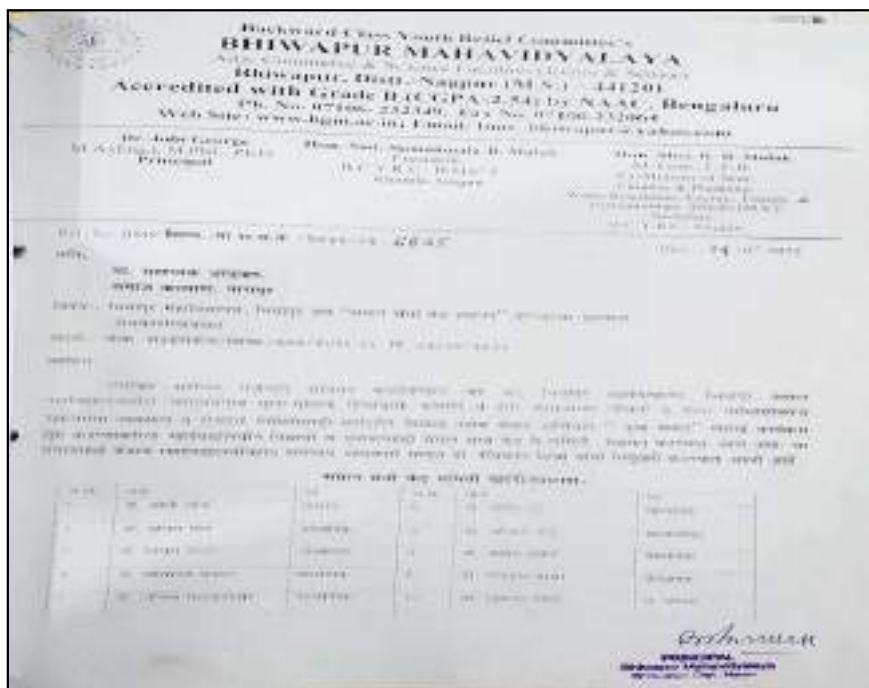
