DETAILED REPORT OF THE ACTIVITY	The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Bhiwapur Mahavidyalaya, Bhiwapur, organized a One-Day State-Level Workshop for Teachers on “Understanding NEP 2020 and its Vision for Teachers” on 7th March from 11:30 AM to 1:30 PM. The objective of the Workshop was to create awareness among educators about the key components of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 and its implications for teaching practices, curriculum design, and Institutional goals. The Session was graced by two distinguished resource persons: • Dr. Vivek Diwan, Associate Dean, RTM Nagpur University • Dr. Pravin Bhagdikar, Chairperson, Board of Studies in Political Science, RTMNU The Workshop began with the welcome of the Guests by the Principal of our Institution with Floral Bouquets. The introductory remarks were delivered by the Chief Coordinator, Dr. Mangesh V Kadu. Resource Person , Dr. Vivek Diwan provided a comprehensive overview of NEP 2020, highlighting its focus on holistic and multidisciplinary education, flexibility in course choices, and the importance of vocational training and skill development. He emphasized the evolving role of Teachers in implementing the policy and the need for continuous professional development.	

	Dr. Pravin Bhagdikar focused on the philosophical and structural aspects of NEP 2020, particularly how the policy envisions an inclusive and equitable education system. He elaborated on the new curricular framework and how teachers are central to realizing the policy's vision of learner-centric education. The Workshop witnessed enthusiastic participation from faculty members across various Institutions. The interactive Q&A Session further enriched the discussion, providing clarity on the practical aspects of implementation. The Session concluded with a formal Vote of Thanks appreciating the resource persons and participants for their valuable insights and engagement.
PROGRAMME OBJECTIVES	1. To familiarize teachers with the key principles and framework of NEP 2020 and its emphasis on the holistic, multidisciplinary and flexible education. 2. To enable educators to understand the changing roles and responsibilities of teachers in light of the NEP's vision for learner-centric and competency-based education. 3. To discuss the structural and curricular reforms proposed by NEP 2020, including credit-based system and Academic Bank of Credits (ABC). 4. To explore the implications of NEP 2020 for higher education Institutions, including autonomy, governance reforms, and integration of technology in teaching and learning. 5. To provide a platform for educators to engage with policy experts and clarify doubts related to the practical implementation of NEP 2020 in classroom teaching and Institutional planning. 6. To encourage faculty development and capacity building, promoting reflective teaching practices in alignment with national educational goals.
PROBLEMS FACED, IF ANY	While organizing the One-Day State-Level Workshop on "Understanding NEP 2020 and its Vision for Teachers", we encountered a few notable challenges. One of the primary issues was the reluctance of some Institutions to send their faculty members, despite the relevance and importance of the topic. Many Institutions cited academic schedules and administrative constraints as reasons for their non-participation. Despite these hurdles, the Workshop was successfully conducted with the active involvement of committed educators and resource persons.
IMPACT/OUTCOME ACHIEVED	• Participants gained a deeper understanding of the key provisions and structural changes proposed under NEP 2020, particularly those affecting the

	role and responsibilities of teachers. • The interactive Sessions helped to clarify doubts regarding the implementation of NEP at Institutional and classroom levels, thereby reducing ambiguity and resistance to change. • The Workshop empowered teachers to align their teaching methodologies with the learner-centric and multidisciplinary approach envisioned by the NEP. • The Session served as a catalyst for participating Institutions to initiate dialogue on Institutional reforms and academic restructuring as per NEP guidelines. • The Workshop provided a platform for teachers from different Colleges to connect, share experiences, and form collaborative links for future academic initiatives related to policy implementation.
