DETAILED REPORT OF THE ACTIVITY	Voter Awareness Rally serves as an essential tool in the Democratic Process, aiming to educate and motivate citizens to exercise their right to vote. These rallies are pivotal in enhancing electoral participation, ensuring that every eligible citizen understands the significance of casting vote. Keeping these thoughts in mind, the Electoral Literacy Club of Bhiwapur Mahavidyalaya, in collaboration with Taluka SVEEP (Systematic Voters' Electoral Education Programme), organized a voter awareness rally on 21st October, 2024 from Rashtriya Vidyalaya to Tahsil Office, a location accessible to a large number of participants and conducive to public gathering. The event was aimed to educate the citizens on the importance of voting, demonstrate the voting process, and motivate citizens to participate actively in the upcoming Legislative Assembly Election scheduled for November, 2024. Students from all Schools and Colleges in town participated in the rally. The rally commenced at 10:00 a.m. with the opening speech of Block Development Officer Mr. Chetan Jadhav. He highlighted the significance of voting as a political right and civic duty, emphasizing that every vote counts in shaping the future of the community and the nation. The Nodal Officer of College level ELC Dr. Mangesh Kadu also addressed the rally. He underscored the importance of informed voting and encouraged the attendees to familiarize themselves with candidates and their platforms. The rally received strong support from Local Business Houses, Non-profit Organizations, Schools, Colleges, Government and Non-government Offices and Community groups. Many organizations set up booths to provide information on their services and how they intersect with civic interests. Additionally, some individuals offered refreshment and drinking water, creating a community-centric environment that encouraged socialization and discussions about civic responsibilities. The rally was

	concluded at 12:30 p.m. with closing remarks of Taluka Magistrate Mr. Kalyan Kumar Dahat, who thanked the attendees, speakers, and volunteers for their participation. He reiterated the rally's message: information and active voting are crucial for a healthy democracy. Volunteers for National Cadet Corps of the College helped the Organizing Committee in maintaining discipline throughout the procession.
PROGRAMME OBJECTIVES	• To inform the Citizens about the importance of voting and the procedures involved. • To foster a sense of civic duty and encourage active participation in the upcoming Electoral Process. • To ensure marginalized and first-time voters are aware of their rights and responsibilities. • To inspire citizens to register themselves and turn out to vote on Election Day.
PROBLEMS FACED, IF ANY	Organizing the 'Voter Awareness Rally' for 1600 students and citizens presented several challenges, including ensuring effective crowd control, maintaining clear communication, managing logistical aspects like transportation and safety in case of any medical emergency, and engaging the participants to sustain their interest and enthusiasm throughout the event.
IMPACT/OUTCOME ACHIEVED	• The rally saw a turnout of approximately 1600 participants, a significant number considering the town's population. • The diverse crowd included Senior Citizens, students from all the Schools and Colleges, Staff Members of all Government and Semi-government Offices, First-time Voters, and Representatives from various Community Groups.
