PROBLEMS FACED, IF ANY	▪ The challenge of ensuring the felicitation felt like a deeply meaningful acknowledgment of her career rather than just a quick, superficial box-checking exercise for International Women's Day. ▪ Integrating a solemn, respectful academic honour smoothly into the high-energy, celebratory atmosphere of a youth cultural festival (UMANG). ▪ The difficulty of ensuring that the valuable insights Mrs. Sindhutai Raghushe shared are archived or acted upon, rather than forgotten once the festival concluded.
IMPACT/OUTCOME ACHIEVED	▪ The insights shared by Mrs. Sindhutai Raghushe served as an informal oral history of educational development, enriching the students' academic perspective. ▪ Integrating an academic and gender-focused felicitation into a cultural festival shifted the event's tone from purely recreational to socially conscious.

	By organizing this under the Women's Study Centre and College Administration, the Institution signaled its active commitment to recognizing women's labour and achievements.
