BRIEF REPORT	The 'Health Club and Yoga Unit' of our College, under the aegis of IQAC, successfully organized a "Free Cancer Screening and Health Check Up Camp" on 28th March, 2026. The Camp was conducted in collaboration with HCG Cancer Hospital, Nagpur, and 'Govt. Primary Health Centre, Somnala (Tahsil Bhiwapur)', reflecting the Institution's commitment to social responsibility. The Programme commenced with a formal Inaugural Ceremony. The Event was chaired by Prof. Dr. S. K. Shinde. The IQAC Coordinator Dr. Anita Mahawadiwar was also prominently present on the occasion. The occasion was further graced by Dr. Korade, Health Officer, Government Primary Health Centre, Somnala (Taluka-Bhiwapur). During the Inaugural Session, Ms. Santoshi Wadhwani, Patient Counsellor from HCG Cancer Hospital, Nagpur, provided a comprehensive overview of the objectives and procedures of the Cancer Screening Camp. She emphasized the vital role of early detection in the effective treatment and prevention of Cancer. Followed by the Inaugural Ceremony, the medical expert team initiated the screening process. A total of 117 participants underwent various health check-ups. The Camp included blood group testing, breast cancer screening for women, and oral cancer screening for both men and women. All screenings were conducted with utmost care, professionalism, and strict adherence to medical standards. The medical team from HCG Cancer Hospital brought advanced screening equipment to facilitate accurate diagnosis. The Camp utilized the following devices: Oral Screening Device (VEL scope / Oral Scan): This handheld, light-based device is used for oral cancer and pre-cancer screening. It helps detect abnormal oral tissues that may not be visible during a routine examination

	and supports the early identification of suspicious lesions in areas such as the mouth, tongue, and cheeks. Breast Screening Device (Mammography Machine): This device is used for breast cancer screening. It captures low-dose X-ray images of the breast, enabling the early detection of lumps or abnormal changes, often before they become physically noticeable. The following members from HCG Cancer Hospital, Nagpur, contributed their services to the Camp: 1. Ms. Santoshi Wadhwani – Patient Counsellor (Psychology) 2. Dr. Shweta Bhoyar – Resident Medical Officer 3. Ms. Rashmi Paware – Associate Nurse 4. Mr. Abdul Salam – Camp Coordinator/Officer 5. Mr. Sagar Vahile – Housekeeping Staff 6. Mr. Nandkishor Chowdhary – Driver This initiative proved to be a significant step toward spreading awareness about cancer prevention and the importance of early diagnosis among the local community. It also highlighted the Institution’s dedication to promoting public health and nurturing a strong sense of social responsibility. The Camp was concluded successfully, leaving a positive impact on all the participants and reinforcing the importance of regular health check-ups and timely medical intervention.

PROBLEMS FACED, IF ANY	Organizing a large-scale health Camp in a semi-rural setting involved several practical and operational challenges. One of the primary difficulties was mobilizing the participants and creating awareness about the importance of Cancer screening, as hesitation and lack of knowledge often discourages people from undergoing such tests. This was addressed through prior communication, local outreach, and counselling at the venue, which helped us to build trust and encourage participation. Another challenge was logistical coordination, particularly in arranging space, electricity, and proper setup for sensitive medical equipment such as the mammography unit and oral screening devices. The Organizing Committee ensured smooth functioning by preparing the venue in advance, coordinating closely with the visiting medical team, and providing necessary infrastructure support. There were also concerns related to privacy and comfort, especially for women undergoing breast Cancer screening. Separate screening areas and a supportive environment were arranged to maintain dignity and confidentiality. Overall, these challenges were effectively addressed through careful planning, teamwork, and coordination, resulting in the smooth and successful conduct of the Camp.

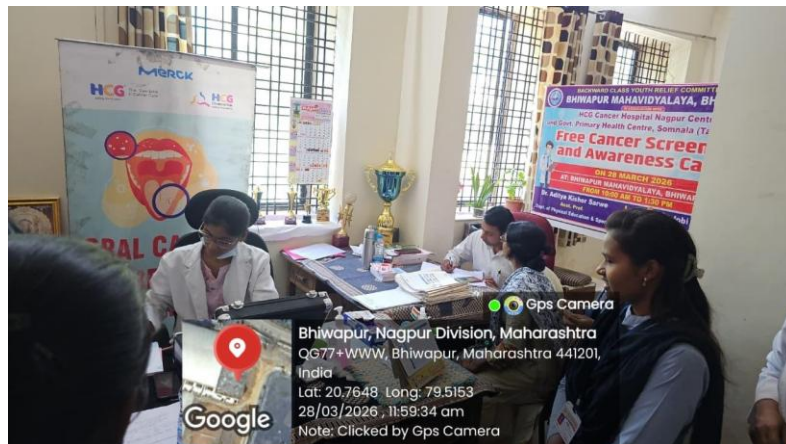

Overall, the Camp was regarded as a highly beneficial and informative initiative. The medical team from HCG Cancer Hospital commended the College for its efficient organization, coordination, and strong commitment to community welfare. They appreciated the active involvement of the staff and volunteers, which ensured the smooth execution of the Camp. The team also acknowledged the enthusiasm and

responsiveness of the participants, making the initiative impactful. They expressed their willingness to collaborate in future health-related outreach programmes, recognizing the Institution's dedication to promoting public health awareness.
