DETAILED REPORT OF THE ACTIVITY	The Library Committee of Bhiwapur Mahavidyalaya organized a "Library Orientation Programme on Digital Library, E-Resource Platforms and OPAC" on 5th March, 2026. The Programme was aimed to create awareness among faculty members and students regarding the effective use of digital library services and various electronic resources available for academic and research purposes. The programme commenced with the formal welcome of the Resource Person Dr. Sanjay Raibole by the senior faculty Prof. Dr. Sunil Shinde. The Programme Coordinator and Member Secretary of Library Committee, Asso. Prof. Dr. Mangesh Kadu highlighted the significance of the topic in his introductory remarks. Chairperson Prof. Dr. Sunil Shinde, in his speech, elaborated on the importance of library and reading in the life of students and teachers. Session Highlights: 1. Digital Library Concept: Dr. Raibole

explained the concept, need and advantages of digital libraries in modern education.

- 2. E-Resource Platforms:** He demonstrated various platforms such as N-LIST, INFLIBNET, e-Shodh Sindhu and other open-access resources.
- 3. Access Methods:** Participants were guided on how to access e-resources using institutional login credentials.
- 4. OPAC Demonstration:** A live demonstration of OPAC was conducted, showing how to search books, journals and other materials available in the library.
- 5. Search Techniques:** He explained advanced search techniques including keyword search, Boolean operators and filtering methods.
- 6. Plagiarism Awareness:** Brief guidance was provided on ethical use of information and avoiding plagiarism.

The programme witnessed active participation from faculty members and students across various Departments. The participants showed keen interest and actively interacted during the Session.

Asst. Prof. Dr. Someshwar Wasekar delivered the formal Vote of Thanks.

Conclusion: The Library Orientation Programme was successfully conducted and eventually achieved its envisioned objectives. The Session proved to be highly beneficial in
