ACT and STATUTES/ MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION (MoA)

1. INTRODUCTION

The **Act and Statutes** or **Memorandum of Association (MoA)** constitute the fundamental legal framework governing the establishment, administration and functioning of Bhiwapur Mahavidyalaya, Bhiwapur. The College is managed by **Backward Class Youth Relief Committee (BCYRC), Nagpur**, a registered educational society committed to quality and inclusive Higher Education. These legal documents also provide the institutional foundation for seeking **Autonomous Status** under UGC Regulations.

2. MEANING AND SCOPE

2.1 Act

The **Act** refers to the statutory provisions under which the parent educational society is established and empowered to establish and administer educational Institutions. It defines the Society's legal status, objectives, powers and responsibilities.

2.2 Statutes and Rules

The **Statutes, Rules and Regulations** govern the academic, administrative and financial functioning of the College. They provide for:

- Governance and statutory authorities
- Academic administration and curriculum
- Service conditions of employees
- Financial management and audit
- Student admission, welfare and discipline
- Examination and evaluation
- Research, innovation and extension
- Internal quality assurance

These provisions ensure transparent, accountable and effective institutional governance.

2.3 Memorandum of Association (MoA)

The **Memorandum of Association (MoA)** is the constitutional document of the parent society. It specifies:

- Name and registered office
- Vision, Mission and objectives
- Powers and functions of the Governing Body
- Membership and governance
- Financial administration
- Amendment and dissolution procedures

The MoA provides the legal foundation for the establishment and management of the College.

3. INSTITUTIONAL LEGAL FRAMEWORK

Bhiwapur Mahavidyalaya is administered by **Backward Class Youth Relief Committee (BCYRC), Nagpur**, and functions under:

- Societies Registration Act, 1860
