BRIEF REPORT	The Health Club and Yoga Unit of our College, under the aegis of IQAC, organized a Workshop on Cancer Awareness on 28th March, 2026. The event was chaired by Prof. Dr. S. K. Shinde. The IQAC Coordinator Associate Prof. Dr. Anita Mahawadiwar was also prominently present on the occasion. A team from HCG Cancer Hospital, Nagpur, led by Ms. Santoshi Wadhwani and Dr. Shweta Bhoyar, interacted with students and discussed the causes, risks, and prevention of cancer. They emphasized the importance of adopting a healthy lifestyle, including a balanced diet and regular physical activity. Ms. Santoshi Wadhwani specifically encouraged female students to undergo regular screenings for breast and cervical cancer, highlighting that early detection significantly improves the chances of successful treatment. Dr. Korde, Medical Officer at the Government Primary Health Centre, Somnala (Tahsil Bhiwapur), urged the female students to take HPV vaccine provided by Government of India as a preventive measure against cervical cancer. In all, 67 students marked their attendance in the Programme.

PROBLEMS FACED, IF ANY	The organization of the Workshop faced a few practical and academic challenges. Coordinating schedules with medical experts from HCG Cancer Hospital, Nagpur, while aligning with the College timetable was difficult. This was managed through early communication and flexible rescheduling of Sessions. Students initially showed hesitation, especially on sensitive topics like breast and cervical cancer. The Committee addressed their concerns by creating a comfortable and respectful environment, encouraging open interactions, and allowing anonymous questions. Logistical constraints such as venue arrangement, audio-visual setup, and time management also posed minor difficulties. These were efficiently handled through prior planning, technical checks, and proper task delegation among committee members. Another challenge was limited awareness and misconceptions about cancer and HPV vaccination. The expert team used simple language, real-life examples, and interactive discussions to clarify doubts and build awareness. Overall, proactive planning, teamwork, and expert guidance helped the Committee to overcome these challenges and conduct the programme smoothly.

FEEDBACK ANALYSIS REPORT OF THE FEEDBACK OBTAINED FROM STUDENTS/ BENEFICIARIES/ ACADEMIC PEERS	Participants expressed highly positive feedback about the Workshop, describing it as informative, engaging, and impactful. Students appreciated the expert guidance provided by the medical professionals, which helped them better understand the causes, prevention, and early detection of cancer. Many found the Session on healthy lifestyle practices useful and motivating. Female students, in particular, acknowledged the importance of awareness regarding breast and cervical cancer and expressed willingness to adopt regular health check-ups. Information on HPV vaccination was received by the students with keen interest and was considered beneficial for long-term health. Overall, participants felt the Programme was well-organized, relevant, and enlightening, and they recommended conducting more such awareness initiatives in the future.
