DETAILED REPORT OF THE ACTIVITY	The Women's Study Centre of Bhiwapur Mahavidyalaya, under the aegis of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), took a significant step toward community development by organizing a Workshop titled 'Empowering Women: Rights and Resilience' at the Gram Panchayat Office in the adopted village of Naxi. The Workshop featured Mr. Narhari J. Pendham, a Vidhi Seva Swayamsevak from the Vidhi Seva Pradhikaran (Legal Aid Cell), Nagpur, as the Expert Speaker. Addressing a gathering of village women, Mr. Pendham provided crucial insights into legal rights and the various mechanisms available for legal redressal, urging women to be proactive in safeguarding their interests. Principal, Dr. Jobi George, emphasized that knowledge is the cornerstone of strength. 'The road to being empowered and resilient to difficult situations begins with awareness. It is essential for women to understand their rights to truly navigate and overcome social challenges,' he stated in his message to the women attending the Workshop. The event was graced by the IQAC Coordinator Asso. Prof. Dr. Anita Mahawadiwar and Asso. Prof. Dr. Mangesh Kadu, alongside dedicated Volunteers from the Women's Study Centre. The Programme was conducted by Asst. Prof. Dr. Vinita S. Virgandham, Member Secretary of the Women's Study Centre, who also proposed the formal Vote of Thanks, expressing gratitude to the village administration and the legal experts for their collaboration in this vital outreach initiative.
PROGRAMME OBJECTIVES	▪ To extend institutional resources to the adopted village of Naxi through targeted community outreach Programmes. ▪ To educate village women on their fundamental legal rights and the avenues available for seeking justice and redressal. ▪ To equip rural women with the mental and

	intellectual tools needed to navigate and overcome difficult social situations. ▪ To provide actionable knowledge that serves as a cornerstone for personal strength, independence, and self-safeguarding. ▪ To execute a meaningful community-focused initiative under the aegis of the College's Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC).
PROBLEMS FACED, IF ANY	▪ Overcoming deep-seated social conditioning or fear among village women regarding formal legal systems and speaking up about their rights. ▪ Simplifying complex legal jargon and statutory frameworks into accessible, local terminology that resonates with the village gathering. ▪ Aligning the Workshop timing with the demanding daily schedules, agricultural labour hours or domestic responsibilities of rural women to ensure good attendance. ▪ Managing the logistics of transport, setup and coordination between College Volunteers, legal experts from Nagpur and the local Gram Panchayat office. ▪ Ensuring that a single Workshop translates into long-term empowerment without a permanent local helpdesk or continuous follow-up mechanism in the village.
IMPACT/OUTCOME ACHIEVED	▪ Village women gained crucial insights into their legal protections and learned how to proactively safeguard their interests. ▪ Participants became familiar with the functioning of the Legal Aid Cell (Vidhi Seva Pradhikaran) and how to access its services. ▪ The Workshop successfully motivated attendees to shift from passive endurance to proactive legal and social awareness. ▪ The event solidified the relationship between Bhiwapur Mahavidyalaya, the Women's Study Centre and the Naxi Gram Panchayat administration. ▪ The College successfully met its IQAC goals by delivering an impactful, real-world educational programme to a marginalized or rural demographic.

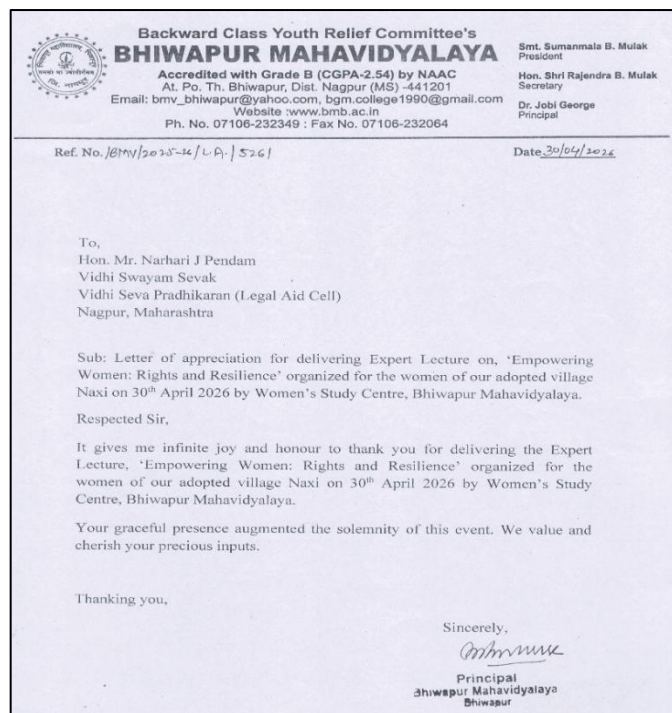
