BENEFICIARIES/TARGET GROUP	The primary beneficiaries of the educational study tour were the students of the Department of History, particularly those who were enrolled in the Undergraduate Programme. A total of 36 students directly participated in the tour. Additionally, faculty members were also benefited through academic interaction and field exposure, which contributed to enhancing the teaching–learning process.

DETAILED REPORT OF THE ACTIVITY	An educational study tour was organized by the Department of History of Bhiwapur Mahavidyalaya under the guidance of Principal Dr. Jobi George on 19 December, 2025. During this tour, visits were made to the Archaeological Survey of India, Prehistoric Section, Nagpur; Epigraphy Branch, Nagpur; Archaeological Excavation Department, Nagpur; Archaeological Survey of India, Nagpur Circle; Anthropology Department, Nagpur; Ajab Bangla Museum, Nagpur; as well as the Swaminarayan Temple. The Superintendent Archaeologist of the Prehistoric Section of the Archaeological Survey of India, Nagpur, explained the museum exhibits and the history of the prehistoric period to the students. The study of ‘remains’ left by human beings is known as prehistoric history. Tools dating back to thirty-three lakh years were discovered and over a period of time, significant changes and developments took place in tools and weapons. Thereafter, Mohammad Shahnawaz Alam from the Epigraphy Branch introduced the Department. Mohammad Tariq Rasool provided detailed information about various inscriptions written in

Arabic and Persian languages and explained the different posters available in the Department from various states.

Dr. Prashant Sonone, Deputy Superintendent Archaeologist of the Archaeological Survey of India, Nagpur Circle, provided information about the archaeological circles in Maharashtra and stated that there are three such circles in the state. He elaborated in detail on the work carried out through these circles, including the survey and conservation of various historical monuments. Sharad Goswami explained that the restoration work of ancient temples located in different parts of Maharashtra is undertaken through this Department.

The Assistant Archaeologist from the Archaeological Excavation Department, Nagpur, introduced the students to the 'remains' obtained from various excavation sites and briefly explained the process of excavation.

The students then visited the museum of the Anthropology Department, where they observed exhibits depicting the evolution of human beings. Thereafter, the students visited the Ajab Bangla Museum, Nagpur, where they were able to observe numerous artifacts from the ancient, medieval, and Maratha periods.

Finally, the students visited the Swaminarayan Temple, where they observed the intricate carvings as well as the cleanliness and well-maintained surroundings.

A total of 36 students participated in this educational study tour. Asso. Prof. Dr. Motiraj Chavhan organized this tour with the objective of enabling the students to understand the local history of Nagpur. All the students of the Department of History participated in this activity. Mrs. Jija Parate and Mr. Ratnakar Kannake

	from the College also participated in the tour. With the cooperation and support of all concerned, this educational study tour was successfully completed.
PROGRAMME OBJECTIVES	• To provide practical exposure to students regarding historical and archaeological studies. • To acquaint students with museum collections, inscriptions, and archaeological artifacts. • To enhance knowledge about prehistoric culture, excavation processes, and heritage conservation. • To create awareness among students about the preservation and protection of historical monuments. • To bridge the gap between theoretical knowledge and practical learning in history.
PROBLEMS FACED, IF ANY	During the educational study tour, a few minor challenges were encountered. Some students experienced slight delays due to transportation and time constraints while covering multiple locations in a single day. Coordination at certain Departments required waiting time due to prior schedules and official procedures. Limited time at each site restricted detailed observation for some students. However, with proper planning, discipline, and cooperation among students and staff, these issues were effectively managed, and the tour was successfully completed.
IMPACT/OUTCOME ACHIEVED	• Students gained practical knowledge of archaeological methods, excavation processes, and historical research. • Enhanced understanding of prehistoric, ancient, medieval, and Maratha period history through direct observation of artifacts and exhibits. • Improved analytical and observational skills through exposure to real historical sources such as inscriptions, tools, and museum collections.

	• Increased interest and engagement of students in the study of history beyond classroom learning. • Students were able to correlate theoretical concepts with practical experiences, thereby strengthening their overall understanding of the subject.
ANALYSIS REPORT OF THE FEEDBACK OBTAINED FROM STUDENTS/ BENEFICIARIES/ ACADEMIC PEERS ETC.	Feedback on the educational study tour from students, peers and beneficiaries was highly positive. Students reported that observing original artifacts, inscriptions, and excavation materials provided valuable practical exposure that deepened their understanding of prehistoric, ancient, and medieval history. Academic peers commended the tour's systematic organization and alignment with educational objectives. Constructive suggestions included allocating more time per location and adding more sites in the future. Overall, the tour successfully met its intended learning outcomes and significantly enriched student academic development.

शैक्षणिक अध्ययन भ्रमण में छात्रों ने जाना पुरातत्व इतिहास

स्थानीय भिवारपुर कॉलेज के इतिहास विभाग द्वारा प्राचार्य डॉ. जोशी जी के मार्गदर्शन में शुक्रवार 19 दिसंबर को एक शैक्षणिक अध्ययन यात्रा का आयोजन किया गया। इसमें भारतीय पुरातत्व सर्वेक्षण, प्रागैतिहासिक विभाग, नागपुर, अभिलेखागार विभाग, नागपुर, पुरातत्व उत्खनन विभाग, भारतीय पुरातत्व सर्वेक्षण, नागपुर, मानव विज्ञान विभाग, नागपुर, अजब बंगला, नागपुर और स्वामी नारायण का दौरा शामिल था। नागपुर स्थित भारतीय पुरातत्व सर्वेक्षण के प्रागैतिहासिक विभाग के अधीक्षक पुरातत्वविद् ने छात्रों को प्रागैतिहासिक विभाग के संग्रहालय की प्रदर्शनी और प्रागैतिहासिक काल के इतिहास के बारे में विस्तार से बताया। मानव द्वारा छोड़े गए अवशेषों के अध्ययन को प्रागैतिहासिक इतिहास कहते हैं। मनुष्य ने तीन मिलियन वर्ष पूर्व औजारों का उपयोग करना शुरू और

स्थलों के बारे में जानकारी देते हुए बताया कि महाराष्ट्र में तीन स्कूल हैं। छात्रों को इनके माध्यम से किए जाने वाले कार्य की सविस्तर जानकारी दी। इनमें विभिन्न प्रकार के स्मारकों का सर्वेक्षण किया जाता है। शरद गोस्वामी ने बताया कि महाराष्ट्र के विभिन्न स्थानों प्राचीन मंदिरों का पुनर्निर्माण कार्य इस विभाग के माध्यम से किया जाता है। छात्रों को विभिन्न स्थानों पर किए गए उत्खनन में प्राप्त अवशेषों से परिचित व सशिष्ट जानकारी दी गई। नागपुर के अजब बंगला स्थित संग्रहालय में छात्रों को प्राचीन मध्यकालीन व मराठा काल के कई अवशेष देखने को मिले। अंत में छात्रों ने स्वामीनारायण मंदिर का दौरा किया। शैक्षणिक भ्रमण में कुल 40 छात्रों ने भाग लिया। भिवारपुर महाविद्यालय के प्रा. मोतीराज चव्हाण ने छात्रों को नागपुर स्थानीय इतिहास से परिचित कराने के लिए अध्ययन यात्रा का आयोजन किया। जिज्ञा पराते, रत्नाकर कर्नाके आदि का सहभाग रहा।

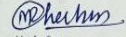

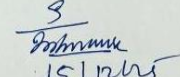
