DETAILED REPORT OF THE ACTIVITY	‘Career Katta’ is an initiative of Maharashtra State Higher & Technical Education Department and Maharashtra Information Technology Support Centre. ‘Career Katta’ supports students in academics, careers, and entrepreneurship. It connects 5,000+ Colleges and approximately 2 lakh students, mainly from rural areas, bridging education and employability. Through its mobile app, students get access to courses, resources, and expert guidance. Over 2,800 students have secured Government jobs already. The platform offers credit-based courses in technology, soft skills, and exam preparation. Programmes like ‘Career Sansad (Students’ Parliament)’ build leadership through interaction with policymakers and industry leaders. It also promotes entrepreneurship via the Global Entrepreneur initiative and helps students create backup career plans. Overall, Career Katta enables skill development, digital access, and career readiness for Maharashtra’s youth. Under the Career Katta initiative, students are provided with various schemes, trainings, workshops, job-oriented training, recruitment guidance, entrepreneurship development techniques, and valuable guidance from experts in these fields. Through the Programme “<i>IAS Aplya Bhetila</i>” (<i>IAS Meets You</i>), students receive guidance regarding competitive examinations. Similarly, the Programme “<i>Udyojak Aplya Bhetila</i>” (<i>Entrepreneur Meets You</i>) aims to increase students’ participation

in the industrial sector and develop essential entrepreneurial skills.

To avail the benefits of these initiatives, it is mandatory to take membership of *Career Katta*. A membership fee of ₹365 has been fixed and is included in the admission fee. While all the students are informed to pay their admission fees, they are encouraged to promptly deposit the ₹365 membership fee at the college to avail the benefit from *Career Katta* and its online Programmes.

Students who deposit ₹365 membership fee will receive an additional ₹365 in their scholarship amount. Thus, this fee will effectively be reimbursed to students through the scholarship.

Bhiwapur Mahavidyalaya established the Centre for running 'Career Katta'. Associate Prof. Dr. M.R. Chavhan is the College Co-ordinator of 'Career Katta, *IAS Aplya Bhetila*' and Associate Prof. Dr. R.K. Quraishi, is the College coordinator of 'Career Katta, *Udyojak Aplya Bhetila*'

PROBLEMS FACED, IF ANY	The implementation of the 'Career Katta' initiative, despite its scale and impact, inevitably encountered several practical and structural challenges. One of the primary difficulties was ensuring consistent student participation, especially since a large proportion of learners came from rural backgrounds with limited exposure to digital platforms and career-oriented Programmes. Many students initially lacked awareness about the long-term benefits of such initiatives, leading to hesitation in enrolling or actively engaging. This was addressed through continuous motivation by faculty, personal outreach such as phone calls, and Orientation Sessions that clarified the value of membership, scholarships, and career opportunities.

Digital accessibility posed another significant barrier. Although the initiative relied heavily on its mobile app and online portal, technical issues such as portal crashes-evident during the ‘Solar Energy Awareness Programme’-disrupted smooth execution. The Committee demonstrated adaptability by immediately shifting to alternative tools like Google Forms, ensuring that participation and data collection were not hindered. This flexibility helped maintain continuity and prevented loss of student engagement.

Financial concerns also surfaced, particularly regarding the ₹365 membership fee. Some students were reluctant to pay, viewing it as an additional burden despite the reimbursement through scholarships. The Committee overcame this by clearly communicating the reimbursement policy and integrating the fee within the admission process, making it more structured and less optional in perception.

Coordinating large-scale participation across hundreds of students and multiple activities created logistical challenges. Managing data, maintaining communication, organizing Events, and ensuring timely reporting required strong administrative effort. The Committee addressed this by forming dedicated coordination teams, assigning clear roles to faculty coordinators, and leveraging digital communication platforms like WhatsApp for real-time updates.

Another challenge was aligning academic schedules with extracurricular Programmes such as the Students’ Parliament, interaction sessions, and startup summits. Students often struggled to balance these alongside their coursework. The Institution mitigated this by scheduling events strategically and emphasizing the academic and career value of participation, thereby encouraging students to view these activities as extensions of their education rather than distractions.

Engagement with external stakeholders, including experts, Government officials, and partner Institutions, required sustained coordination and formal communication. Delays and procedural

	complexities were managed through structured planning, official MoUs, and proactive follow-ups by the coordinators, ensuring smooth collaboration. Overall, the challenges were met with a combination of proactive communication, technological adaptability, administrative coordination, and sustained mentorship, enabling the initiative to function effectively and achieve its intended outcomes.

ANALYSIS REPORT OF THE FEEDBACK OBTAINED FROM STUDENTS/ BENEFICIARIES/ ACADEMIC PEERS ETC.	Participants expressed highly positive feedback about the ‘Career Katta’ initiatives, describing them as transformative and practically valuable. Many students noted that the platform provided clarity about career paths, especially for those from rural backgrounds who previously lacked access to structured guidance and opportunities. The expert sessions and interaction Programmes were appreciated for being insightful, motivating, and directly relevant to real-world challenges. Students highlighted that activities like ‘IAS Aplya Bhetila’ and ‘Udyojak Aplya Bhetila’ helped them better understand competitive exams and entrepreneurship, respectively. The guidance received from experienced professionals was described as inspiring and confidence-building. Several participants mentioned that these sessions broadened their perspectives and

encouraged them to think ambitiously about their futures.

The Students' Parliament initiative was particularly praised for nurturing leadership, communication, and decision-making skills. Student office bearers shared that the experience gave them a sense of responsibility and practical exposure to governance and teamwork.

Workshops, training sessions, and events like the Start-Up Summit and Job Fair were seen as highly beneficial, offering exposure to employment opportunities, industry expectations, and startup ecosystems. Participants appreciated the hands-on nature of these Programmes and the emphasis on skill development.

Overall, students felt that 'Career Katta' significantly enhanced their career readiness, digital engagement, and self-confidence. Many described it as a meaningful bridge between education and employment, helping them move forward with clearer goals and stronger motivation.

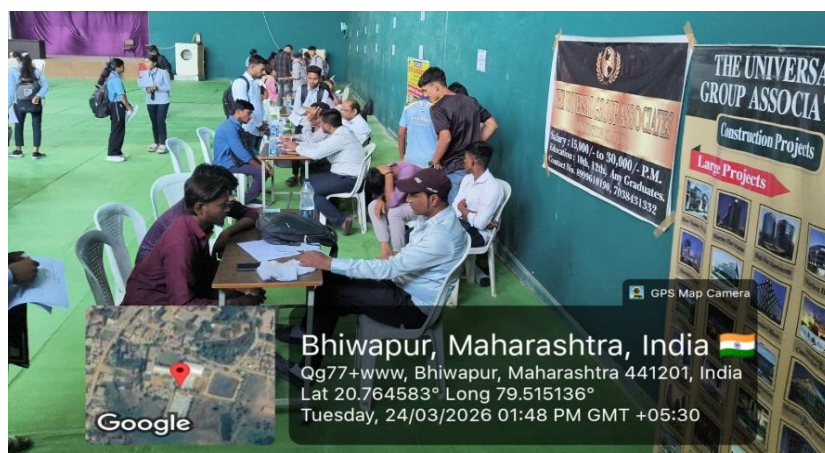
