DETAILED REPORT OF THE ACTIVITY	The first Meeting of the Parent-Teacher Association, of our Institution, during the Academic Session 2025-2026, was organized on 21st November, 2025, under the Chairmanship of Dr. Jobi George, Principal of our College. Agenda No.1 To read and confirm the Minutes of the previous Meeting. Resolution No. 01 The Minutes of the previous Meeting of the Parent-Teacher Association were read and it was approved unanimously by all the Members present in the Meeting. Resolution No. 2 The Parent-Teacher Association of our Institution, for the Academic Session 2025-2026, was re-constituted. Agenda No.3: Discussion on students' attendance in the College

ResolutionNo.3:

An extensive discussion was held on the topic of students' attendance. The Chairman highlighted that the attendance of some students was below the expected standard. He urged the Parents and Guardians to monitor their ward's attendance regularly. Additionally, he recommended the Parents/Guardians to make unannounced visits to the College to verify their ward's attendance.

To address this issue, the Committee resolved to send Postcards to the Parents/Guardians of students who have either a 100% absence rate or an absence rate exceeding 75%. It was decided that each teaching and Non-Teaching Staff Member will visit such students' home and personally meet to inform them to attend the College regularly.

Agenda No. 4: To discuss and take decision about the negligence of students in taking admissions in the College in various disciplines and submission of the GOI Scholarship forms.

Resolution 4:

The Principal of our College pointed out that some of the students are not serious about submitting their GOI Scholarship forms within the stipulated time period. He also brought to the notice of all that some of the students are not strictly adhering to the schedule fixed by the University for taking admissions in the College, due to which, they are deprived of their privilege of getting Higher Education. He also instructed all the Teaching Staff to co-operate and inform personally to all the students about the dead-line for the submission of GOI scholarship forms. The Principal also requested the house to be alert and aware of the seriousness of the issue. All the Members unanimously agreed to pay proper attention towards this issue.

The Principal informed the parents that all students must complete and submit their scholarship application forms; otherwise, full fees will be applicable. Parents were therefore requested to ensure the

timely submission of their wards' scholarship forms. He further stated that a special Camp would be organized in the College to assist students in preparing the necessary documents. A dedicated team of teachers would also be formed to guide and support all the students in completing their applications.

Agenda No.5. To discuss with parents about students maintaining discipline in the College.

Resolution 5: After detailed discussion with the parents regarding the importance of discipline in the College, it was resolved that the parents will cooperate with the College authorities in guiding their wards to follow the rules and maintain proper discipline. Parents agreed to regularly monitor their ward's attendance, behaviour, and punctuality. The College will also continue to counsel students and take necessary steps to maintain a disciplined academic environment.

As no other matter was raised by the members present, the Meeting proceeded to the Concluding Session.

Mrs. Shobha Devhare, Chairperson of the newly constituted 'Parent-Teacher Association', assured both the parents and the College staff that all members of the Parent-Teacher Association would work collectively for the development of the Institution.

The Presidential address was delivered by Dr. Jobi George, the Principal of our College. He highlighted the challenges faced by the Institution and sought the cooperation of parents in overcoming them.
